A talkback session with Janine Geske and RJI member will follow.

■ **Tuesday, November 15:** *Training Seminar by Dr. Mark Umbreit, 6:30 p.m., Eisenberg Memorial Hall in the Law School.* "The Art of Restorative Justice Dialogue." Dr. Umbreit will be holding this session for those who would like to know more about how restorative justice and peacemaking processes work, as well as those who wish to augment earlier mediation training. Dr. Umbreit describes his approach to this topic by making a distinction: "Whereas conflict resolution theory and practice focuses upon a problem solving model to address the presenting dispute, peacemaking addresses conflict at a much deeper level. Peacemaking is based on a humanistic and transformative theory of conflict that draws heavily upon core values of empowerment, mutual recognition, collaboration, dialogue, and healing, as well as the ancient wisdom and practices of many diverse indigenous cultures throughout the world."
