

Criminal Law Referrals

1. Wisconsin State Public Defender's Office (SPD) - https://www.wispd.gov/

Contact the SPD office in the county in which you live to determine if that office can represent you. In Milwaukee, the Public Defender's Office for:

- o Adult cases is located at 819 North Sixth Street, Room 908, (414) 227-4130.
- o Juvenile and mental health cases is located at 10930 W. Potter Road, Suite D, (414) 266-1182.
- 2. **Court Appointed Representation.** If the Public Defender's Office cannot represent you, you may apply to the court for the appointment of an attorney at the county's expense. You must complete the <u>Petition for Appointment of An Attorney, Affidavit of Indigency and Order form GF-152A</u>. The form should be filled out completely and then signed in front of a notary BEFORE you go to court.
- 3. **Retain a Lawyer.** If you are not appointed an attorney by the court, you can contact:
 - Central Wisconsin Community Law (2266 N. Prospect Ave., Suite 312, Milwaukee, WI, (414) 755-3419). Low-cost sliding-scale representation in criminal defense cases. Call for intake information.
 - Centro Legal (611 W. National Ave., #103, (414) 384-7900, www.centrolegalwisconsin.org) provides low cost representation for criminal misdemeanors, diversions, and deferred prosecution agreements. Services in English and Spanish. Free consultations by appointment only. Call to schedule.
 - State Bar Association Modest Means Panel is designed to assist people whose income is too
 high to qualify for free legal services, but too low to pay a lawyer's standard rate. The panel
 assists on misdemeanors, ordinance violations, and pre-charging consults. For more information
