Percentages are rounded to whole numbers for reporting of results. Frequencies have been rounded to whole numbers but percentages are calculated based on non-integer weighted sample sizes. The actual sample size is 1,872. Sample size in the tables may vary due to rounding of weighted sample sizes. Note: The Total column *does not* weight states proportional to their populations, so should not be used to report opinion of the region as a whole.

This survey sampled only the 21 counties of Wisconsin, Illinois and Indiana that are part of the Chicago megacity as defined by the Organization for Economic Cooperation and Development, and therefore is not intended to be representative of any of the states as a whole. See the Methodology Statement for details of how the poll was conducted.
