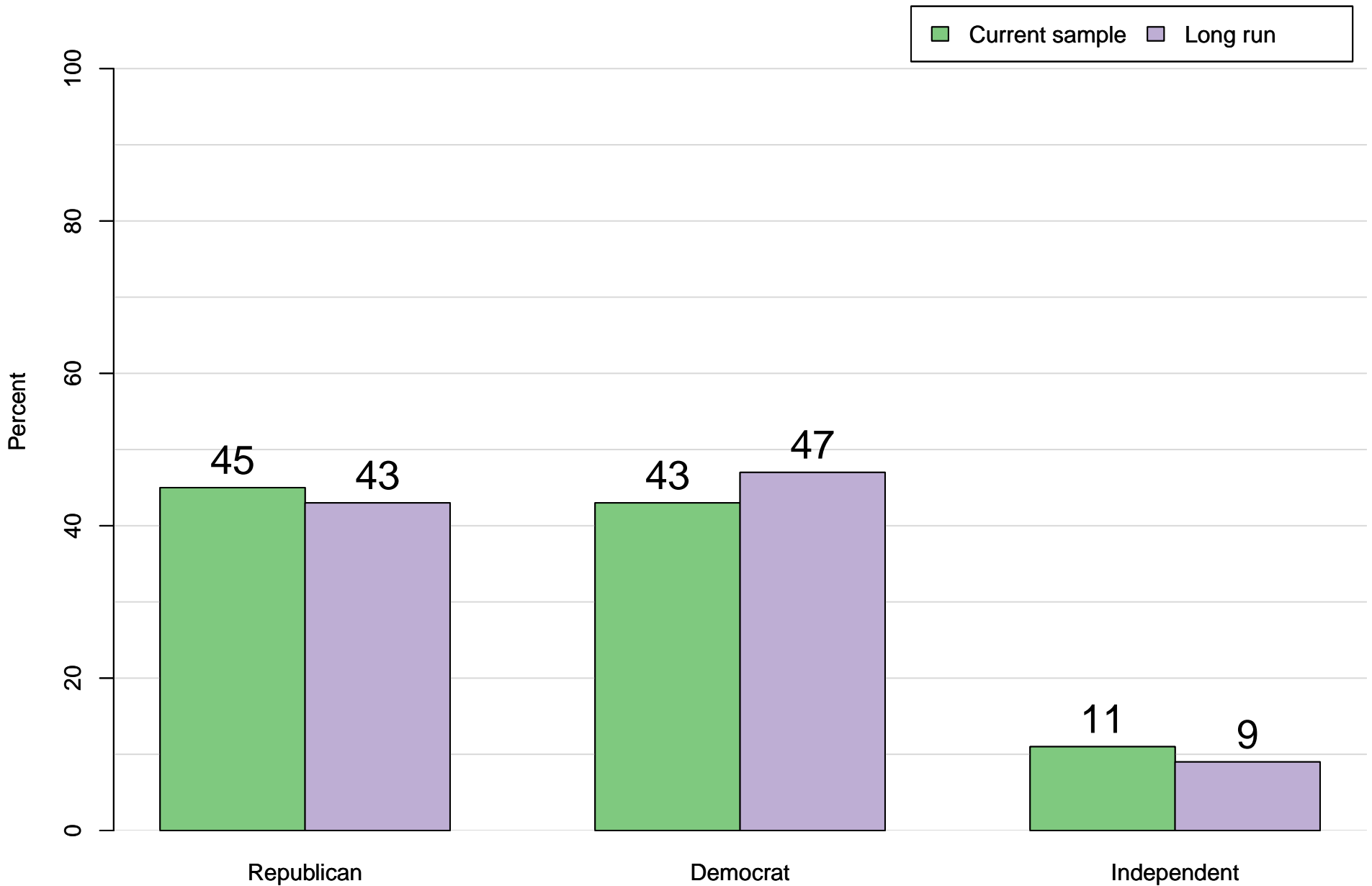

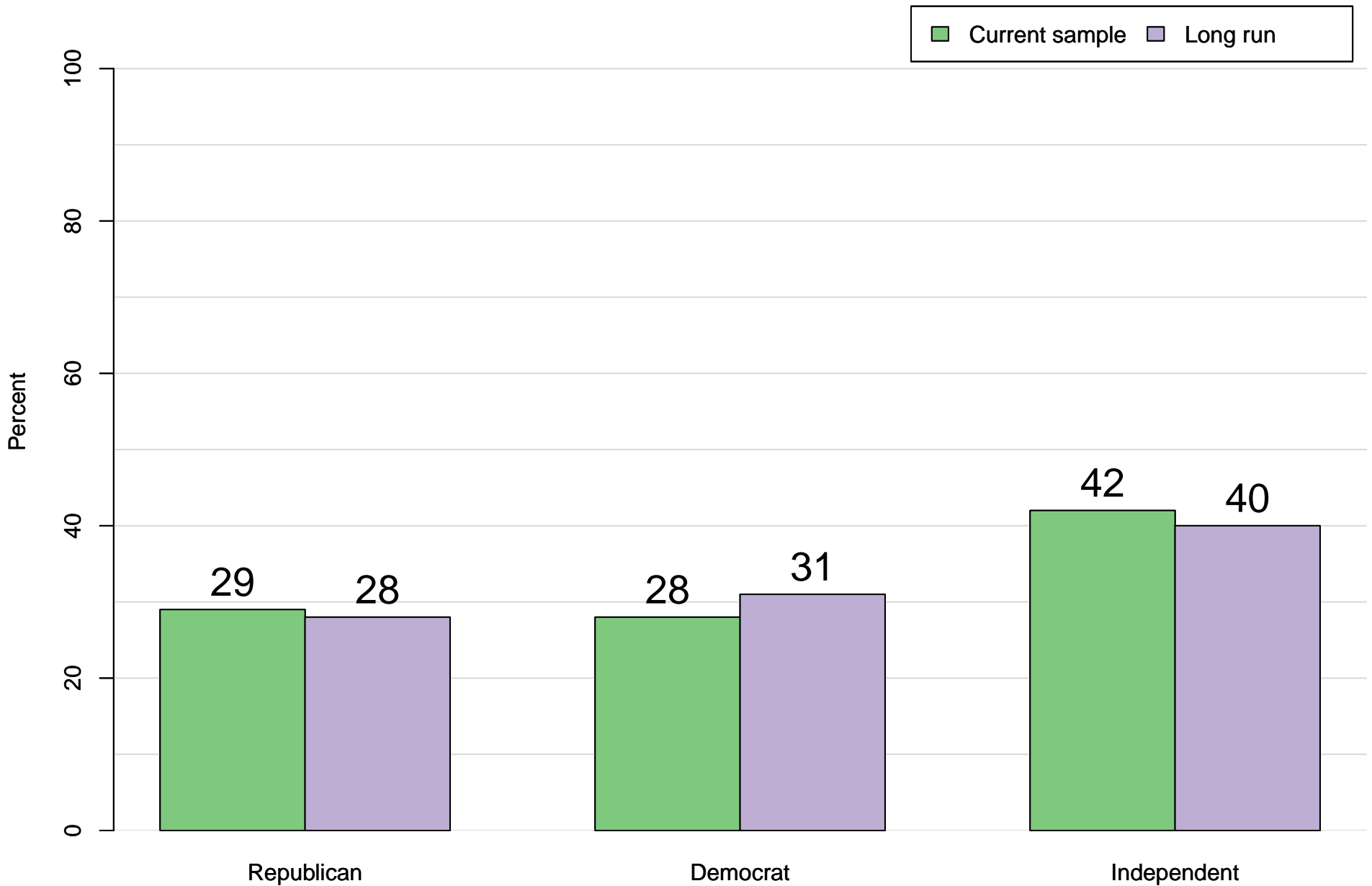

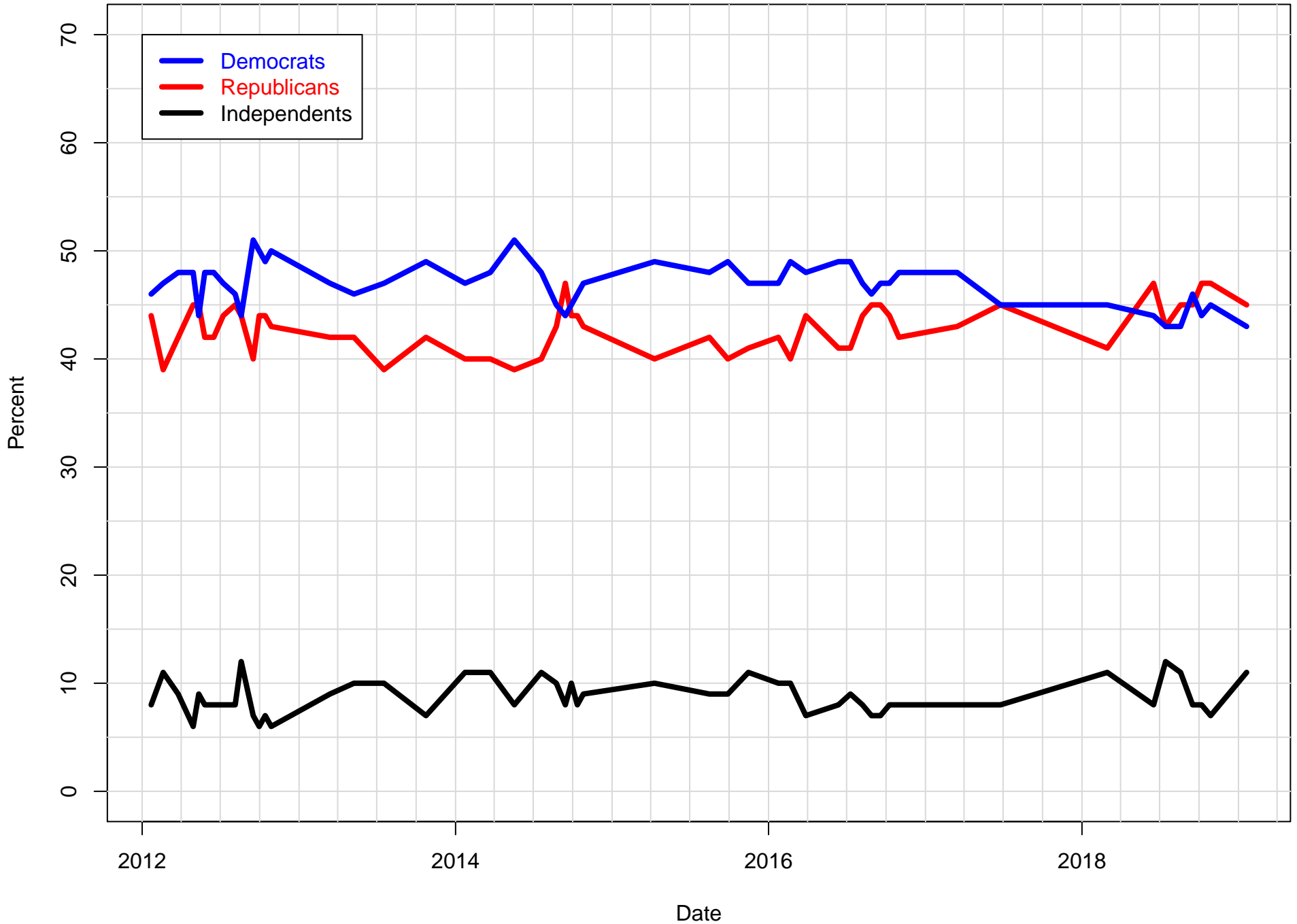
Party ID with Leaners vs Long Run Party ID, Registered Voters January 16–20, 2019



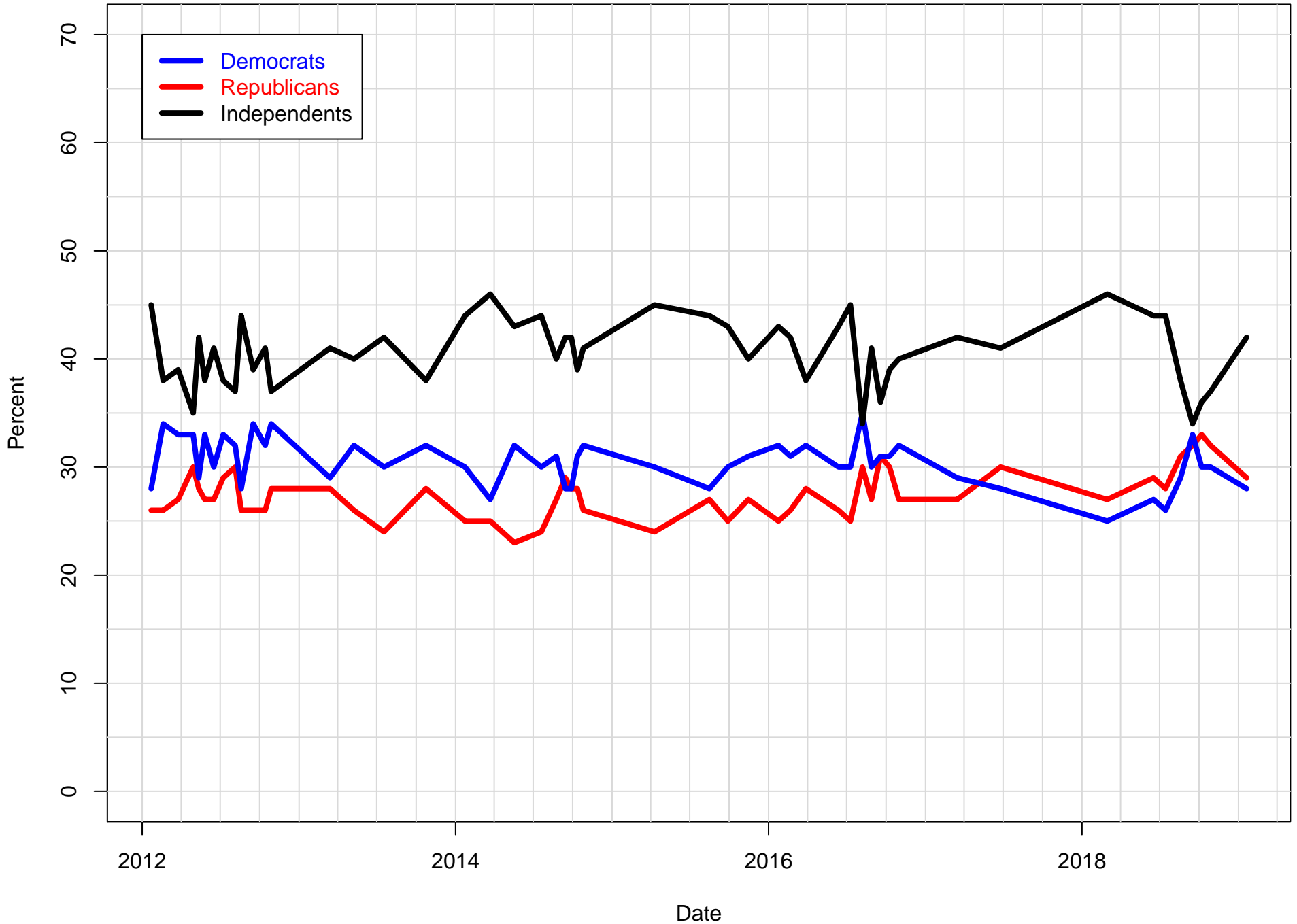
Party ID without Leaners vs Long Run Party ID, Registered Voters January 16–20, 2019



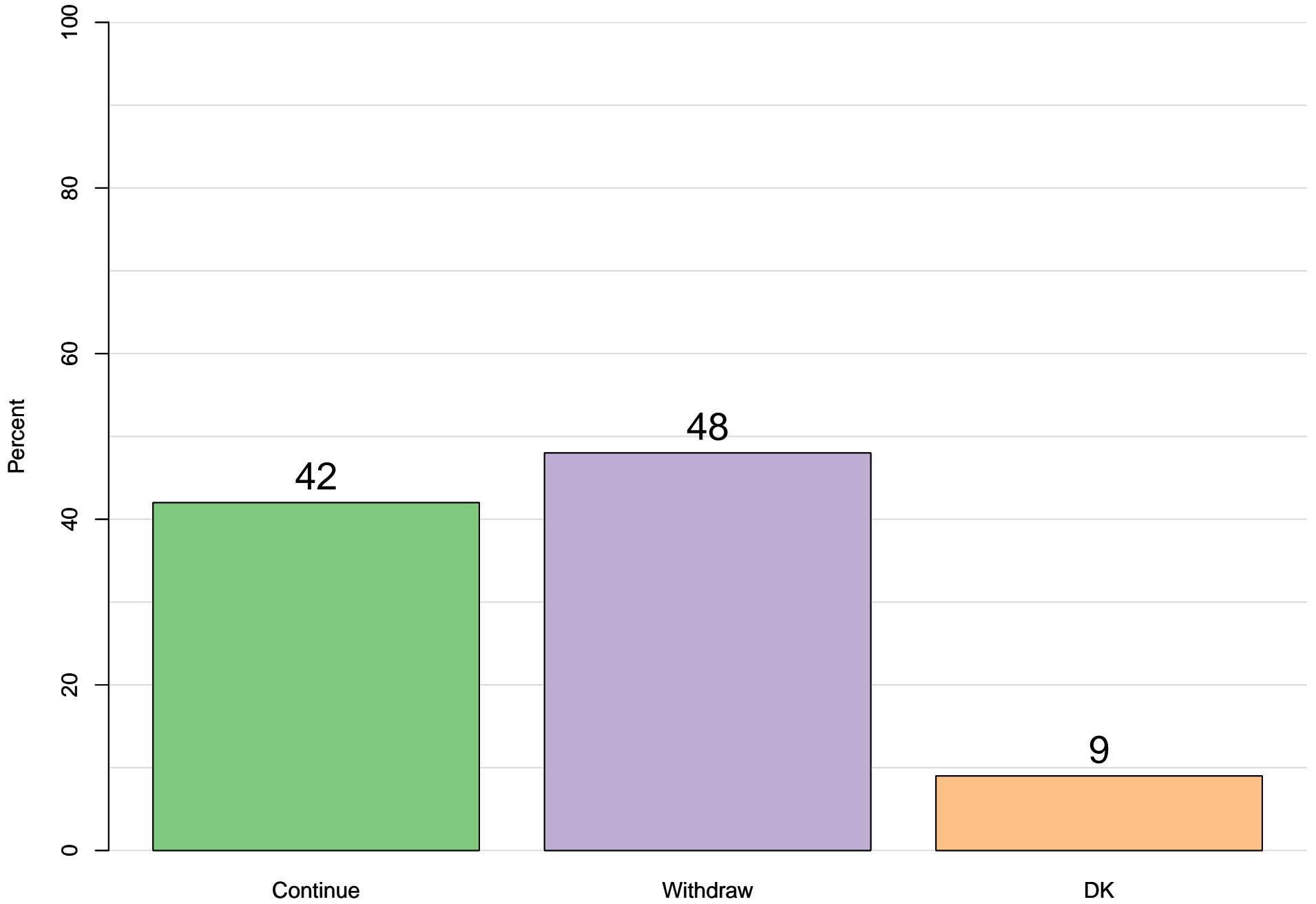
Trend in Party ID with leaners, Registered Voters, 2012–2019



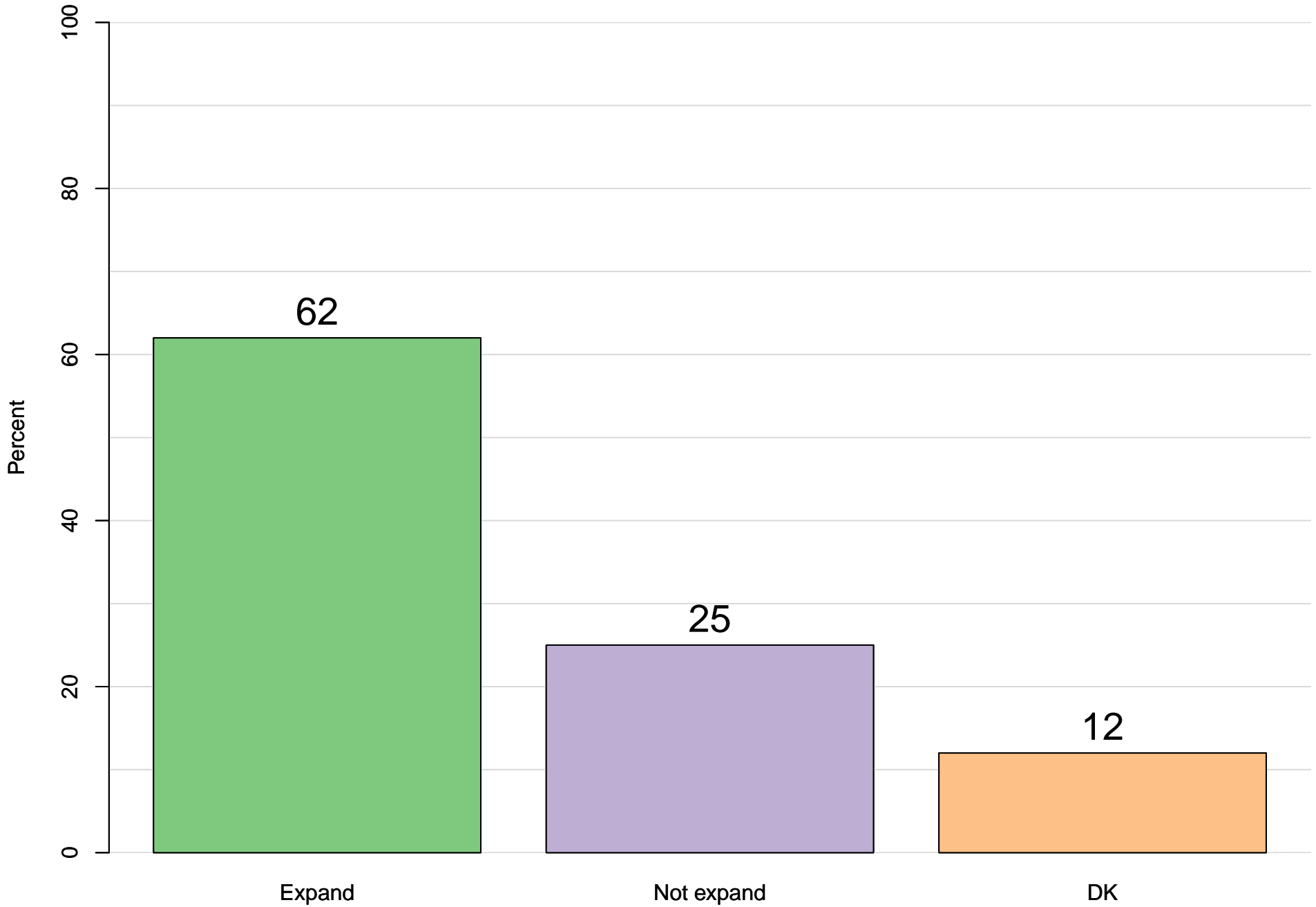
Trend in Party ID without leaners, Registered Voters, 2012–2019



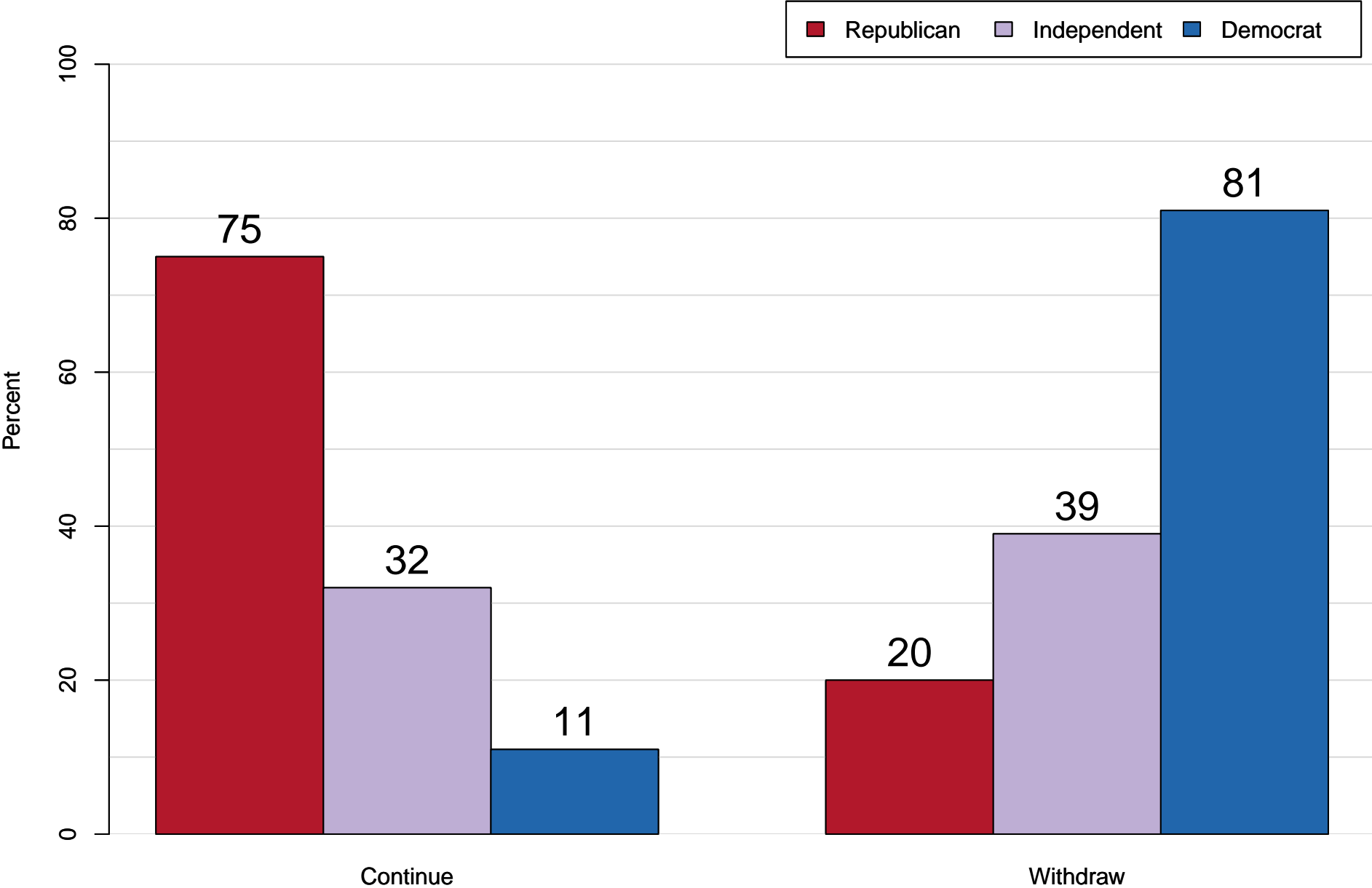

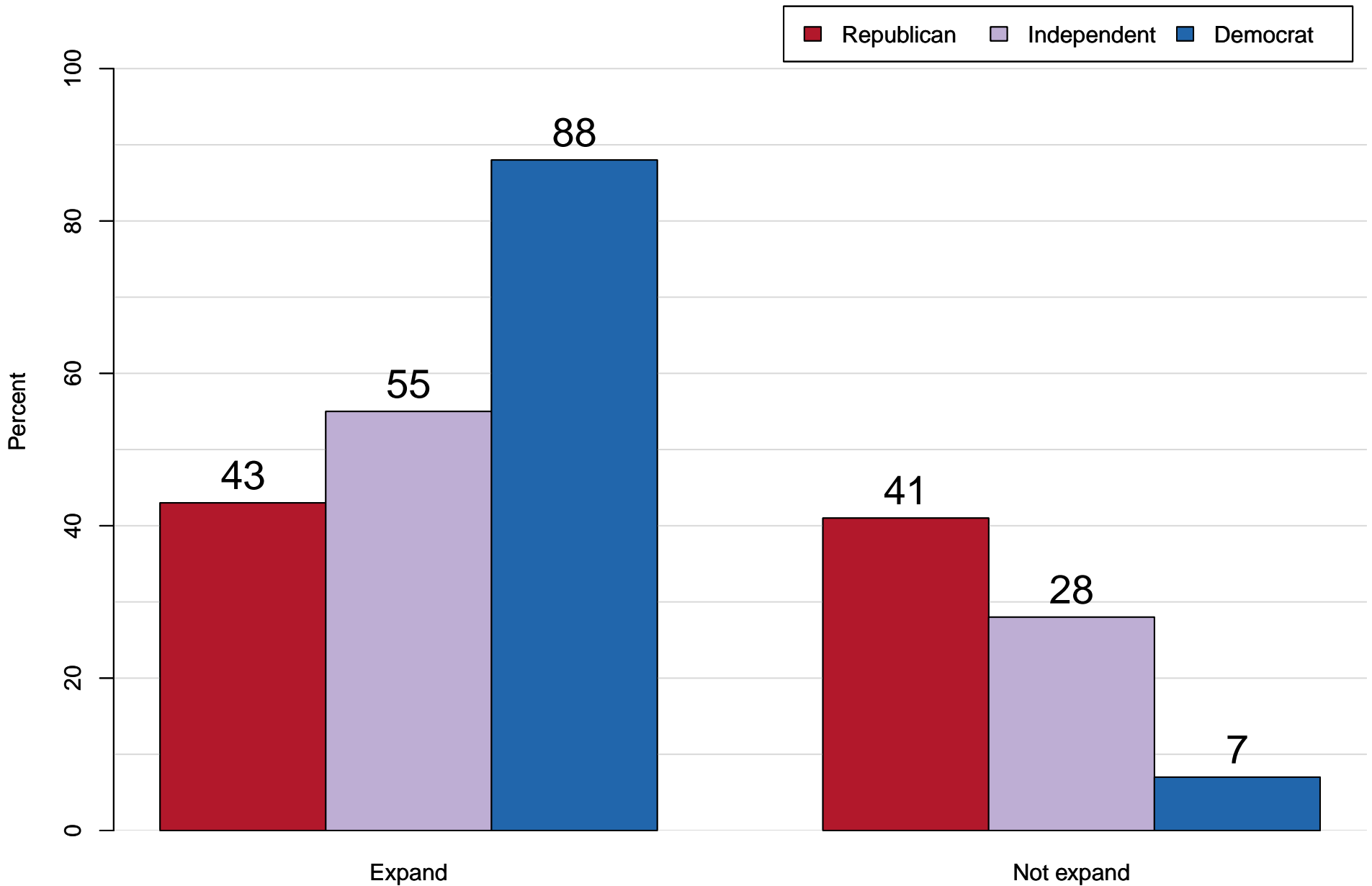

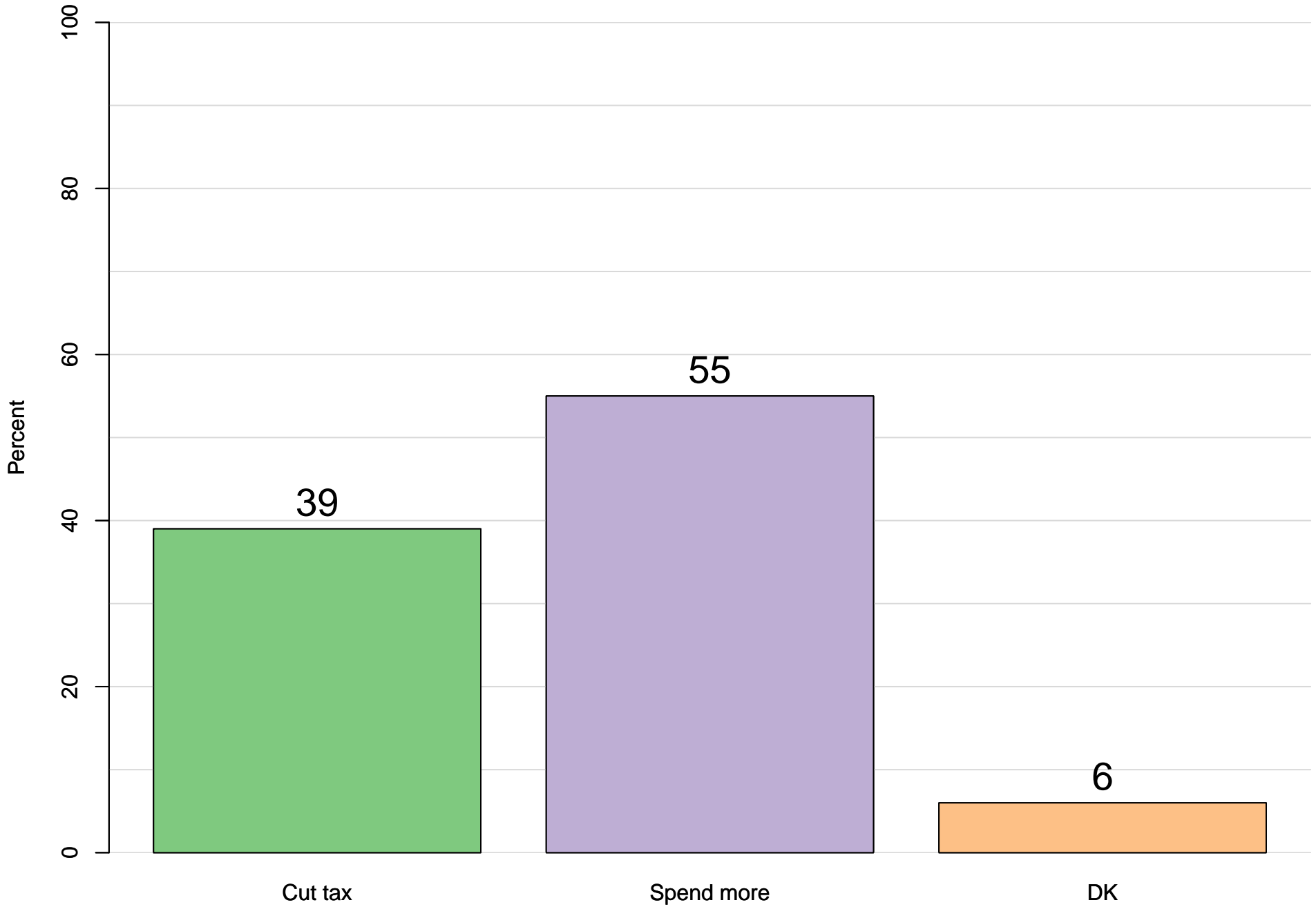

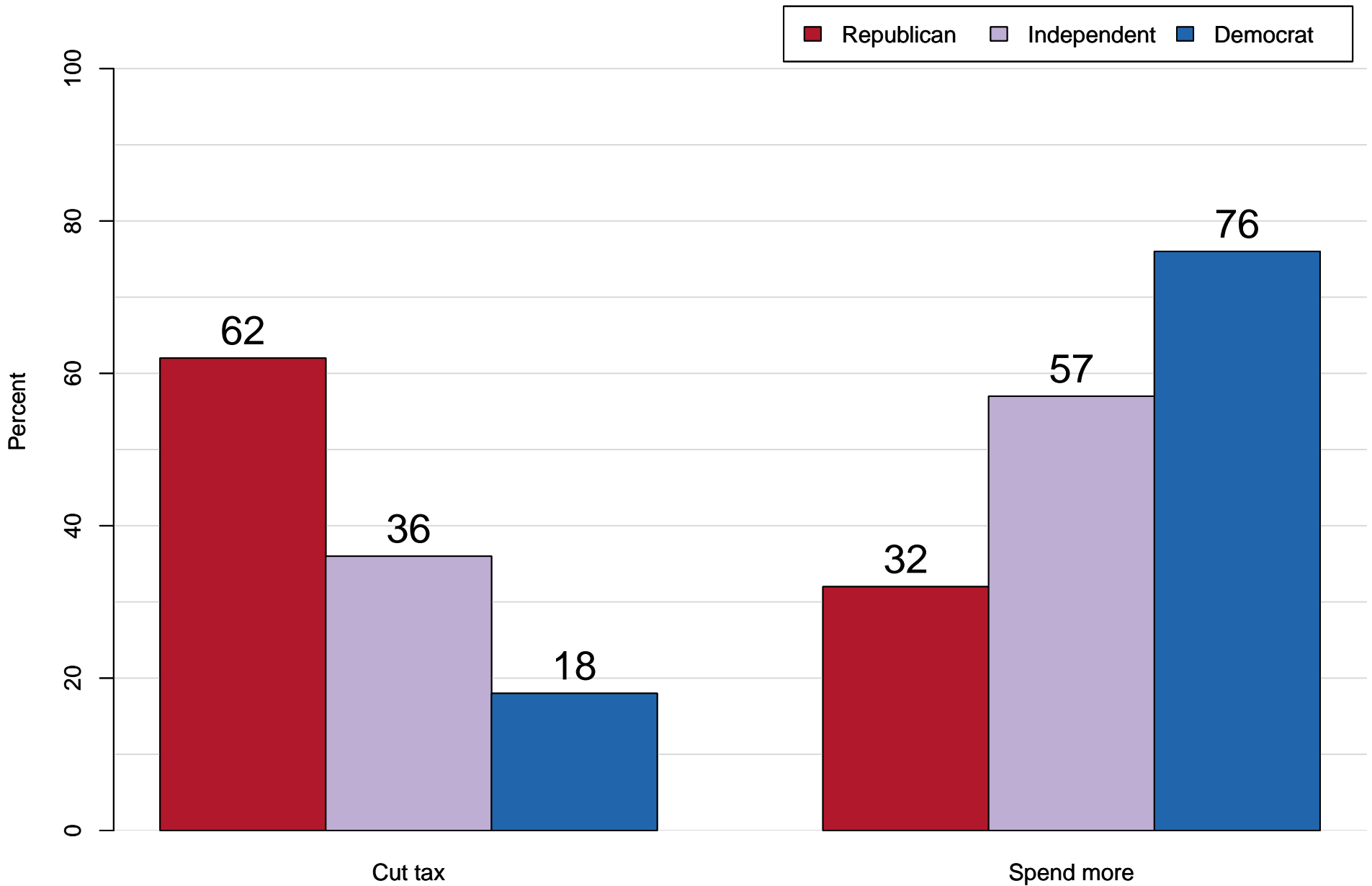

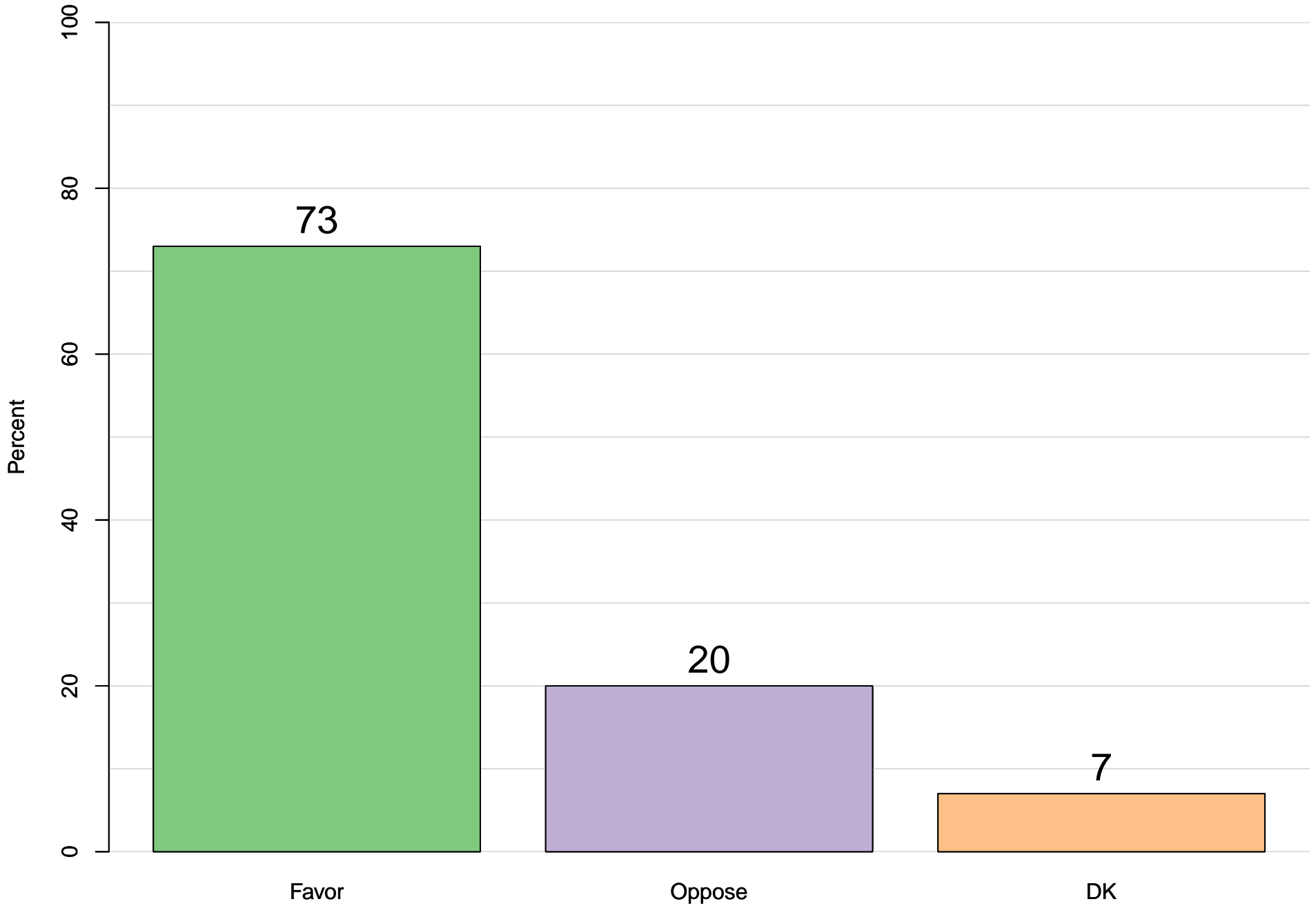


Cut property taxes or increase school spending by Party ID

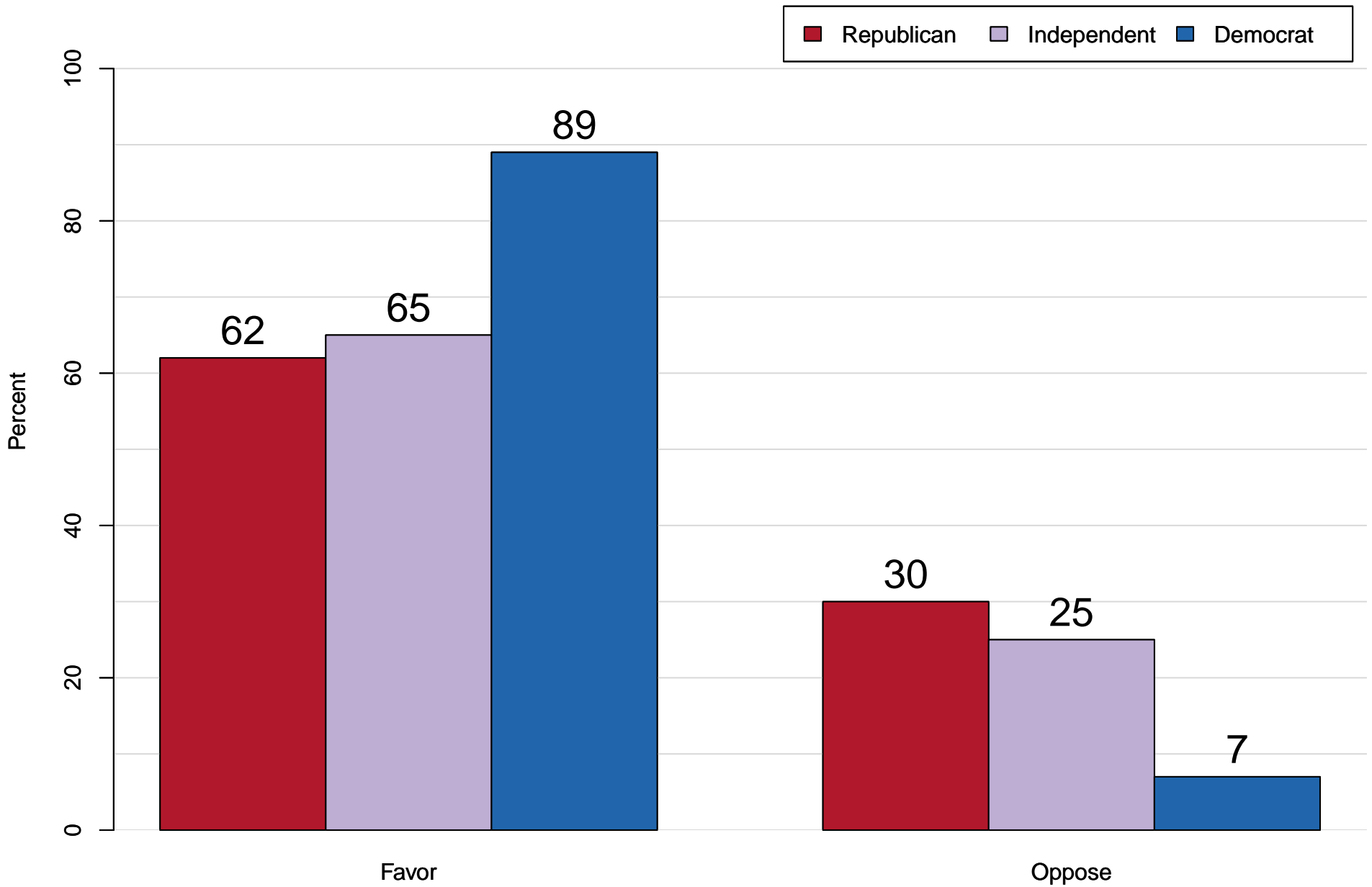

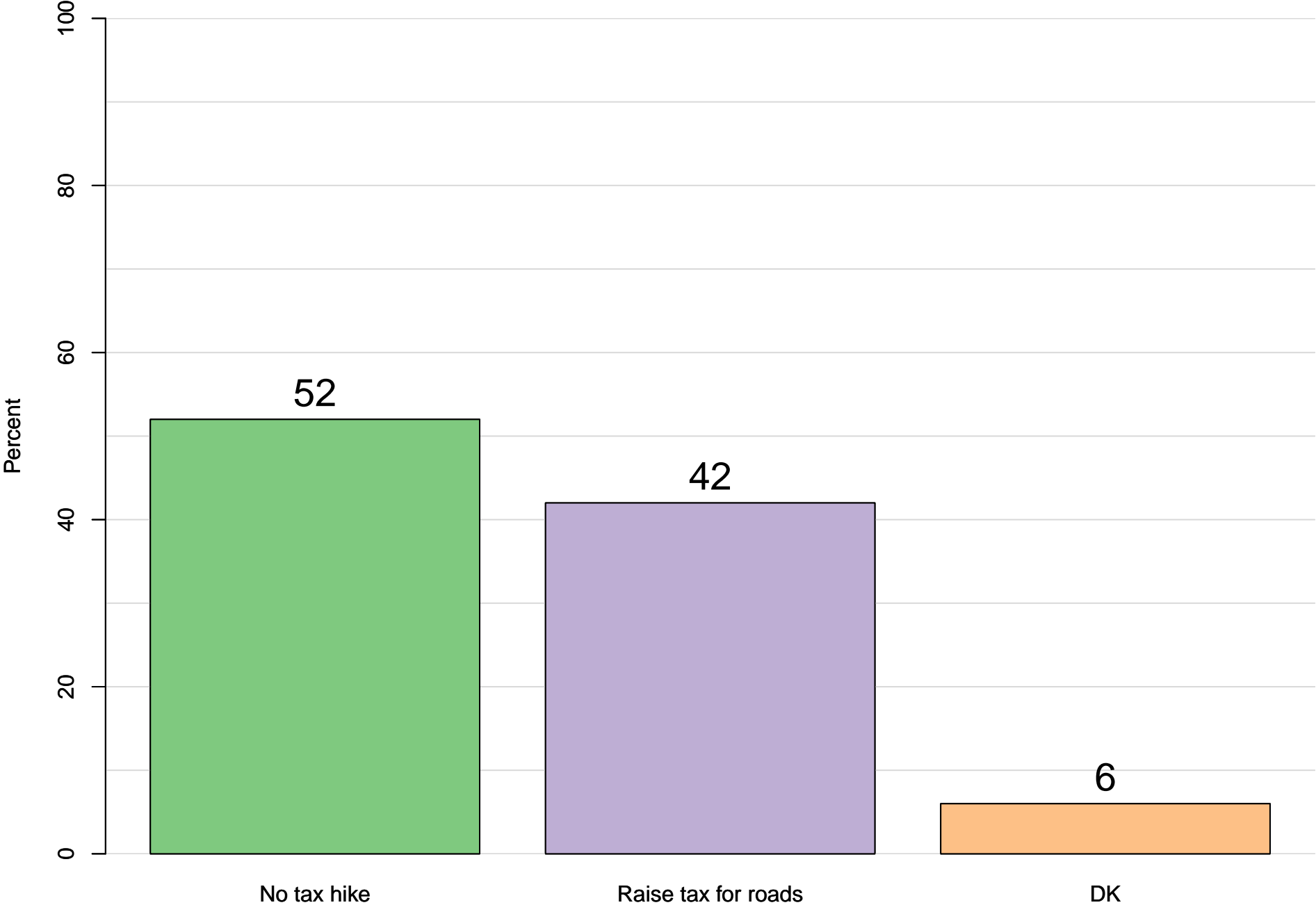


Favor or oppose major increase in aid for special education by Party ID

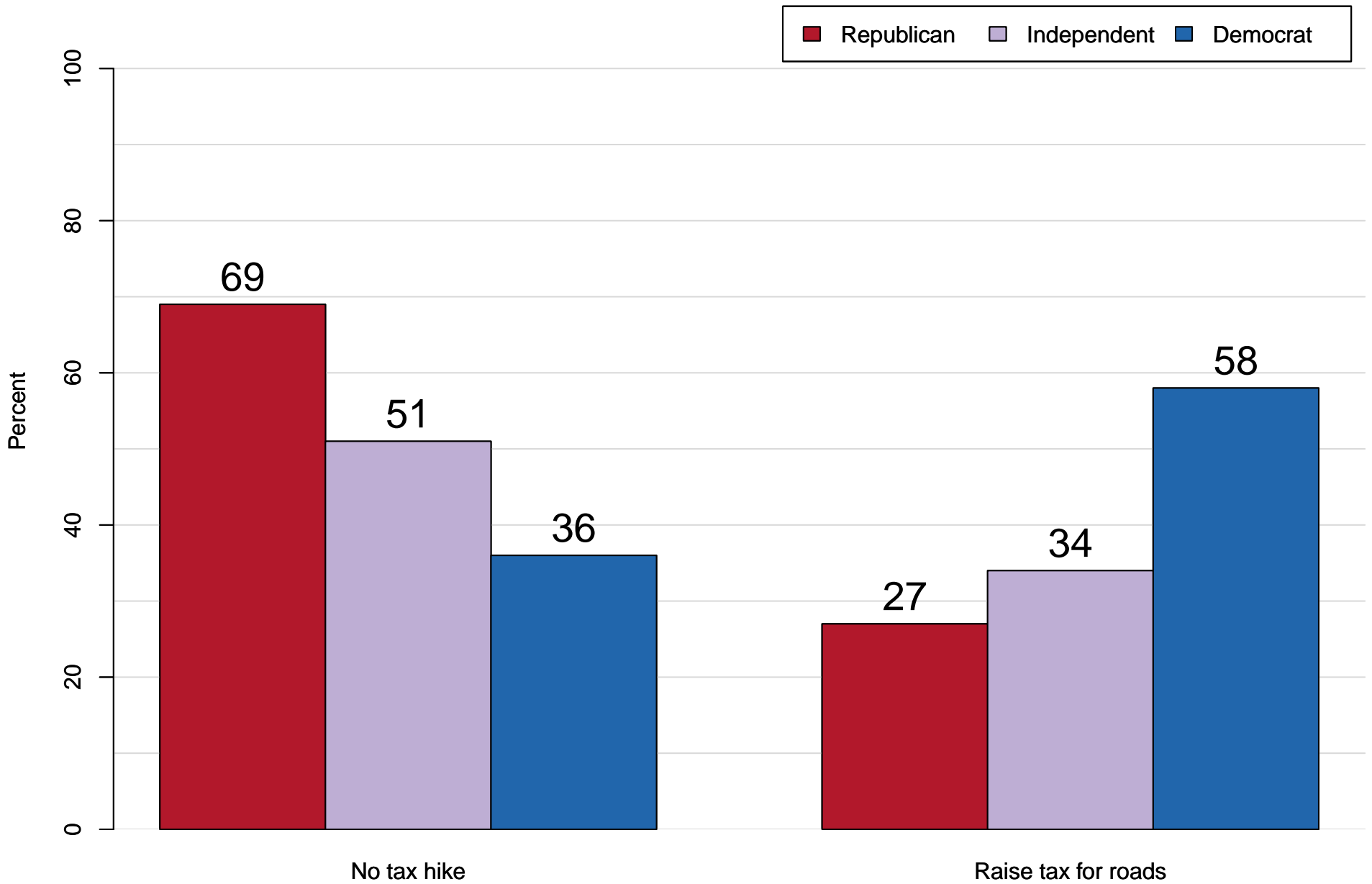

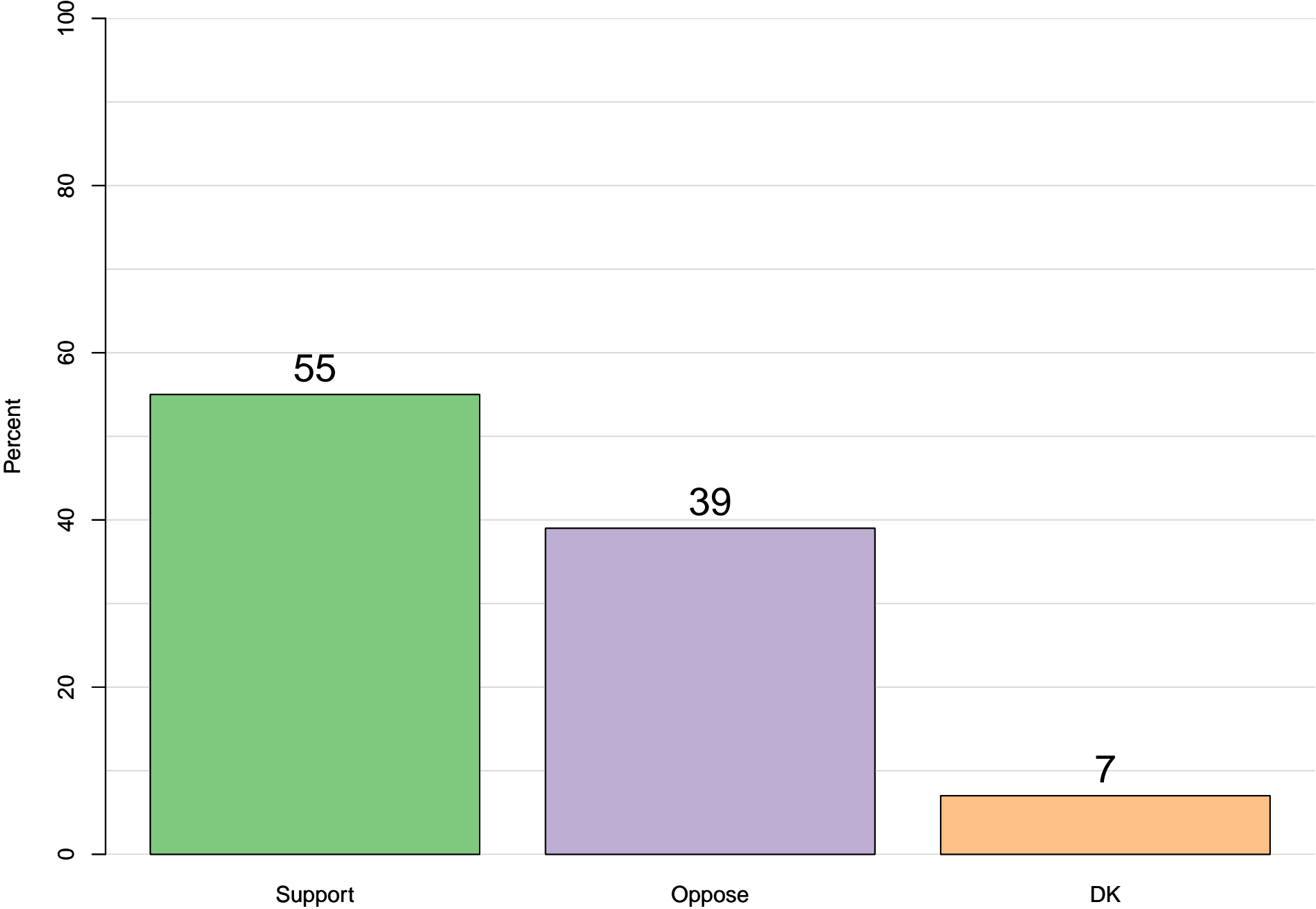

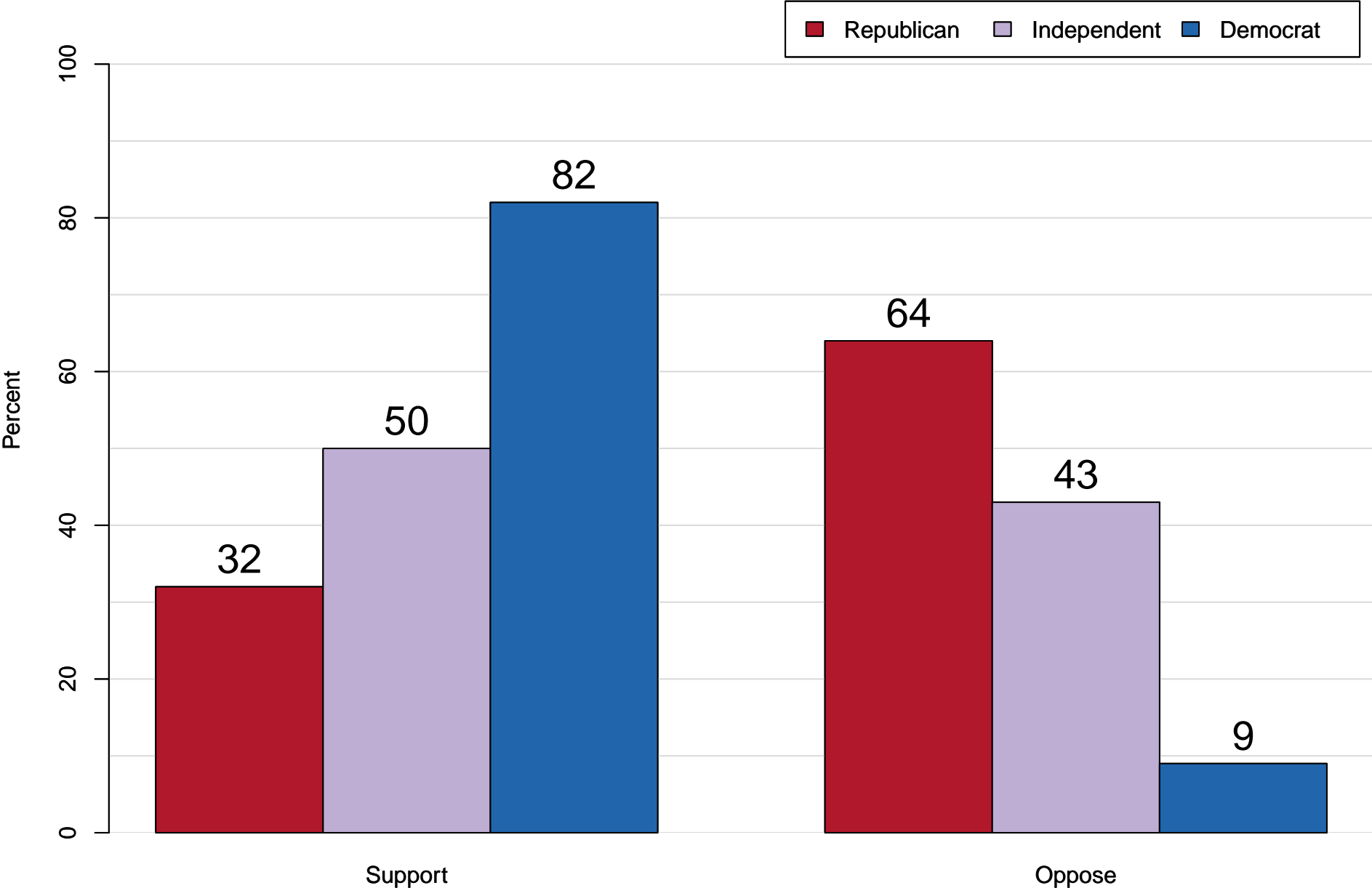

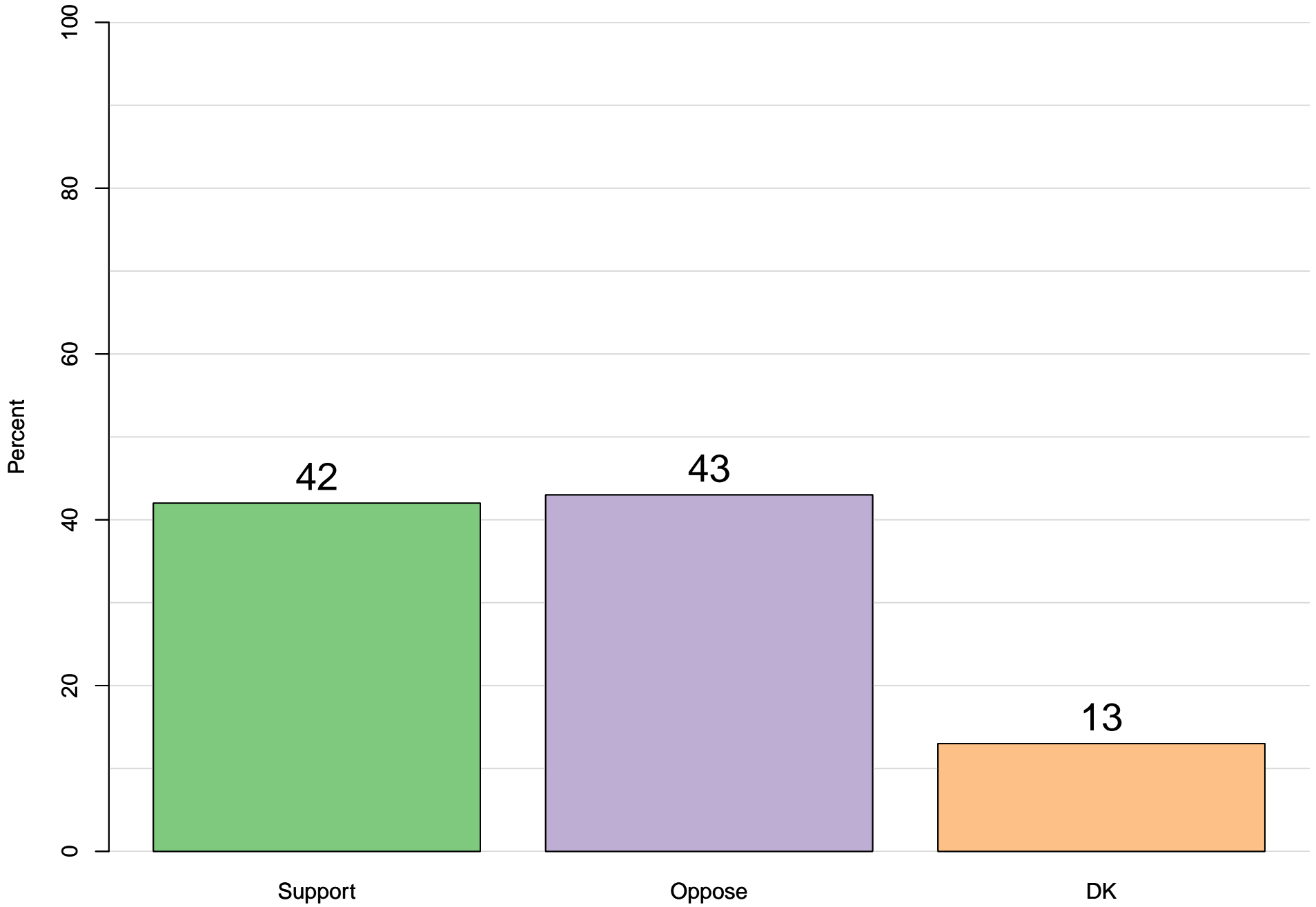

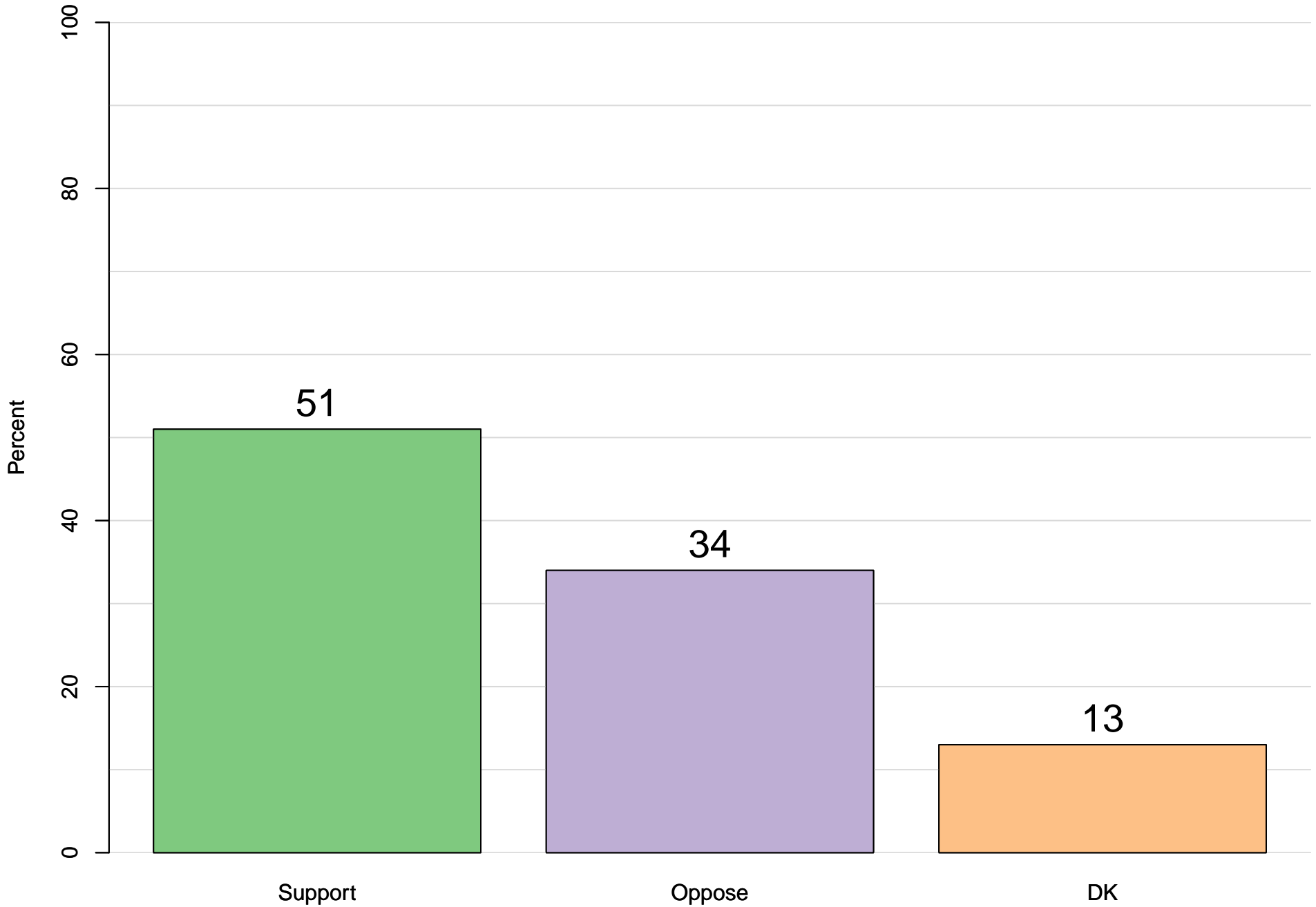

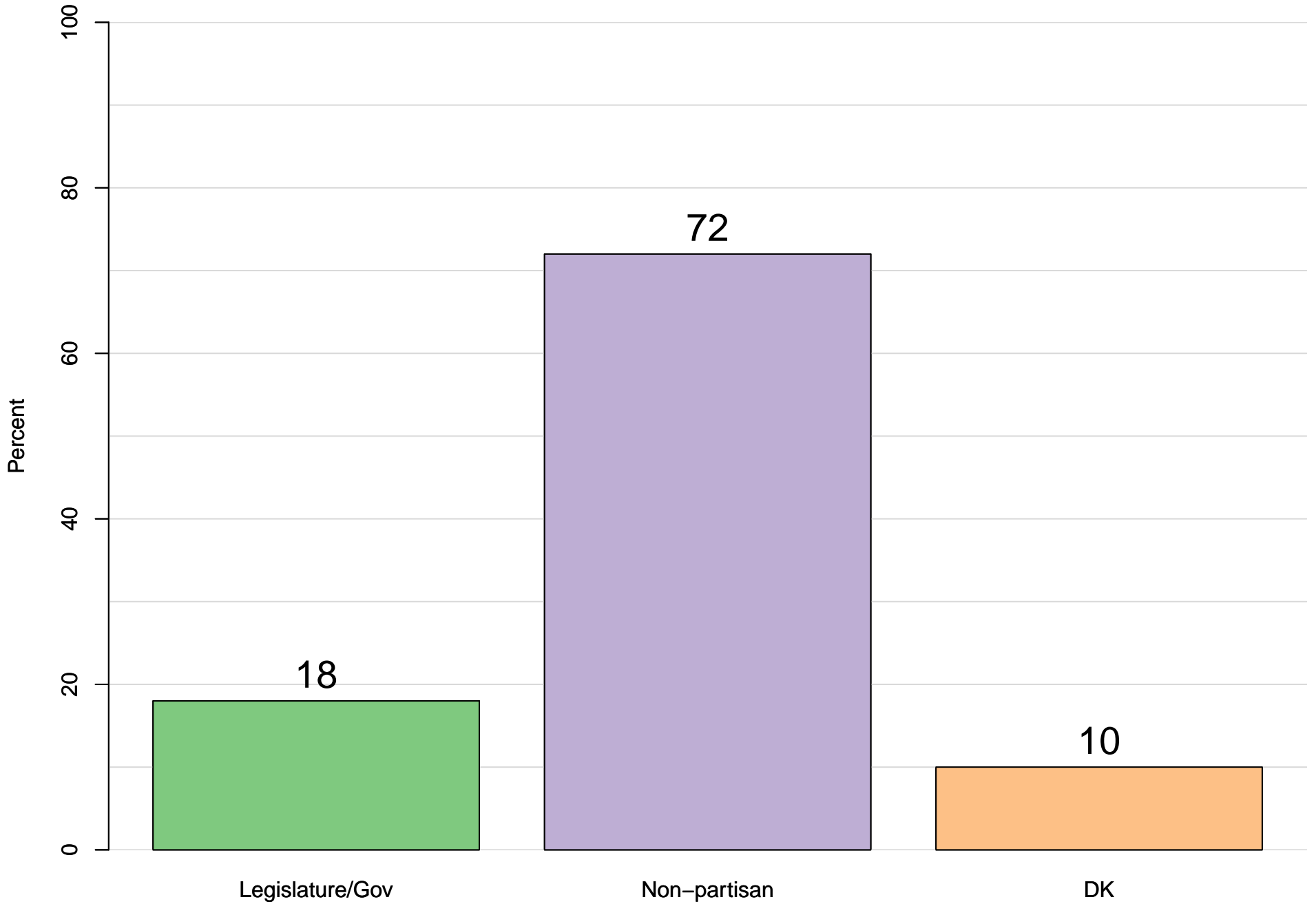

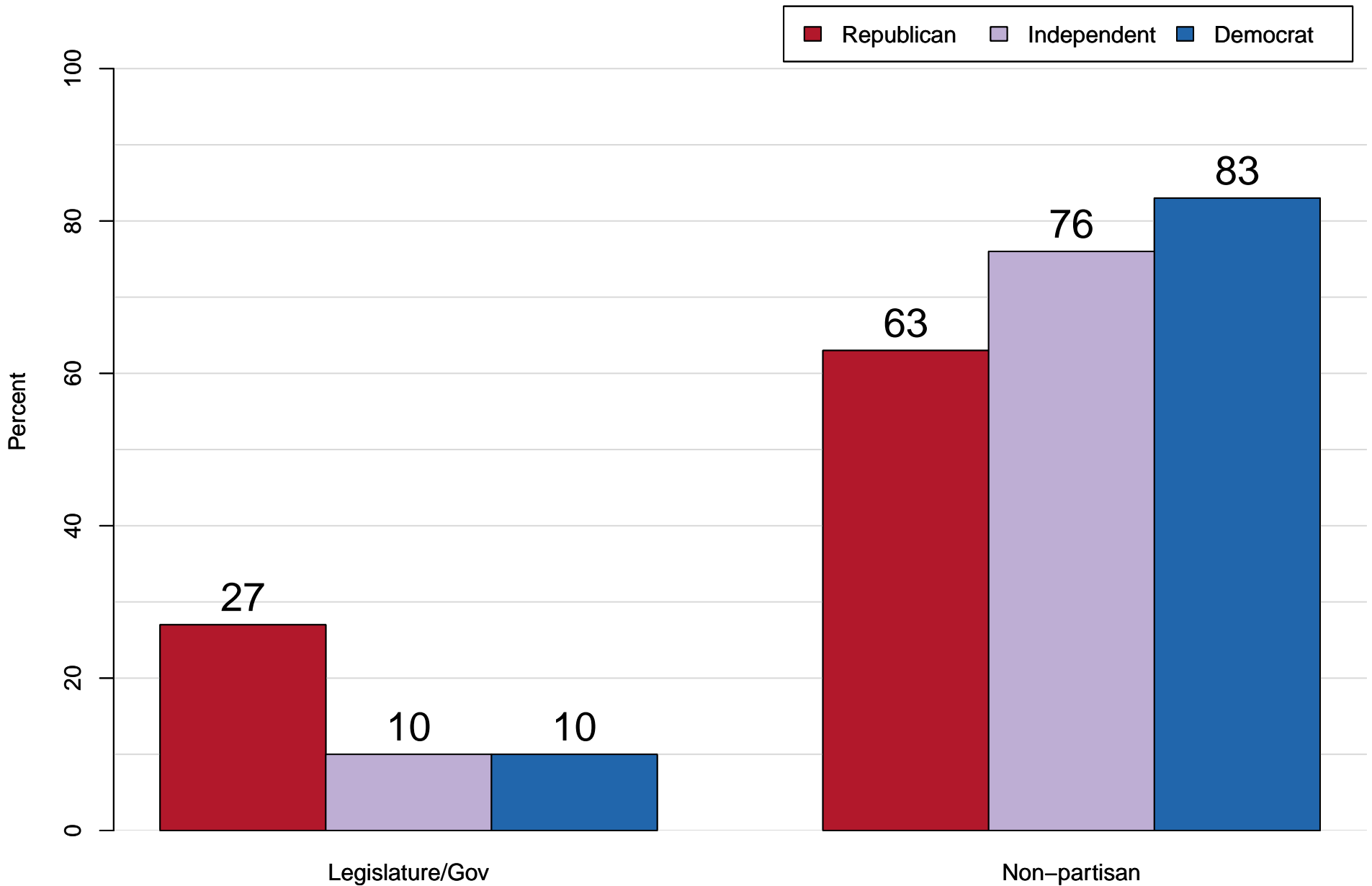

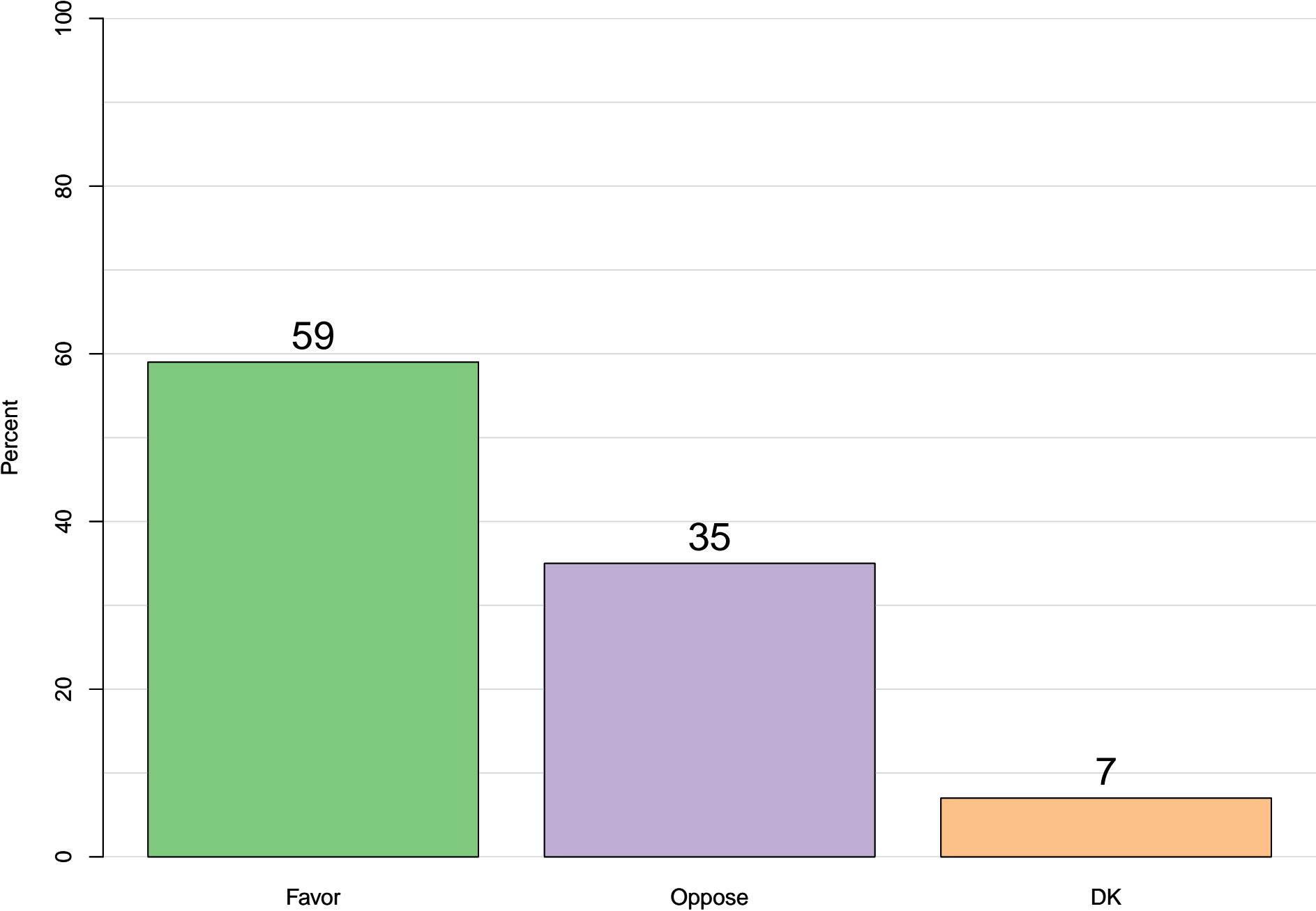

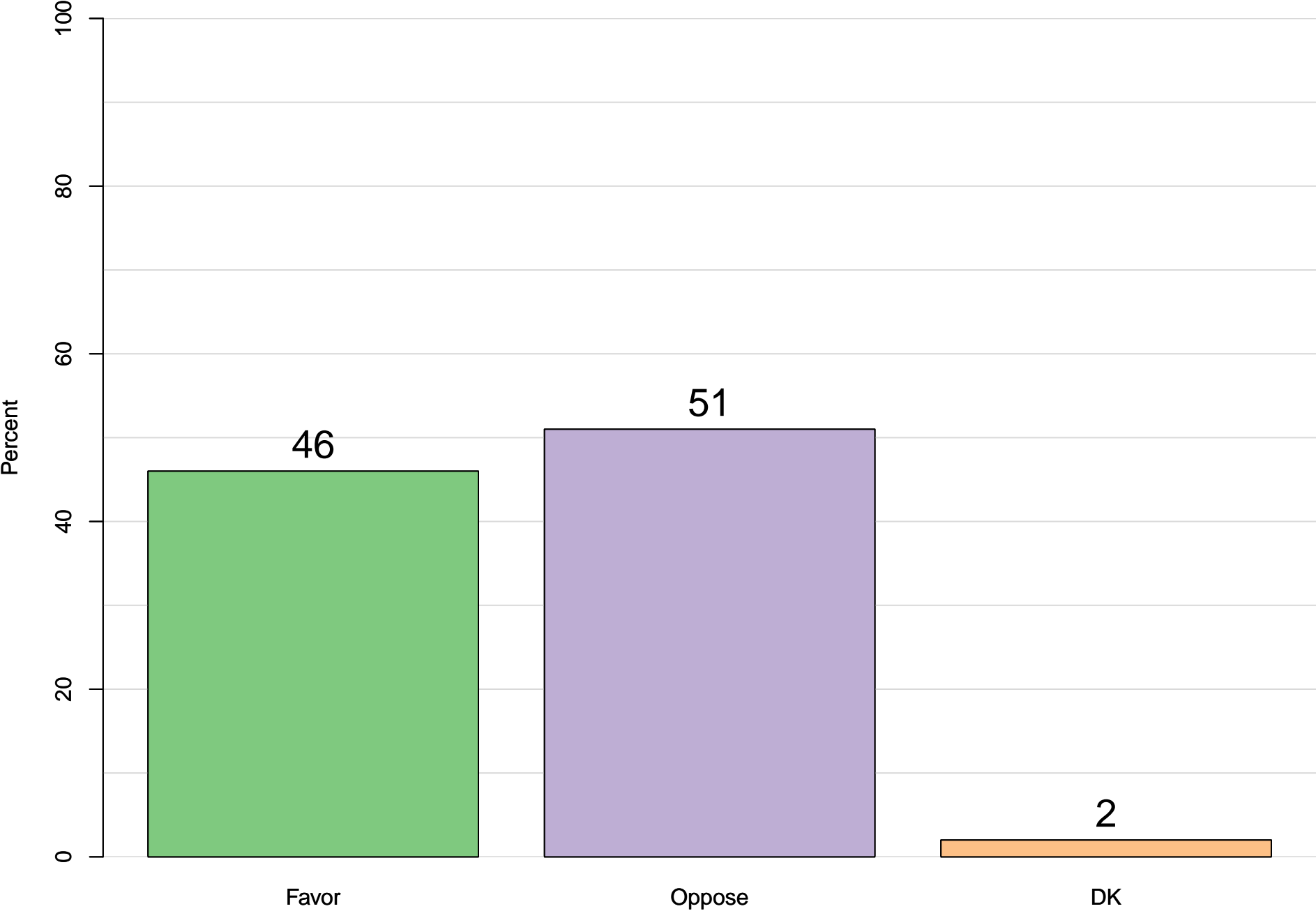

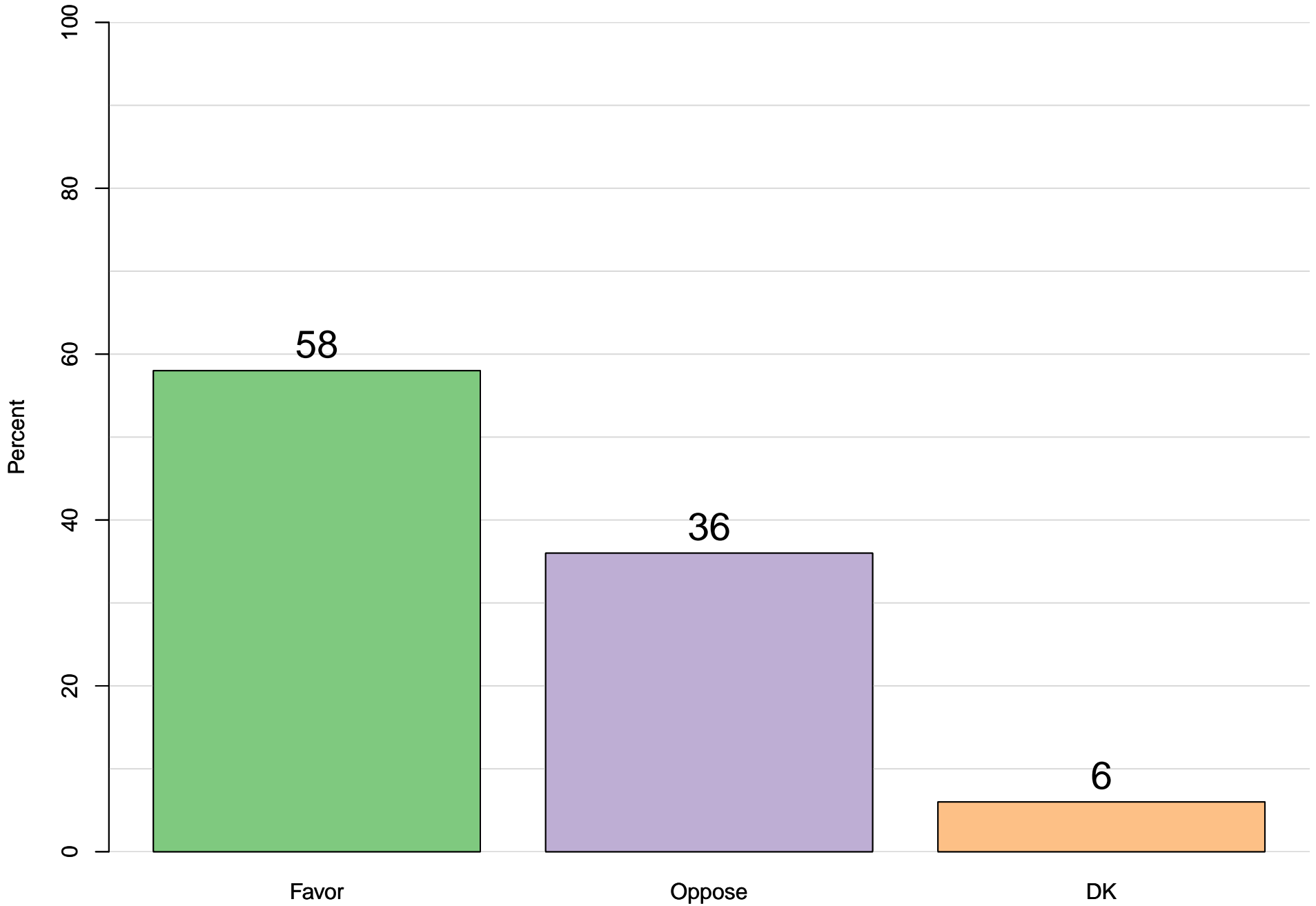

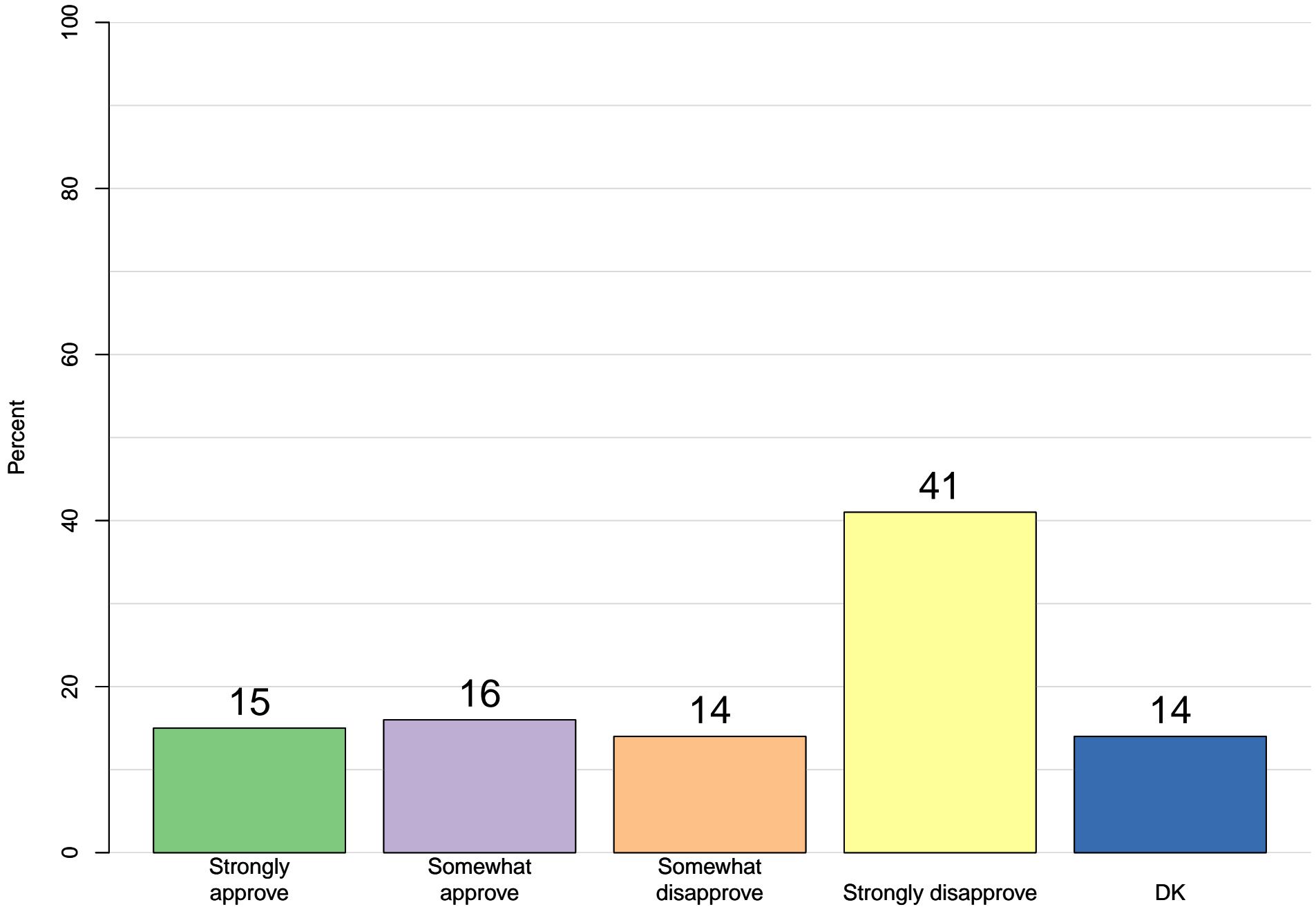

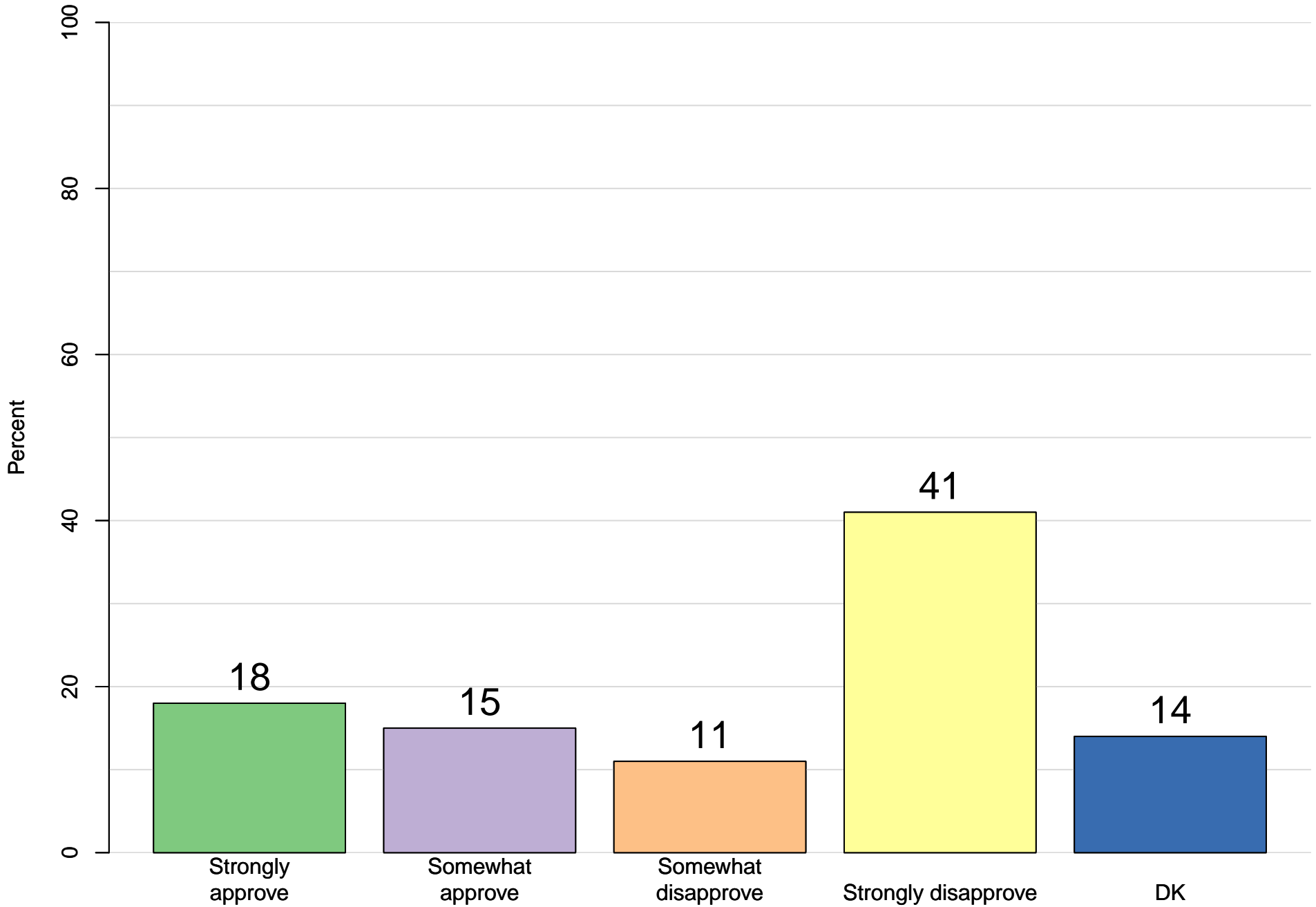

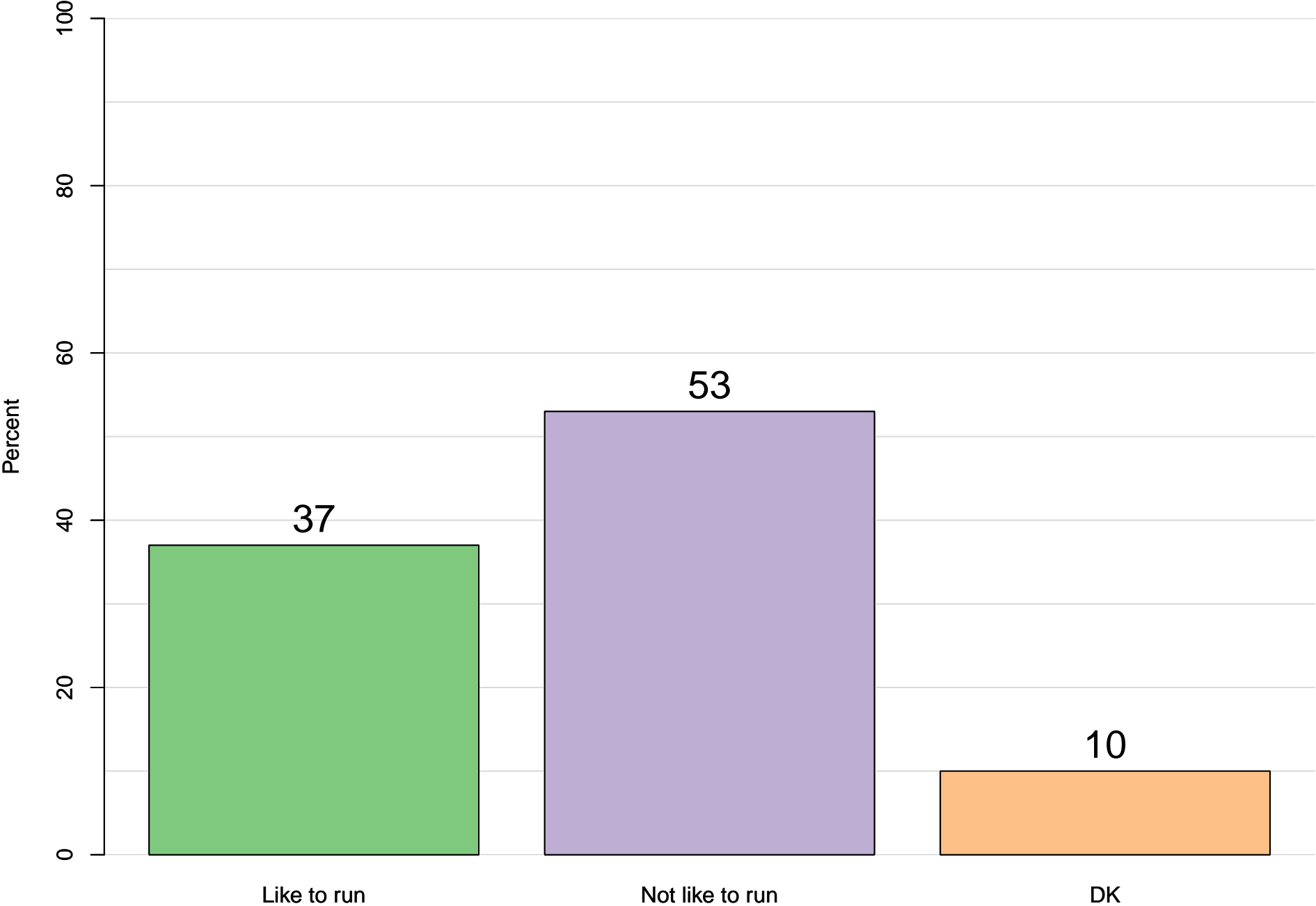

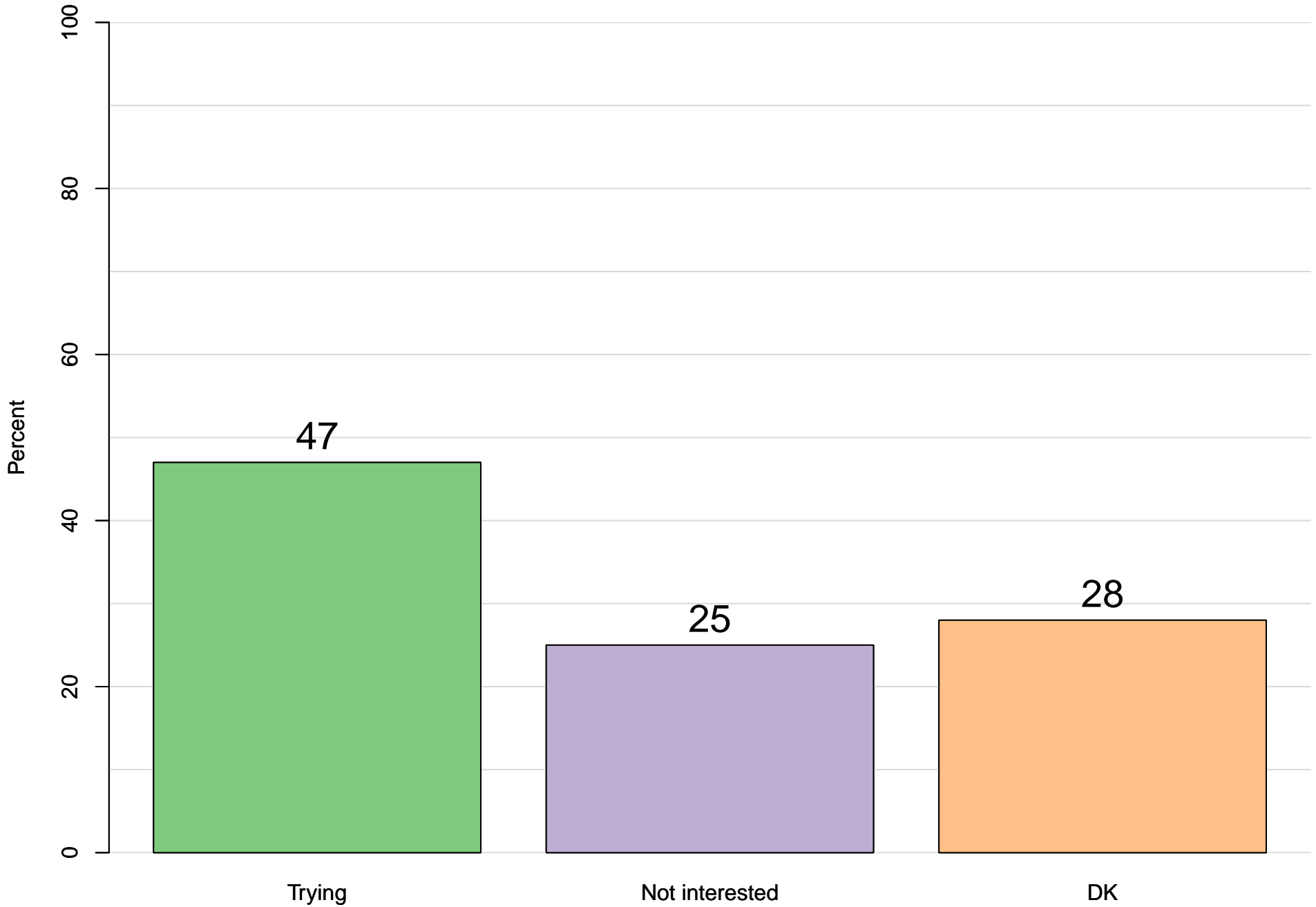

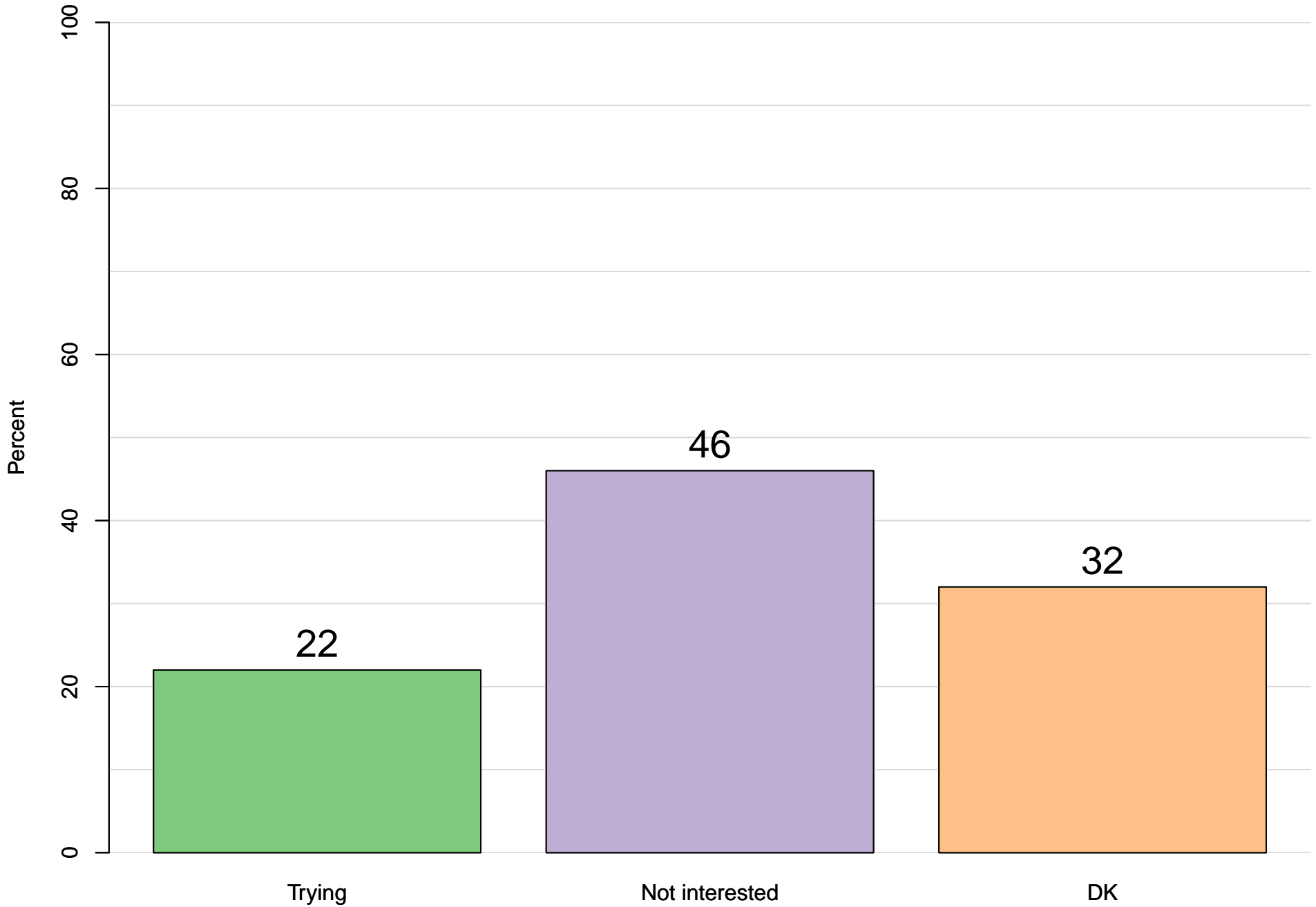

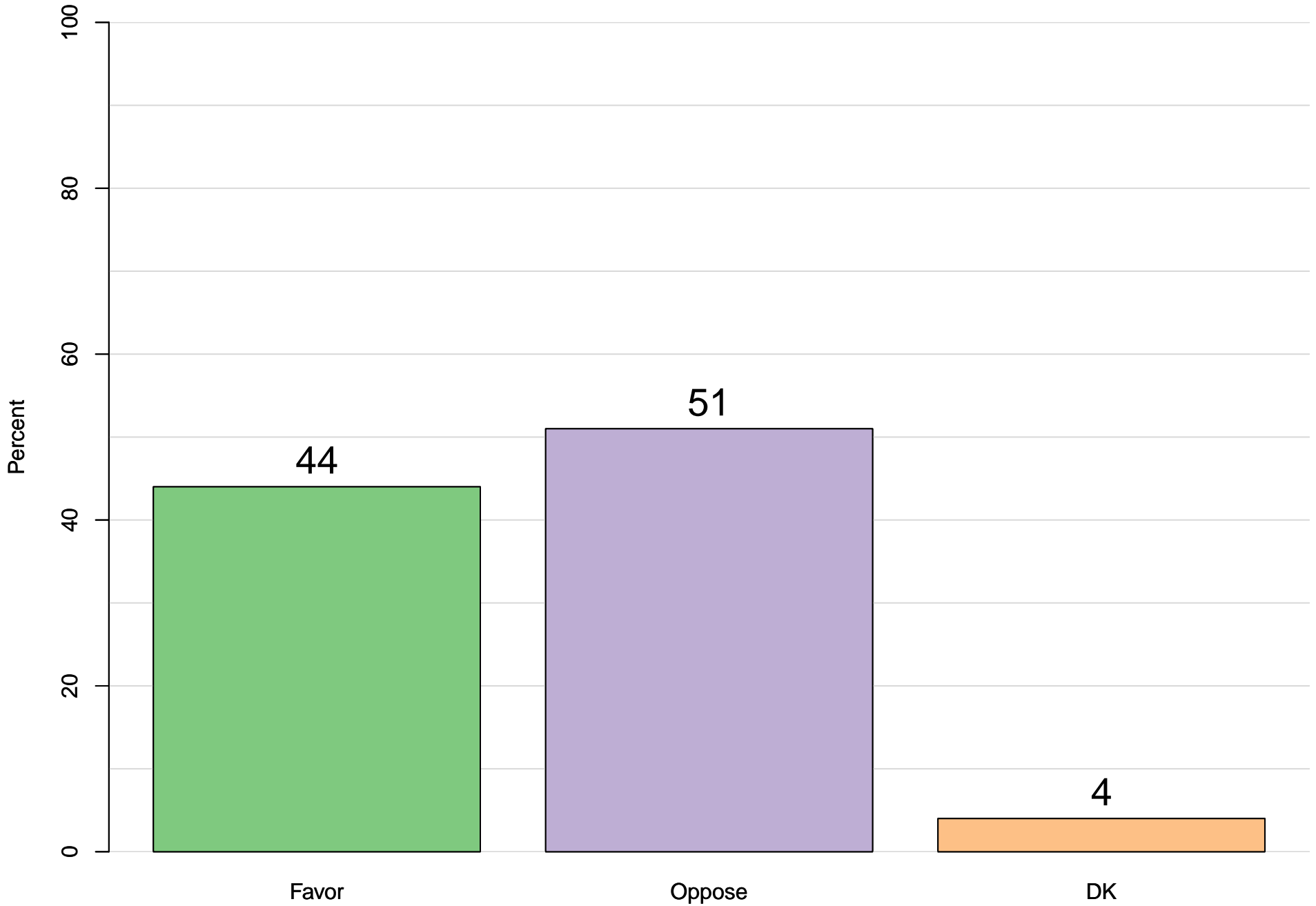

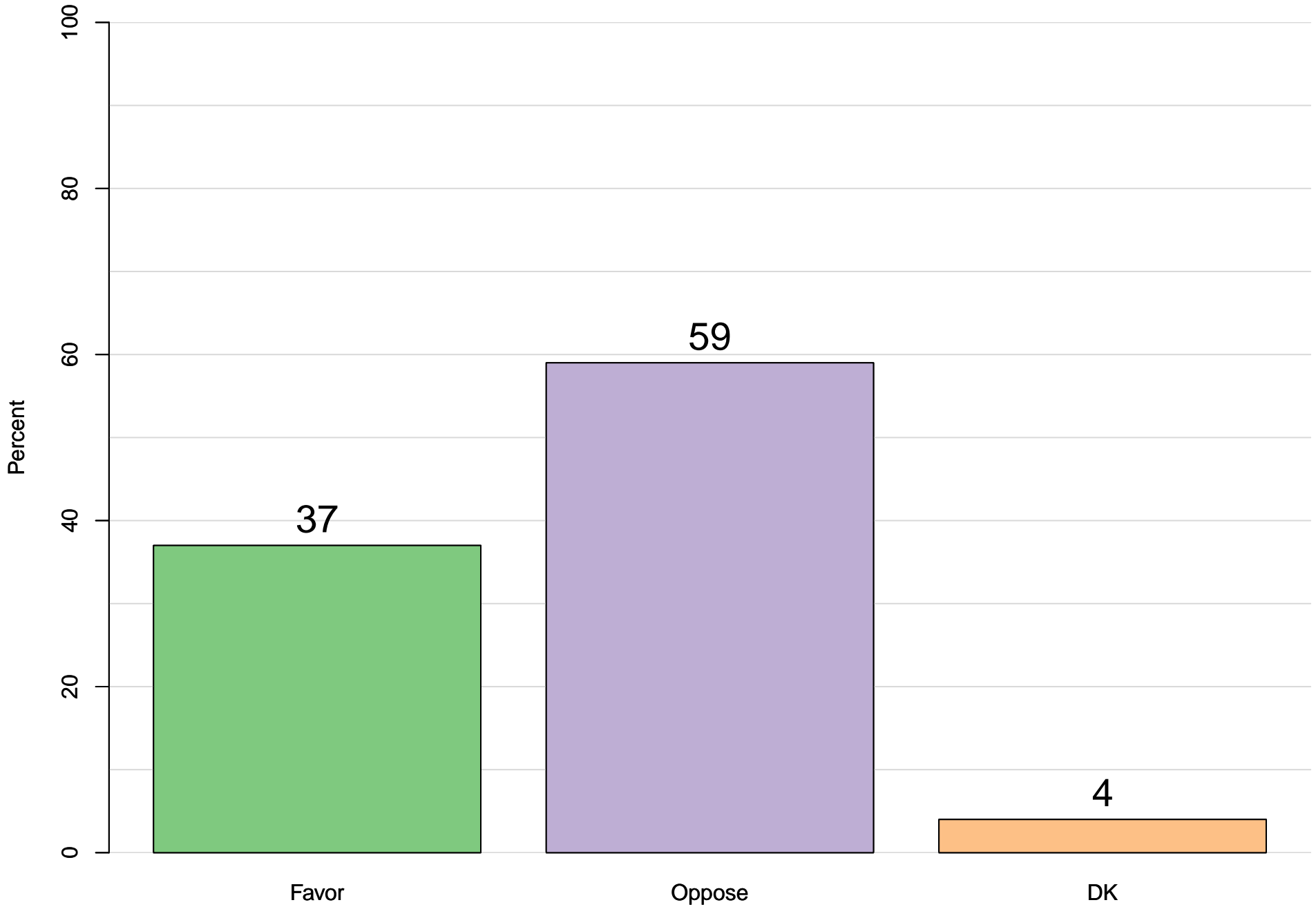


Favor or oppose building wall along Mexican border

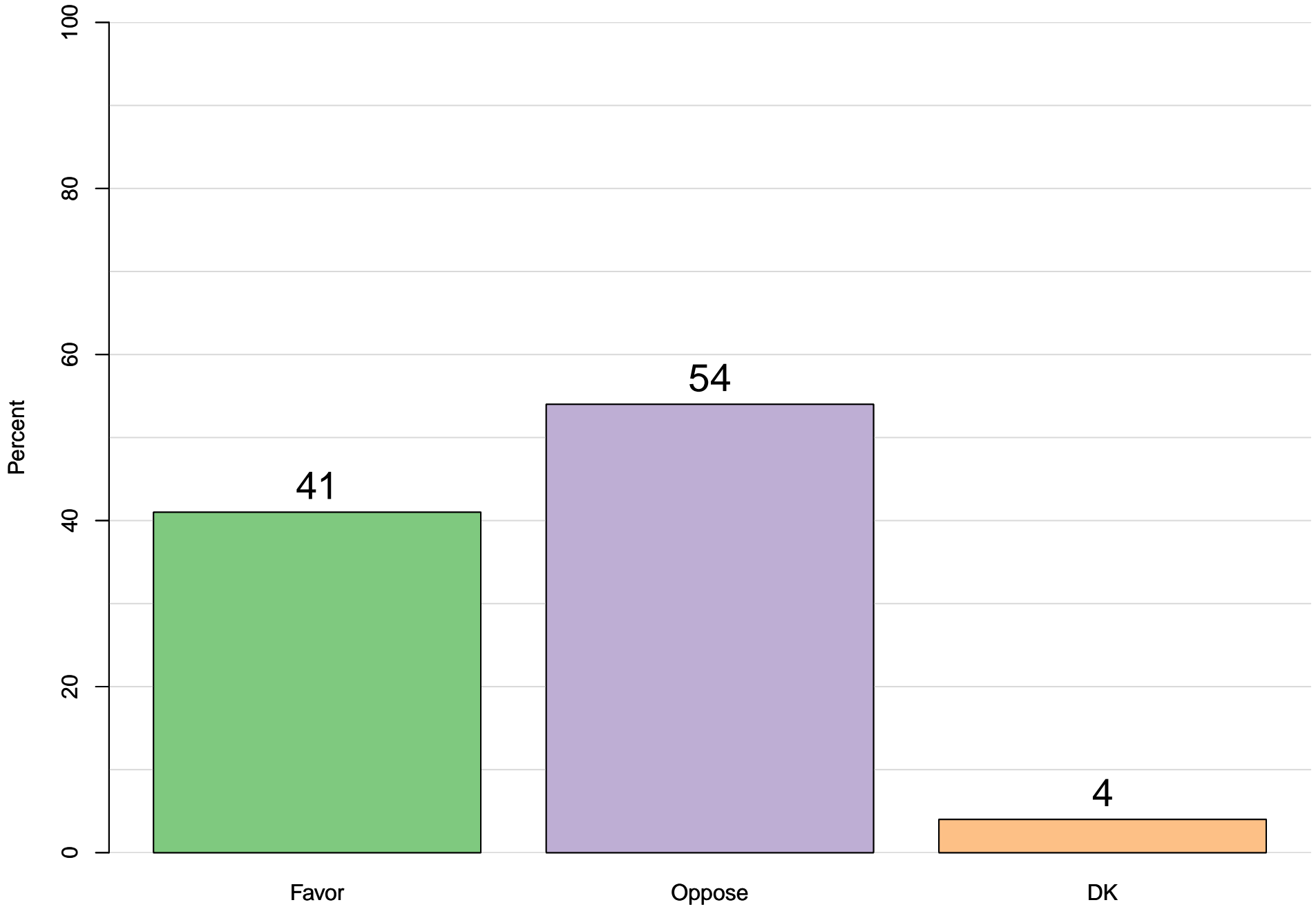

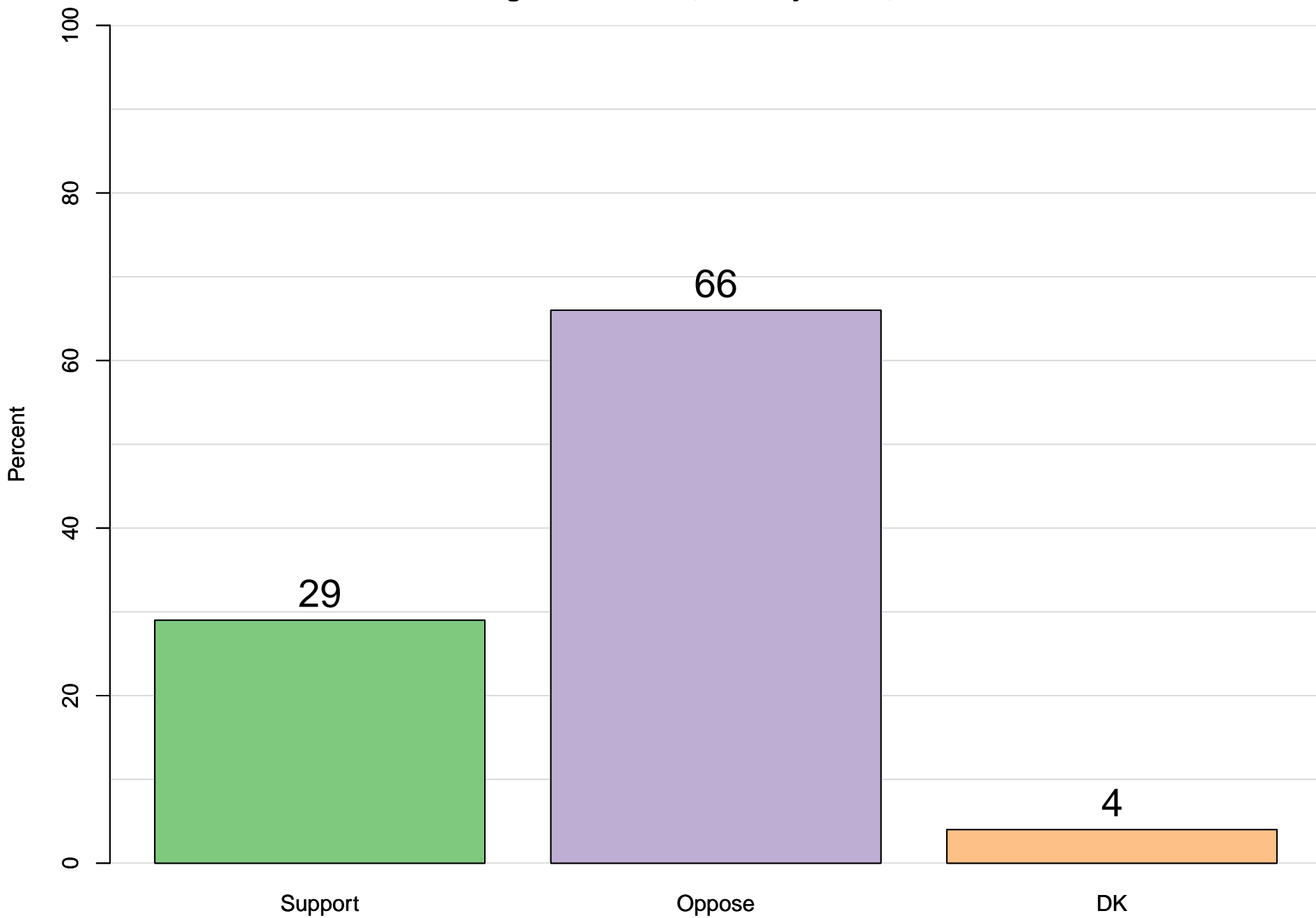

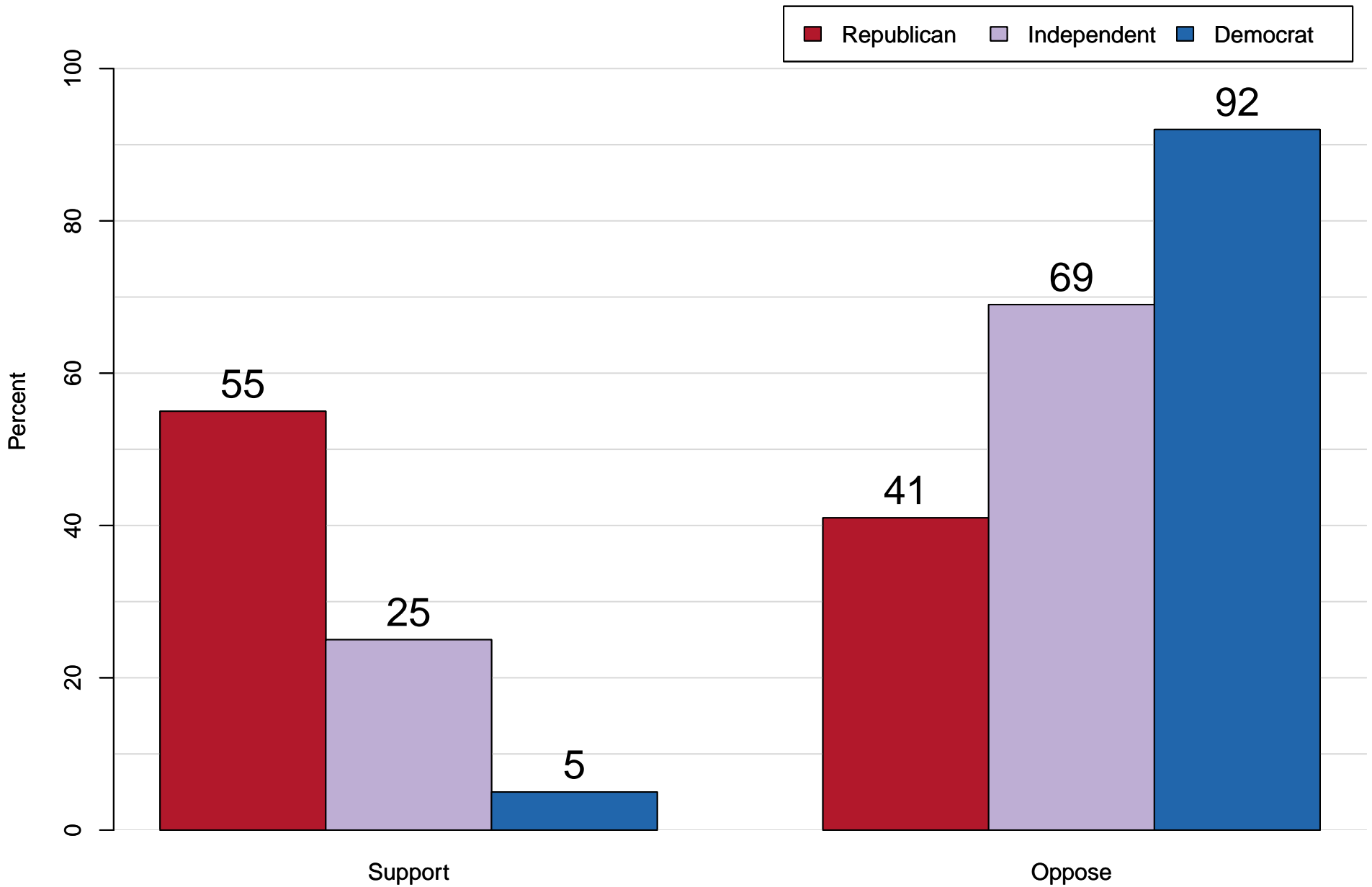
Support or oppose partial government shutdown over border wall

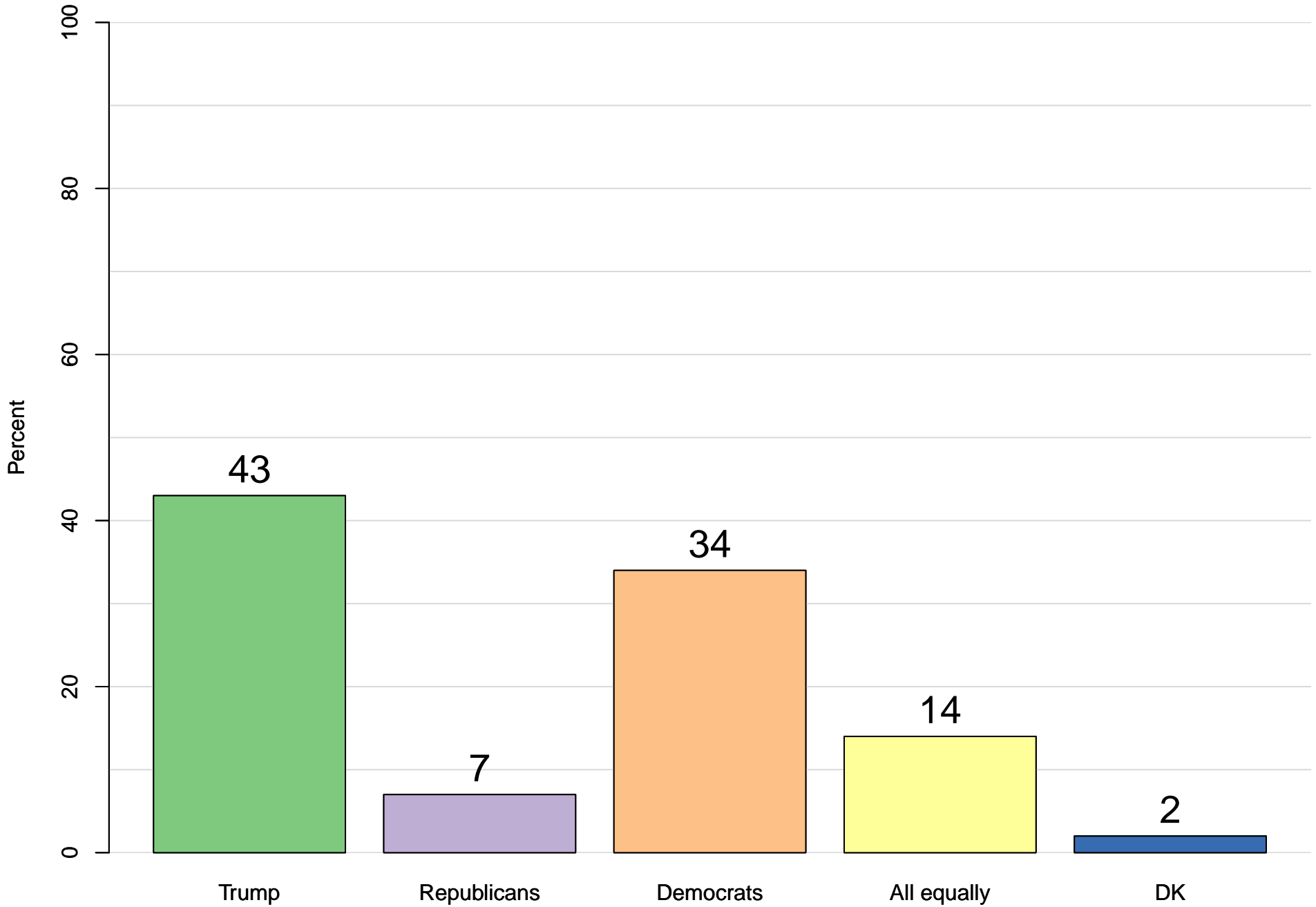

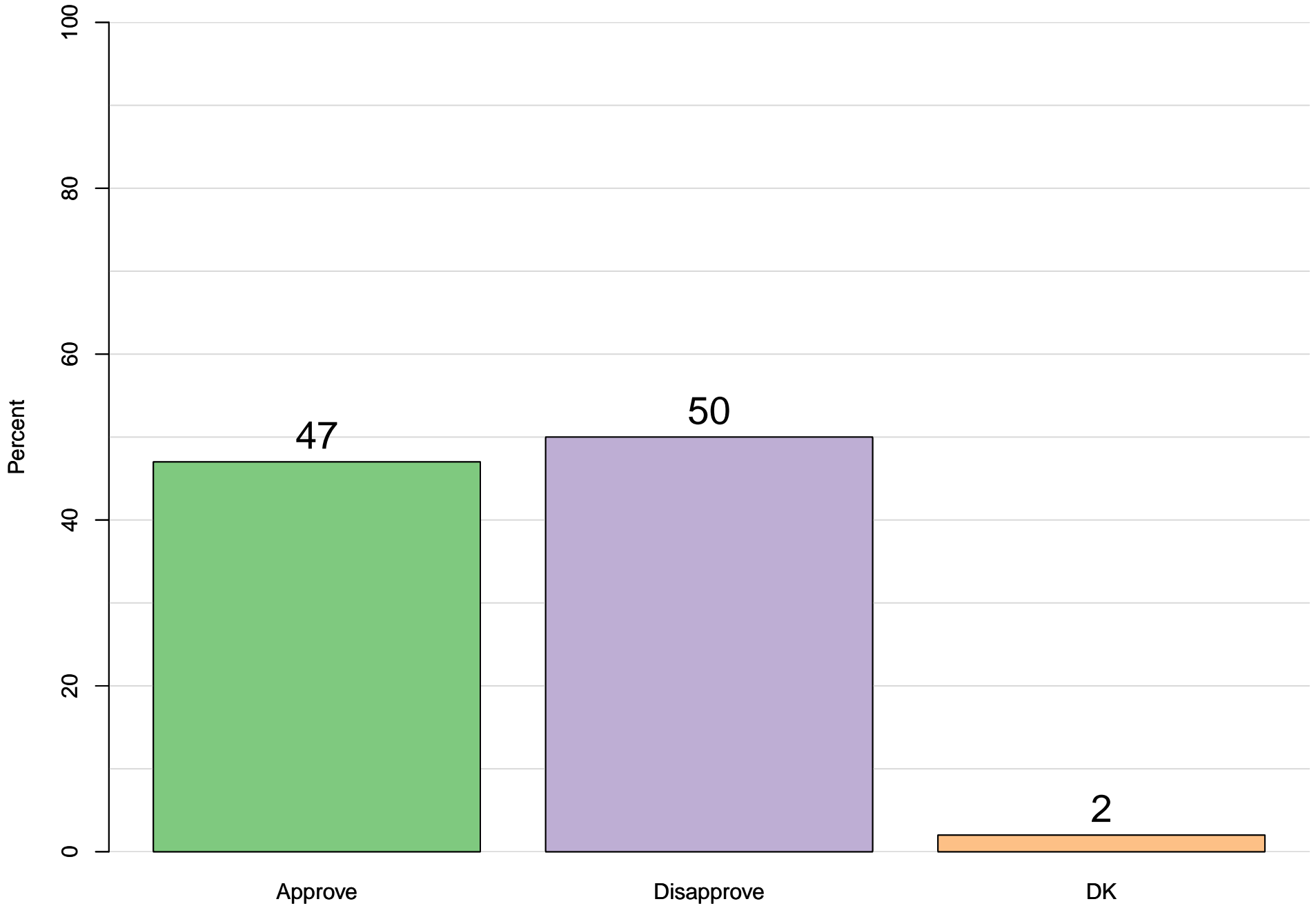

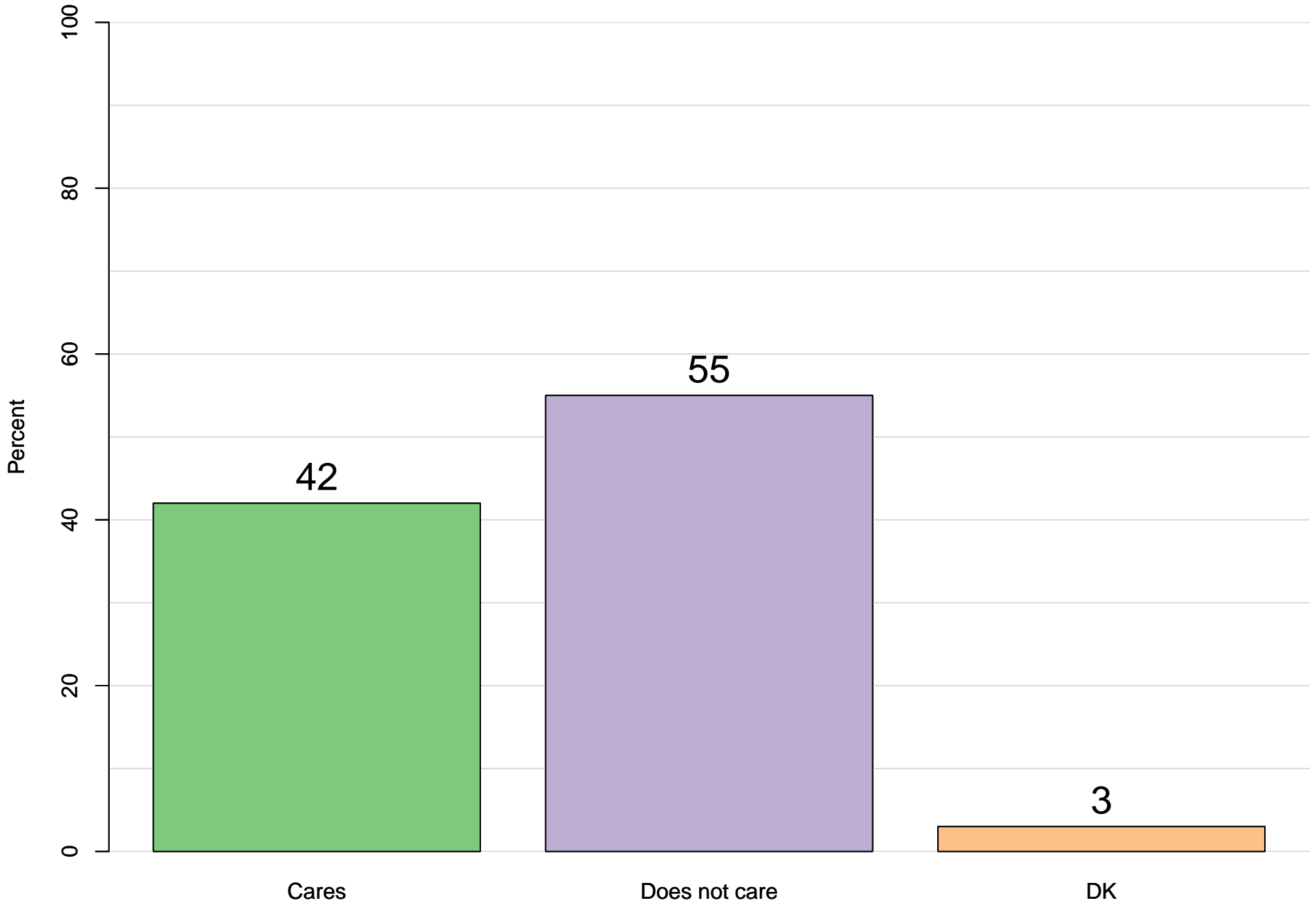

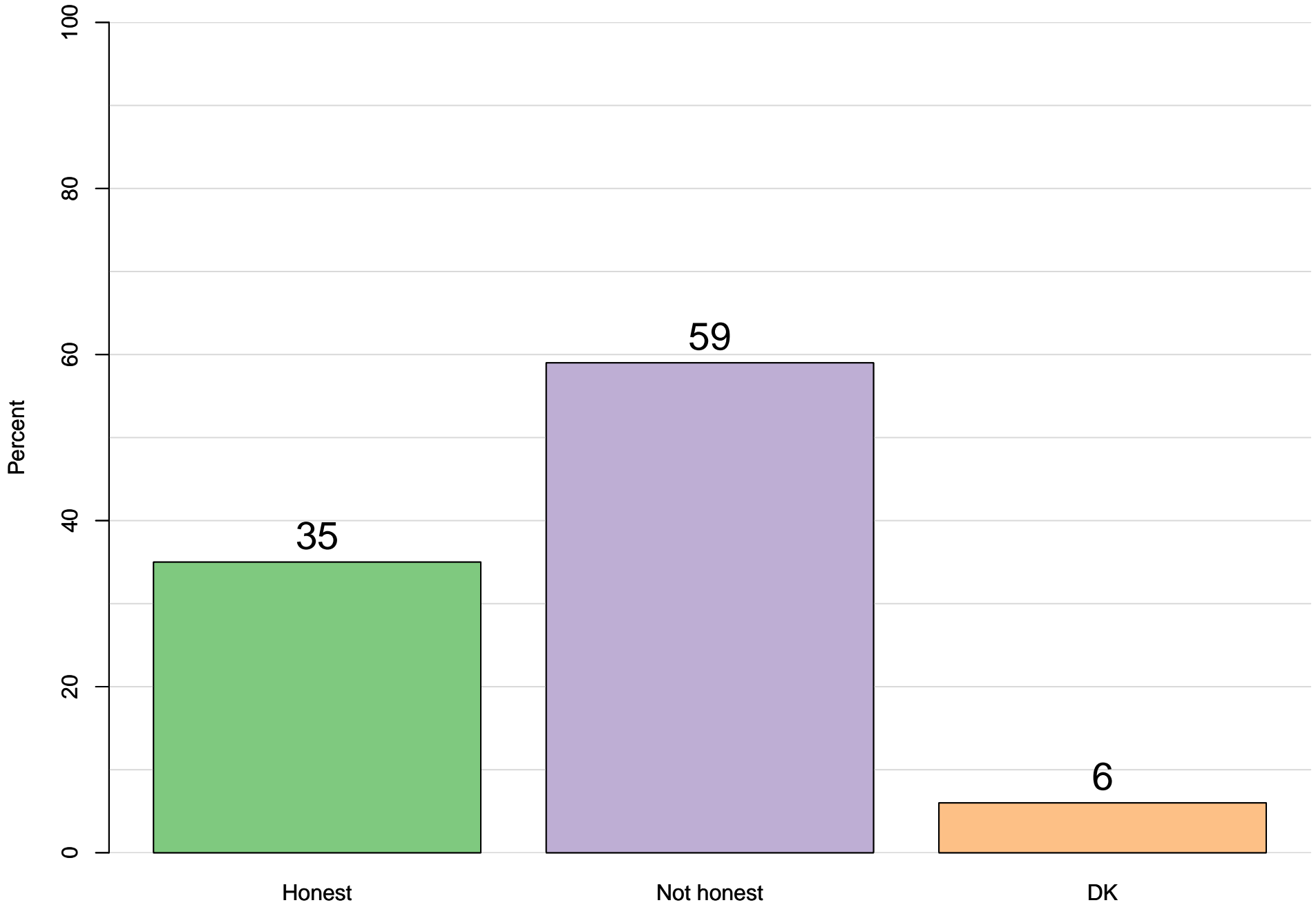

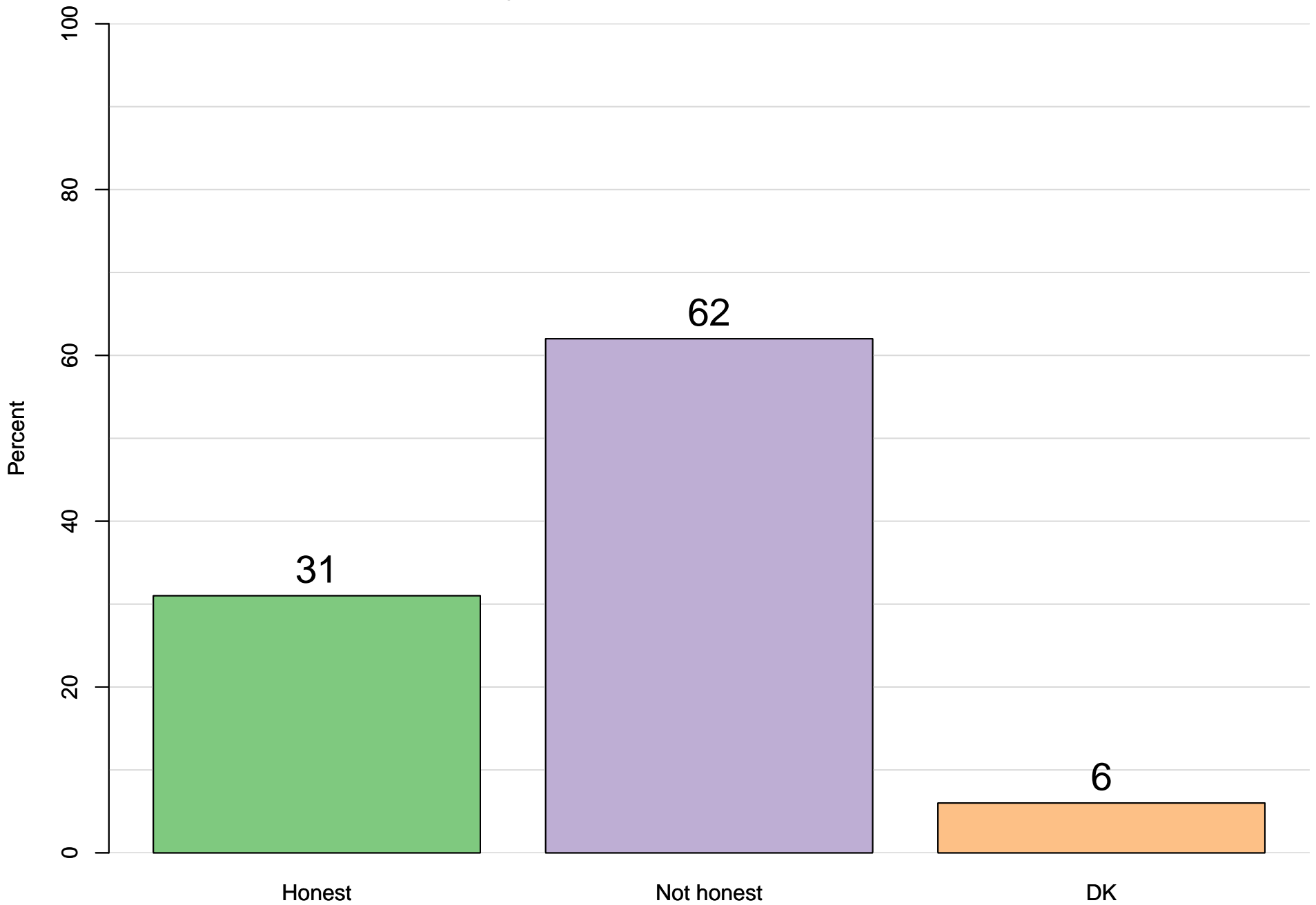

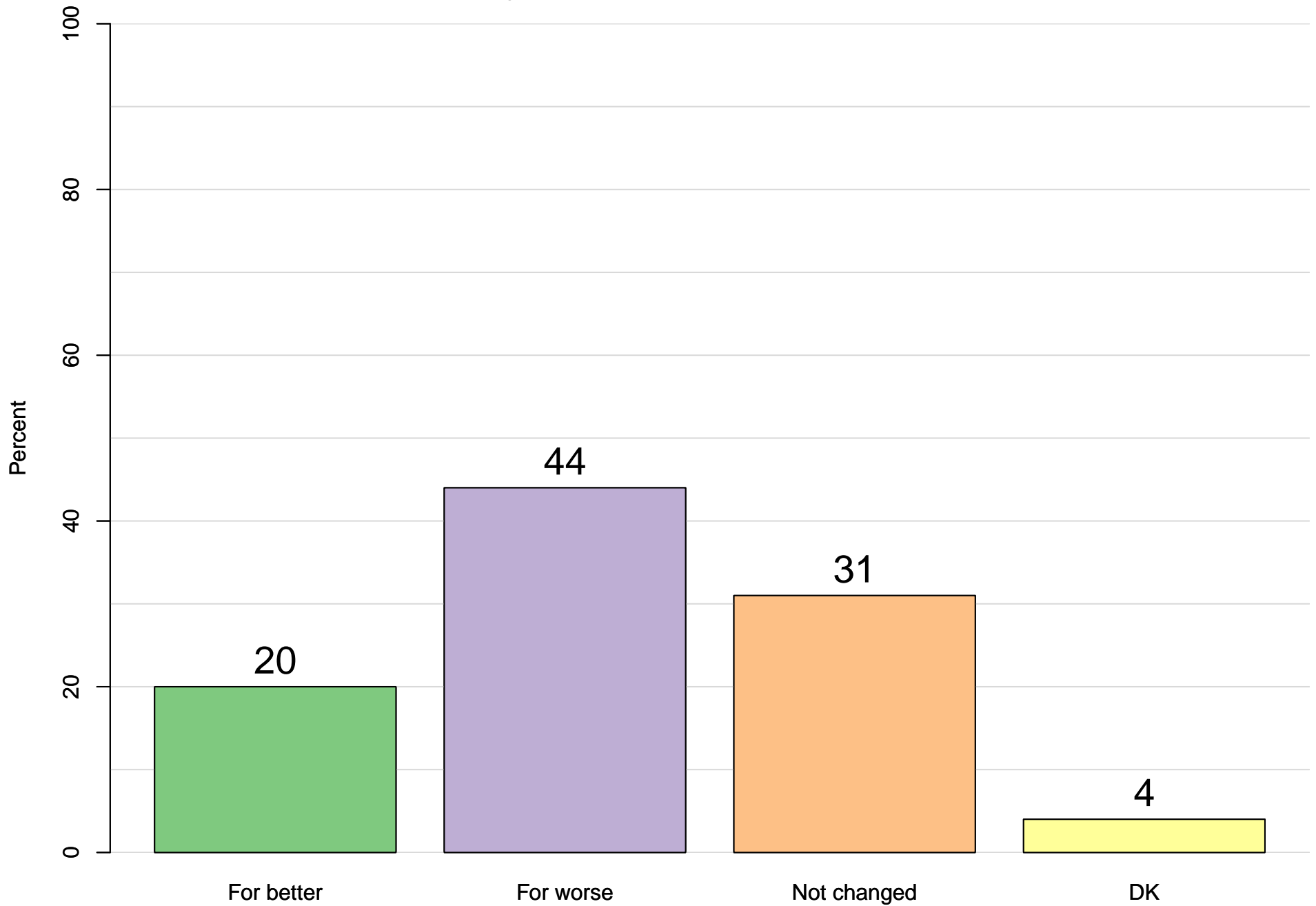

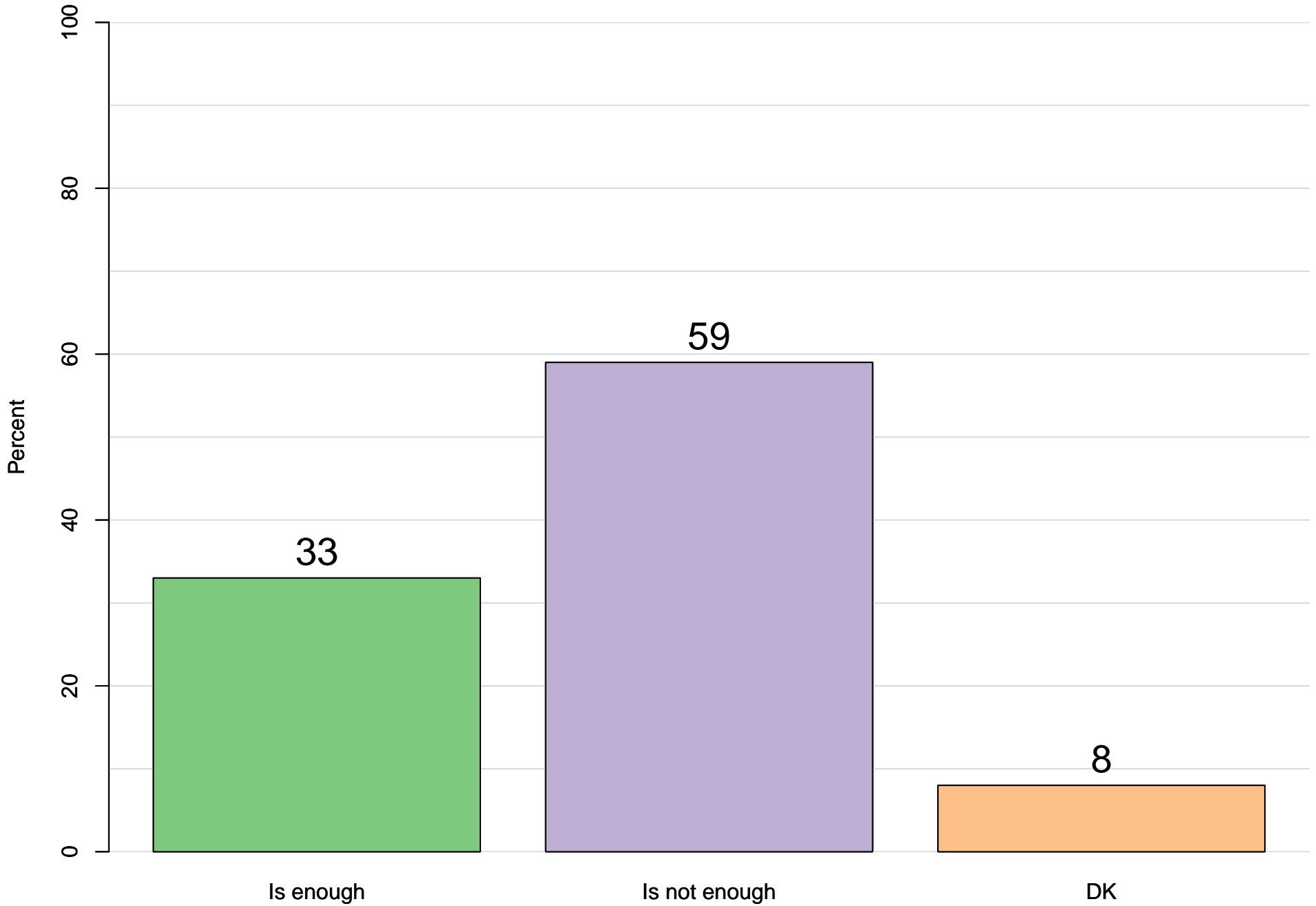

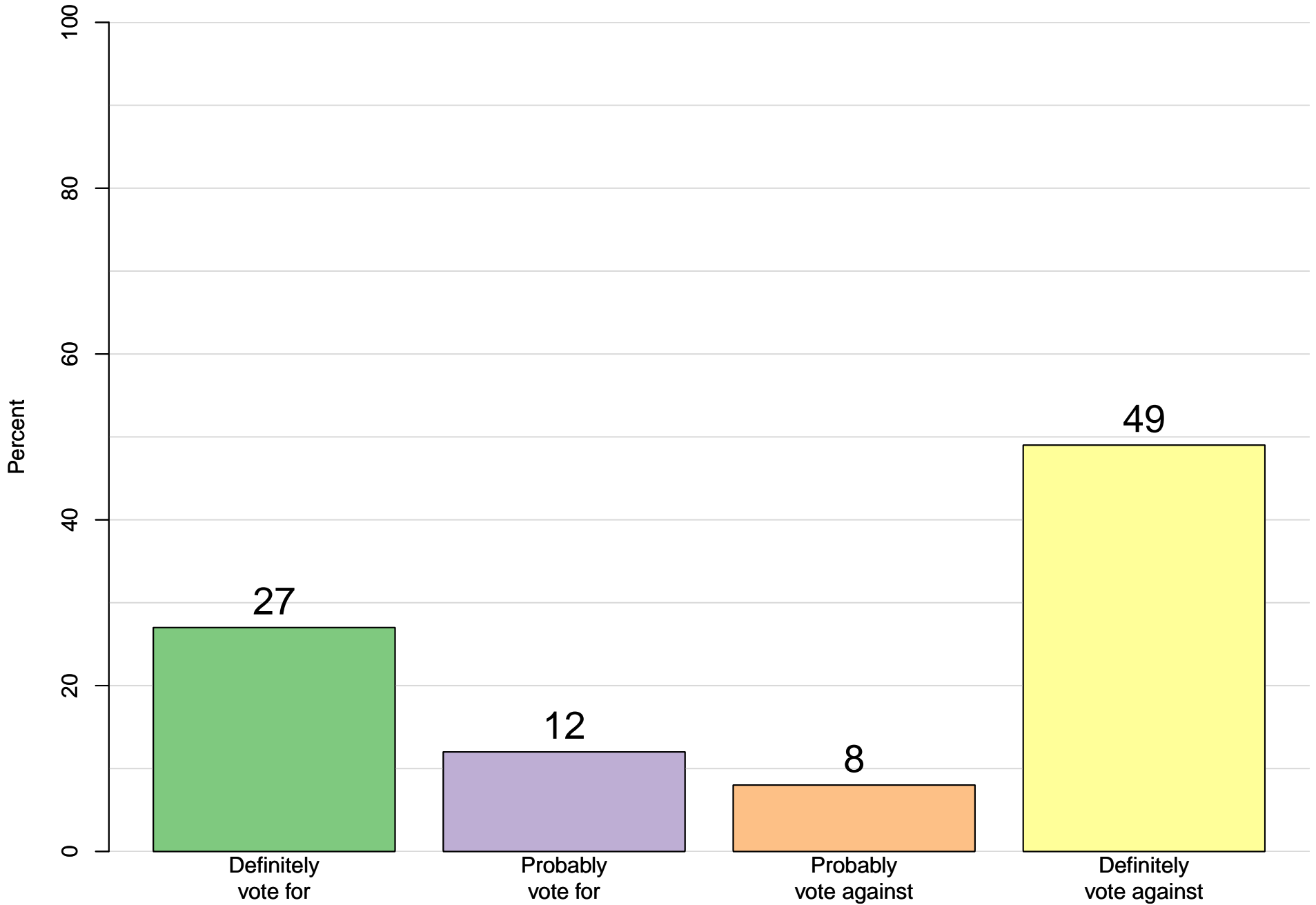

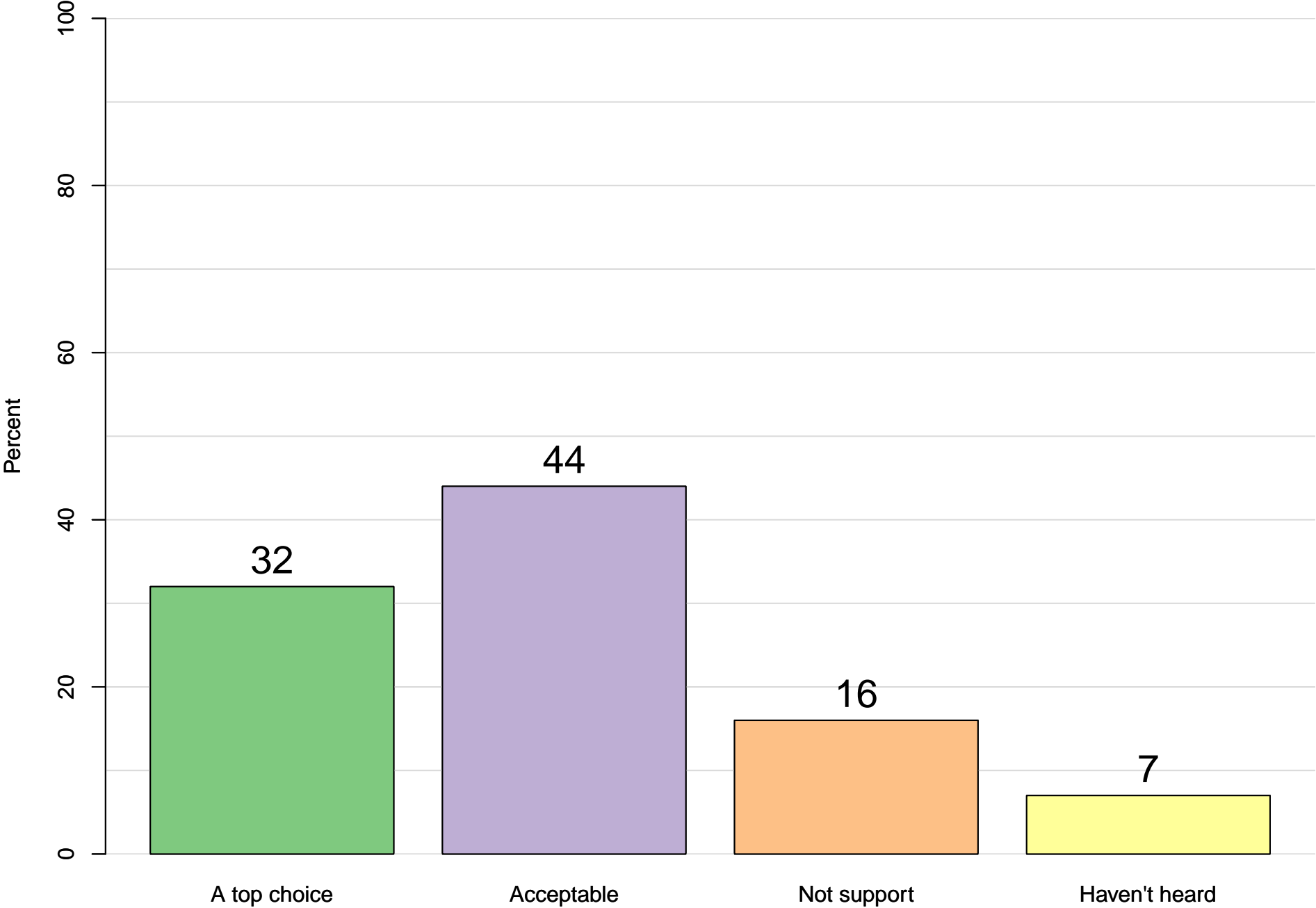

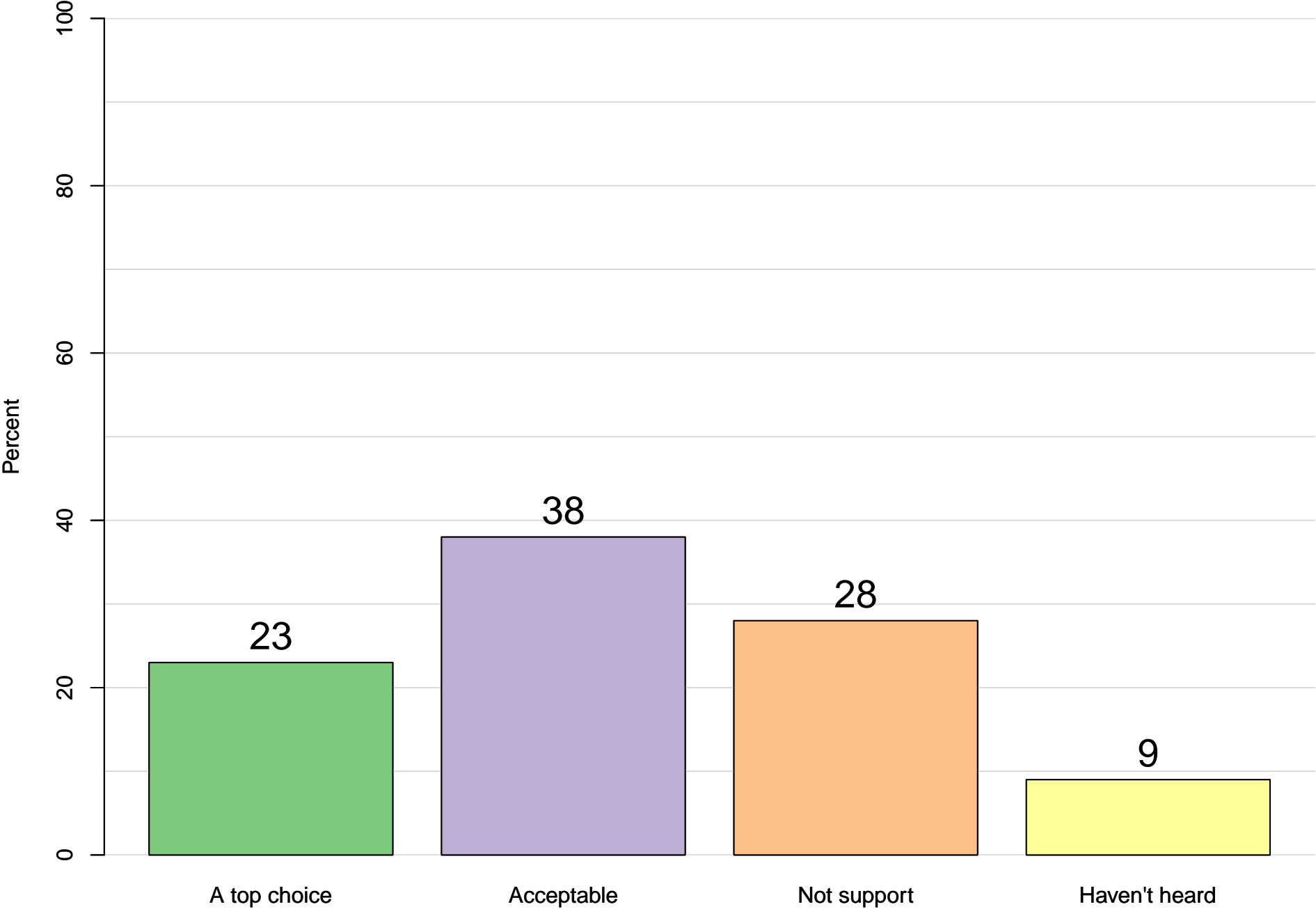

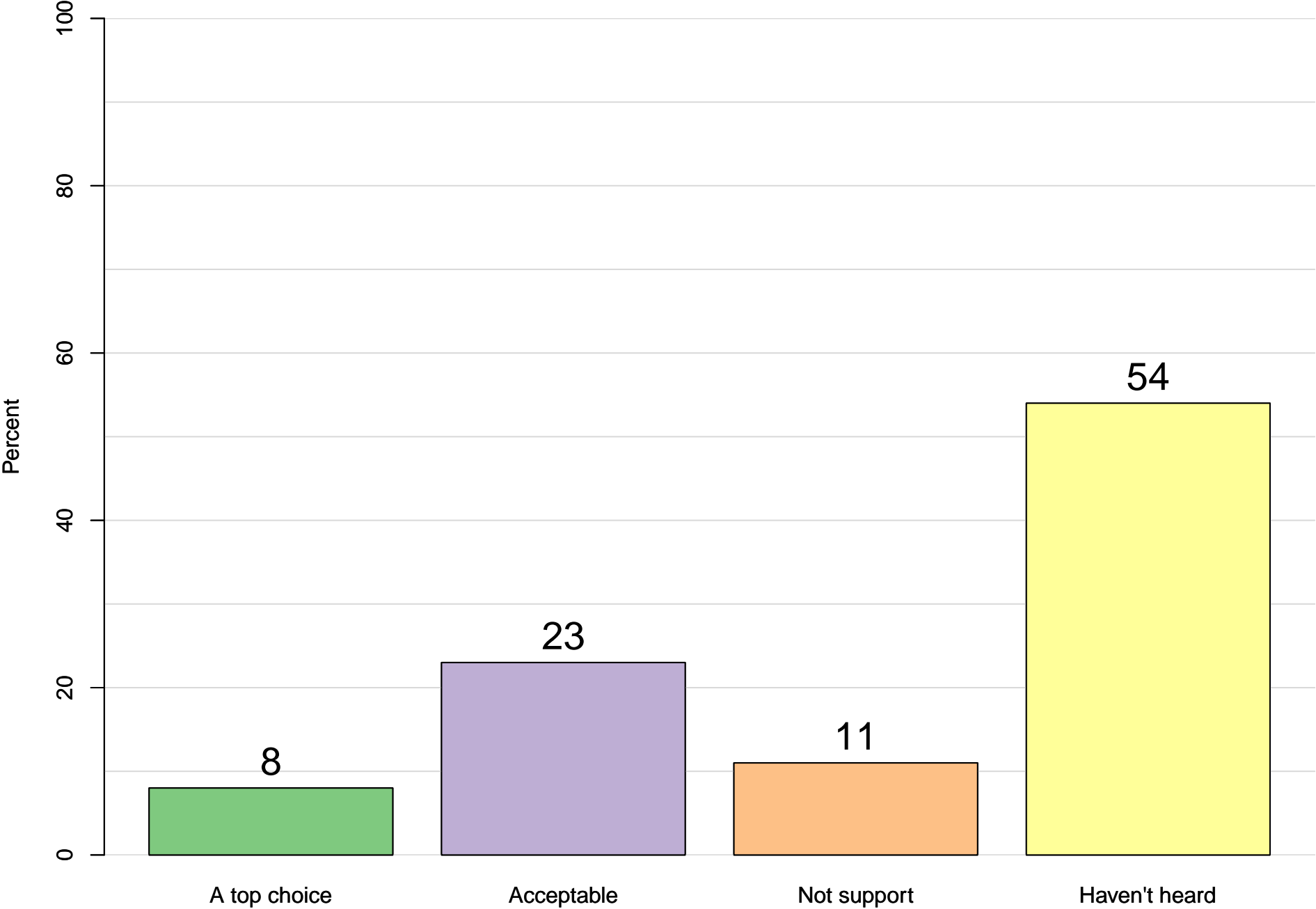

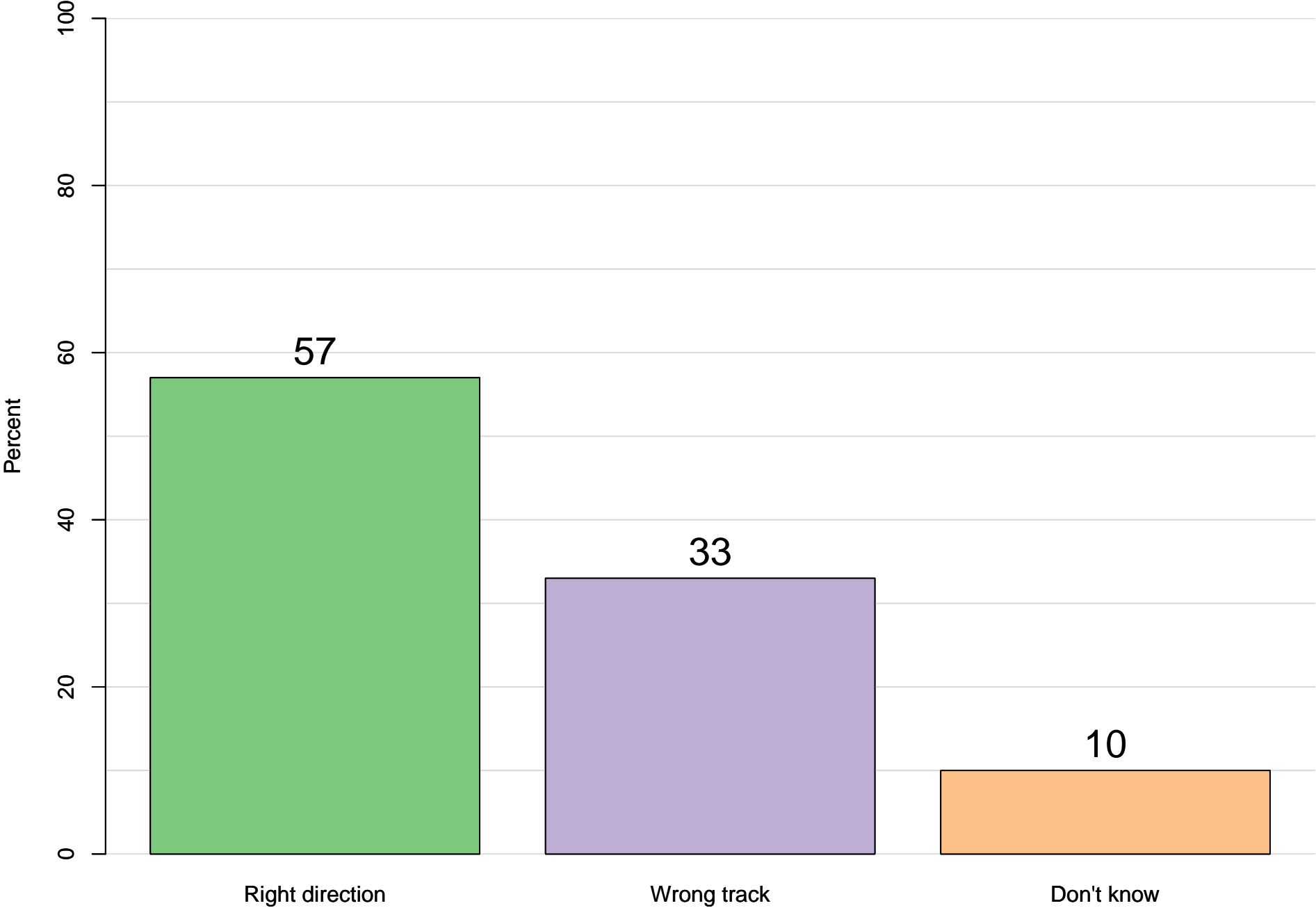


Wisconsin headed in right direction or wrong track

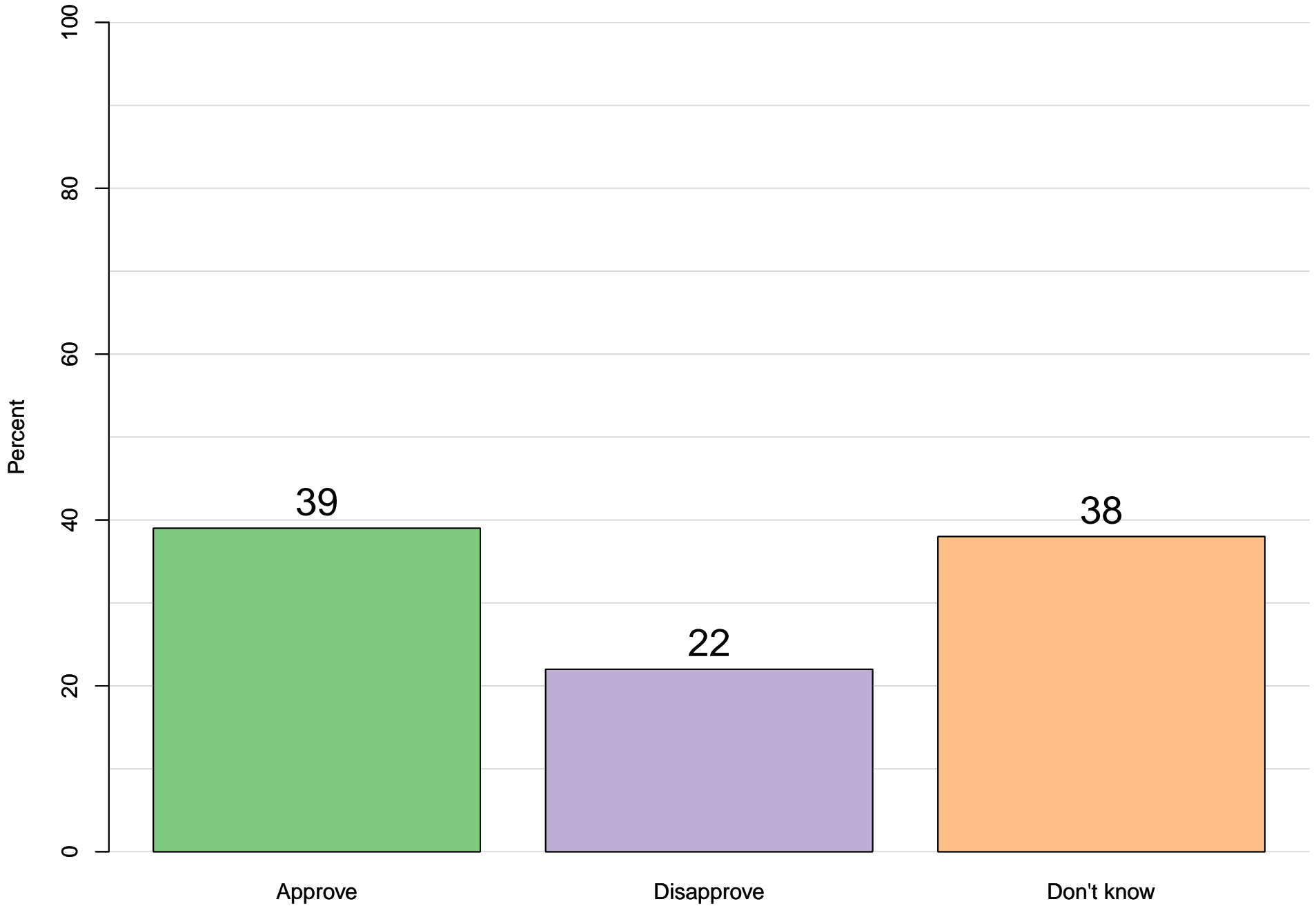

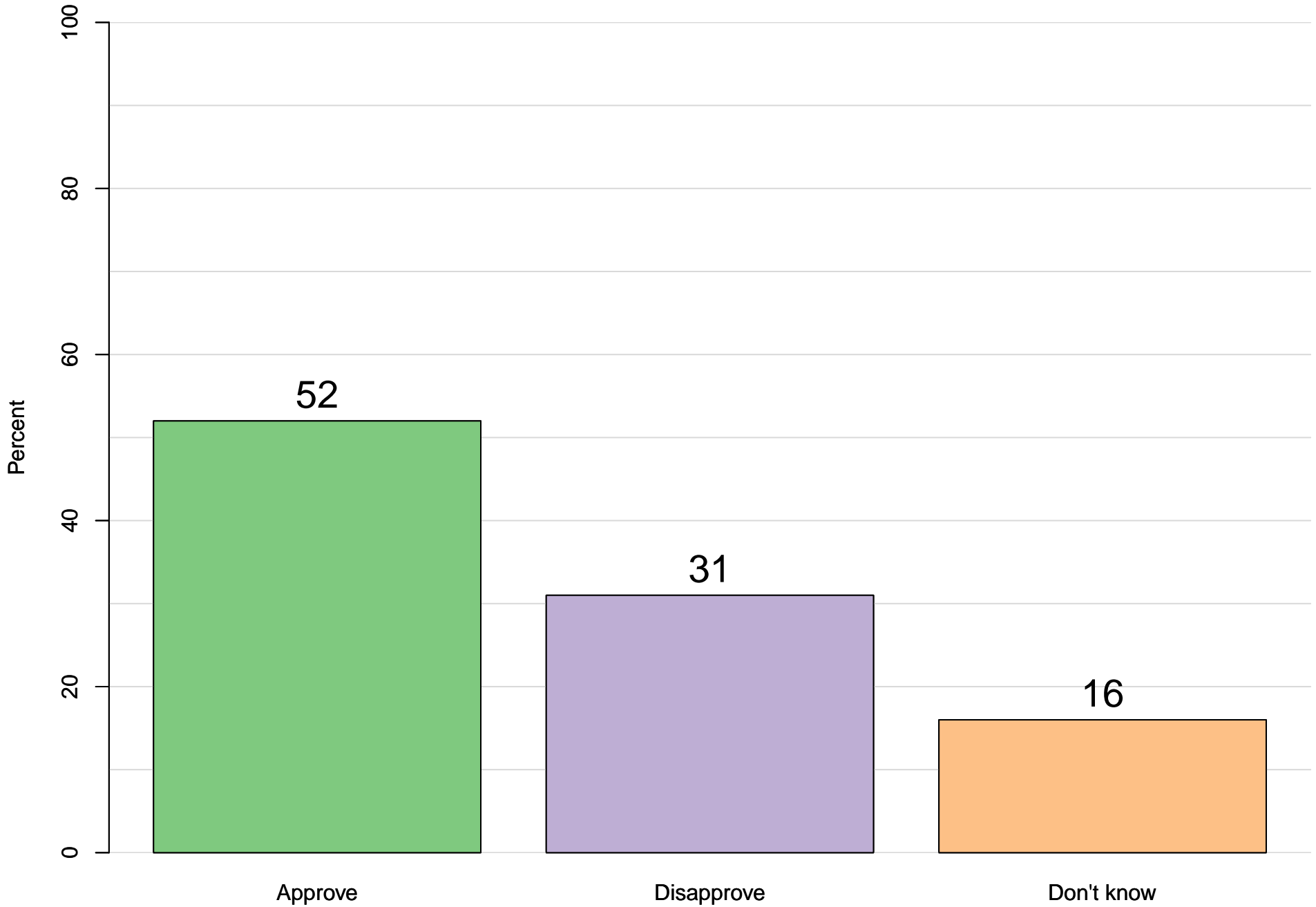

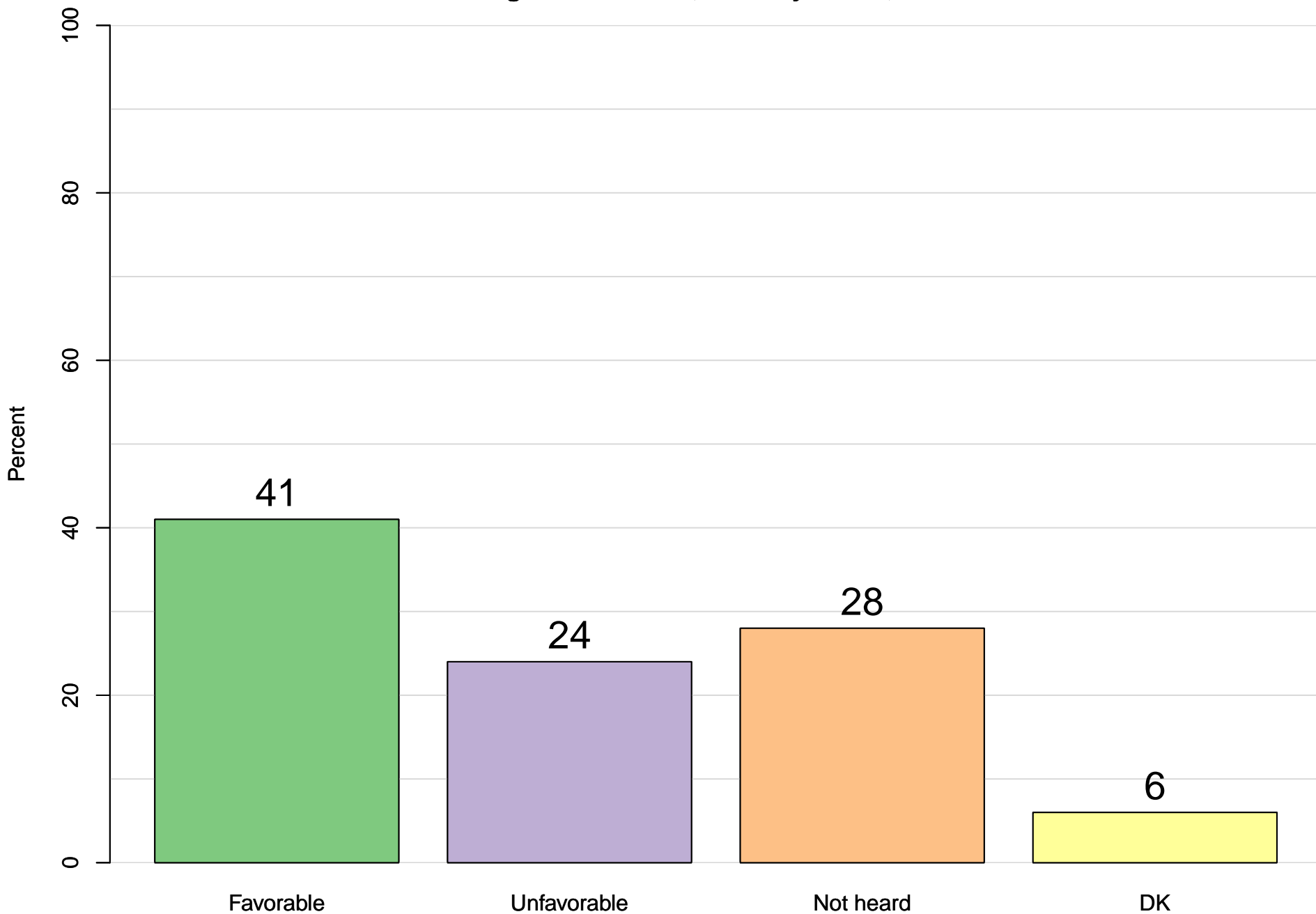
Approve or disapprove of Evers handling job Registered Voters, January 16–20, 2019



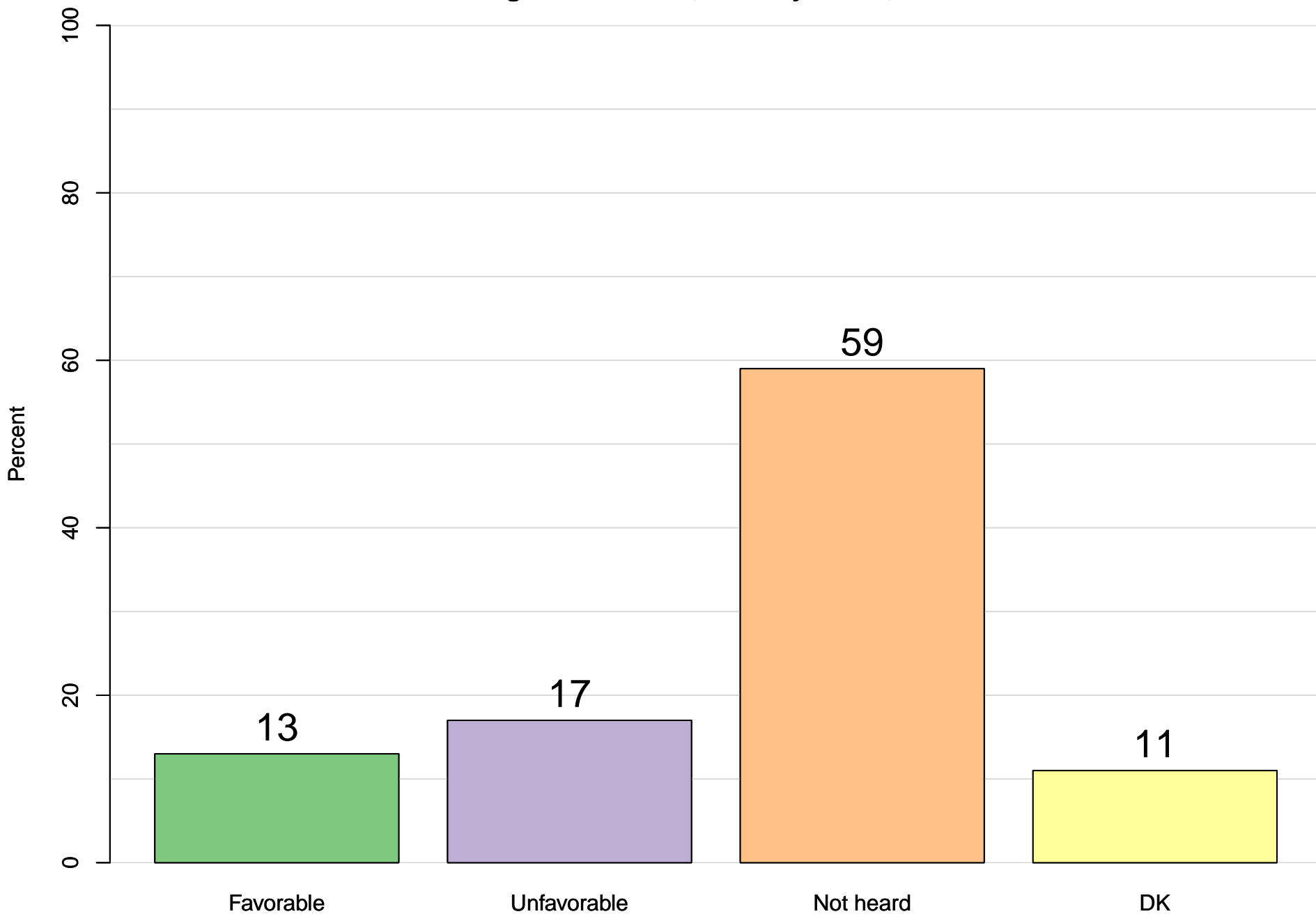
