

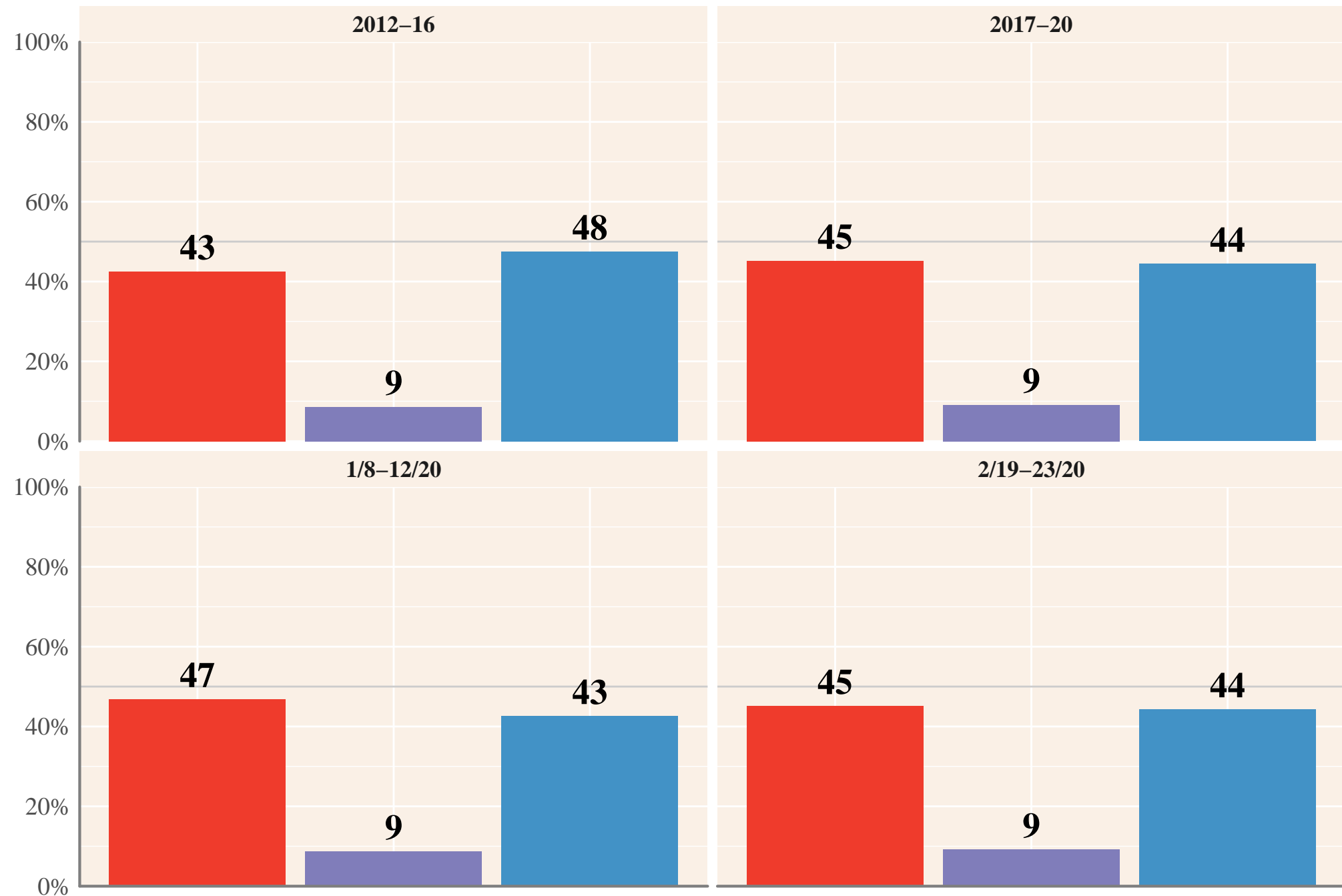

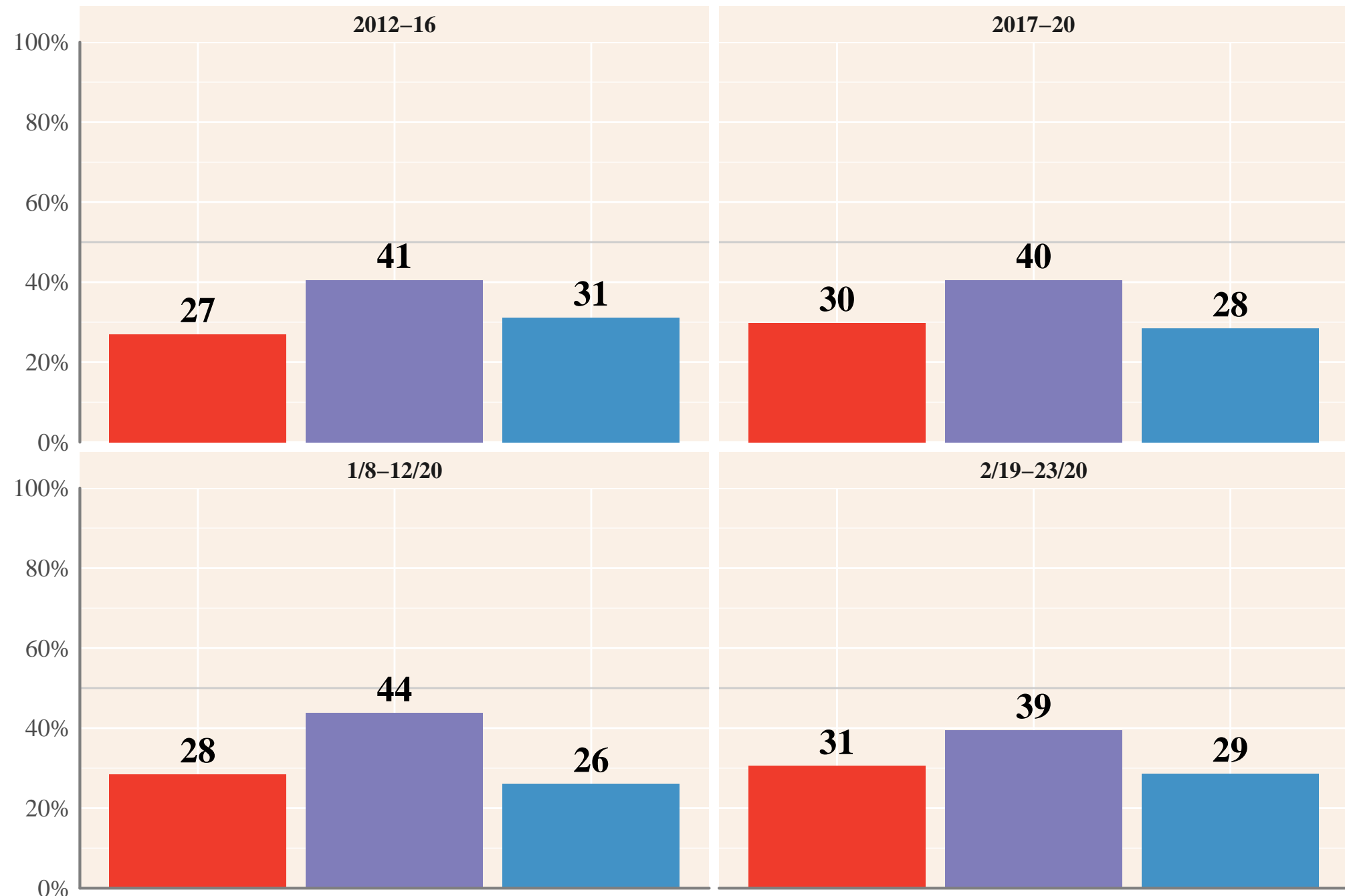
Party identification, with leaners

Republican Independent Democrat



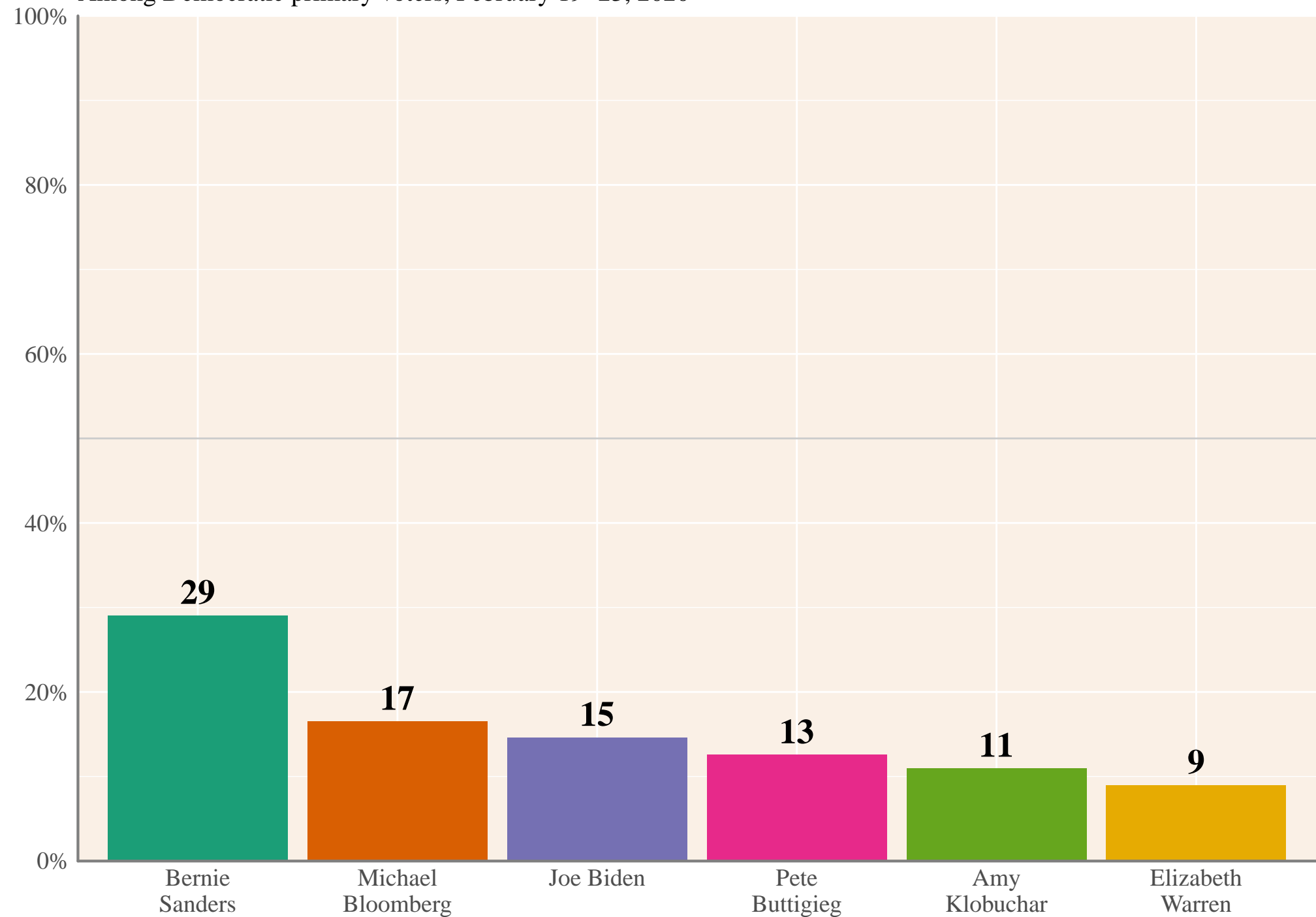
Party identification, without leaners

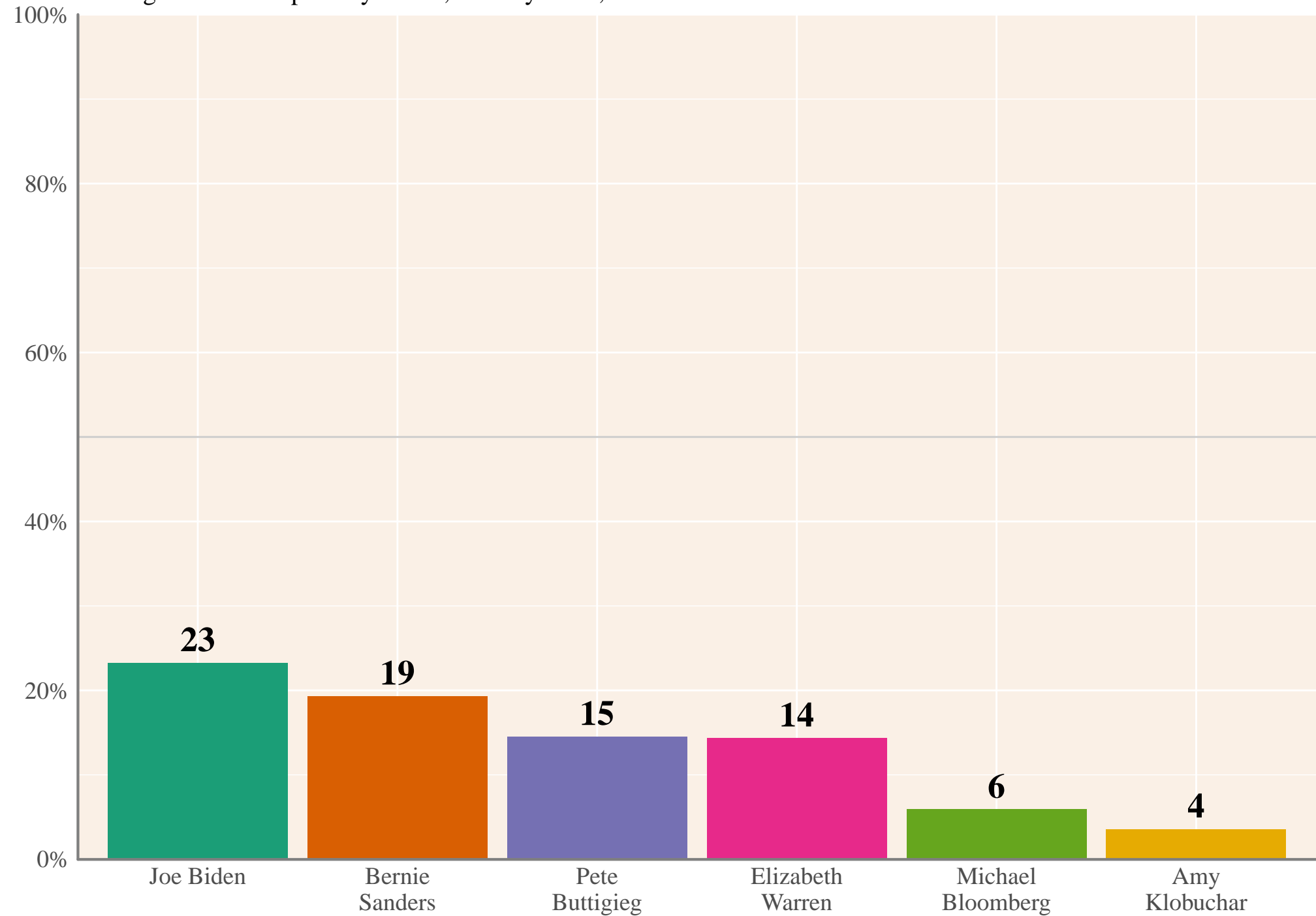

Among Democratic primary voters, February 19–23, 2020



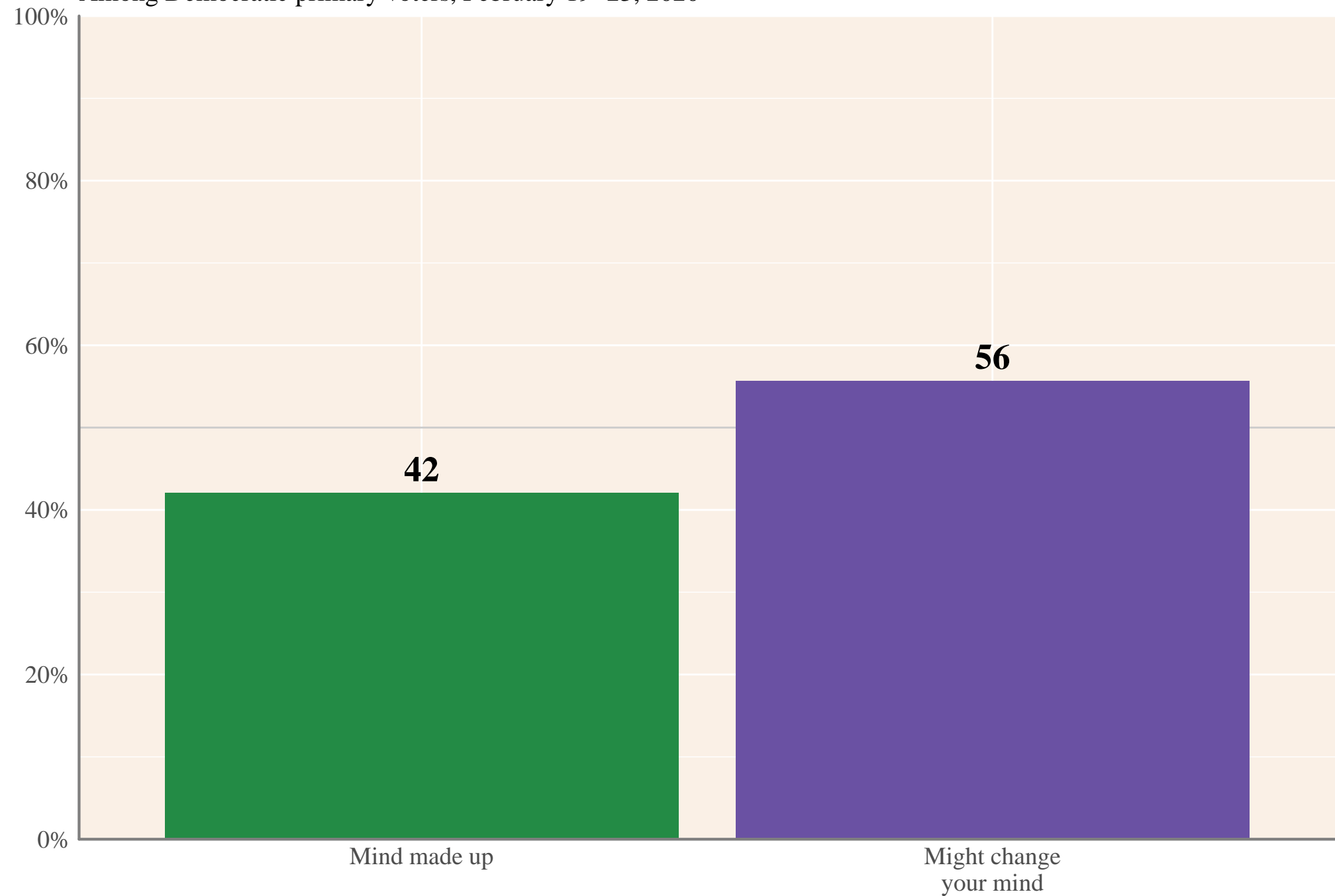

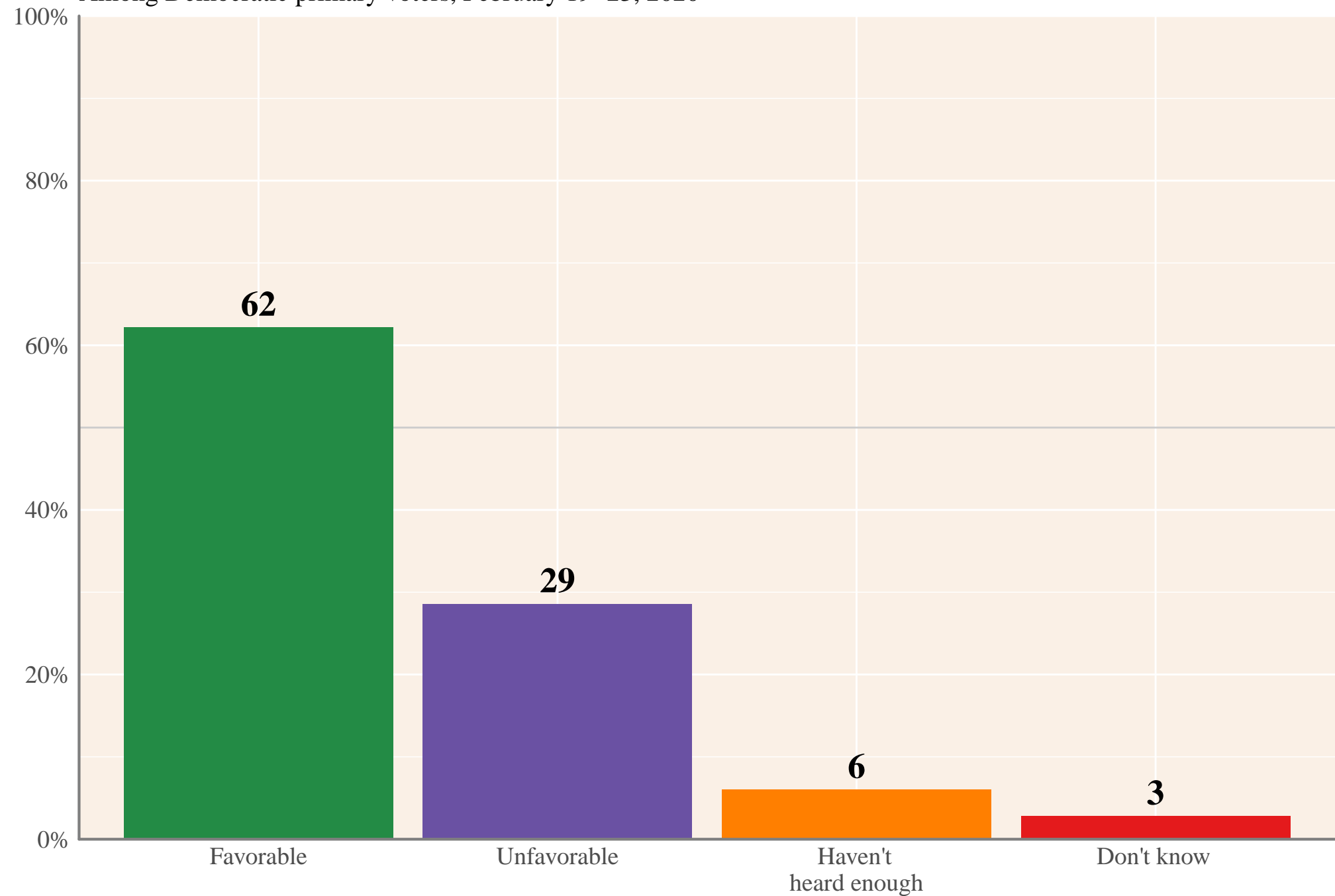
Is your mind made up, or do you think you might change your mind? [regarding 2020 Dem Pres Primary]

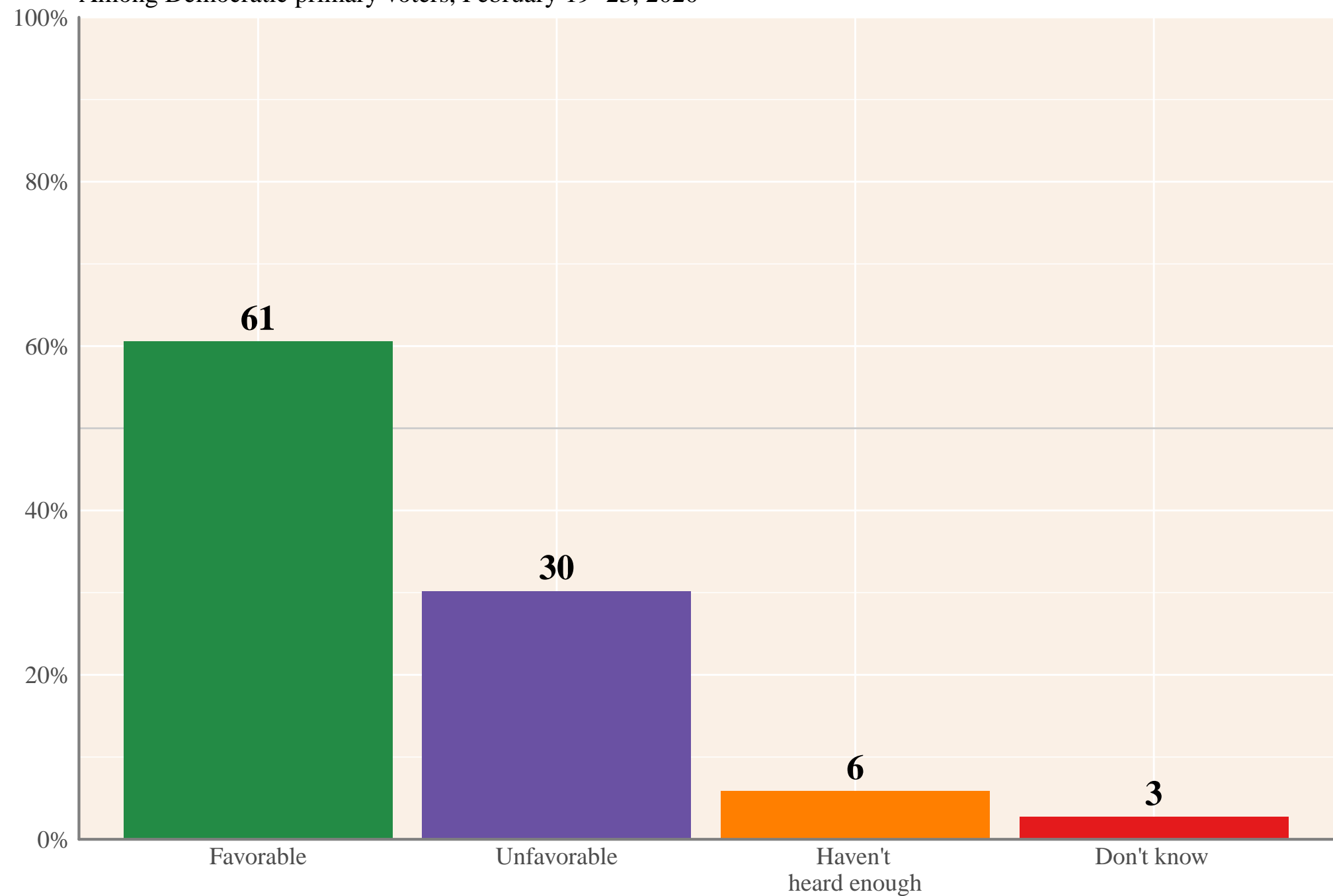

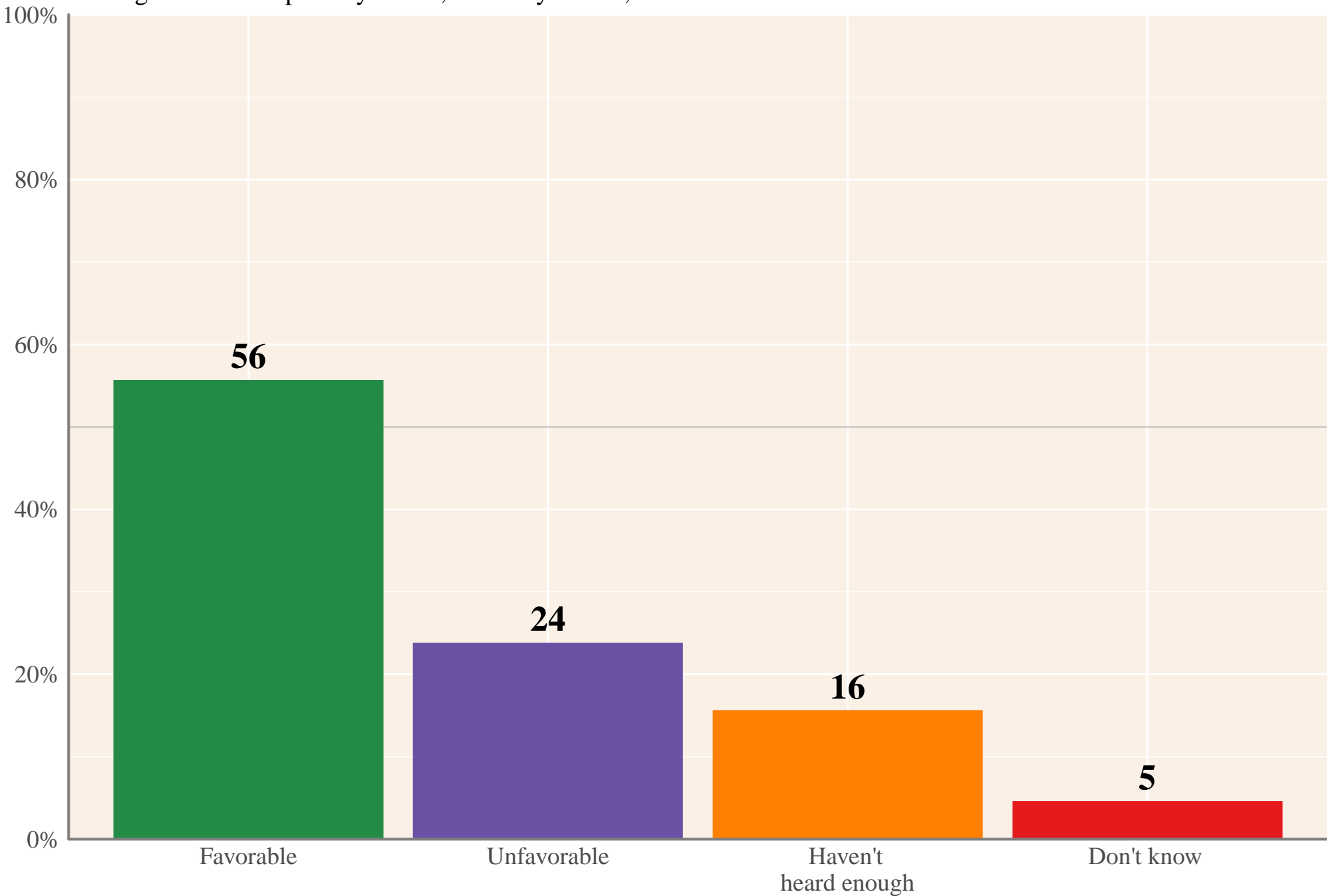

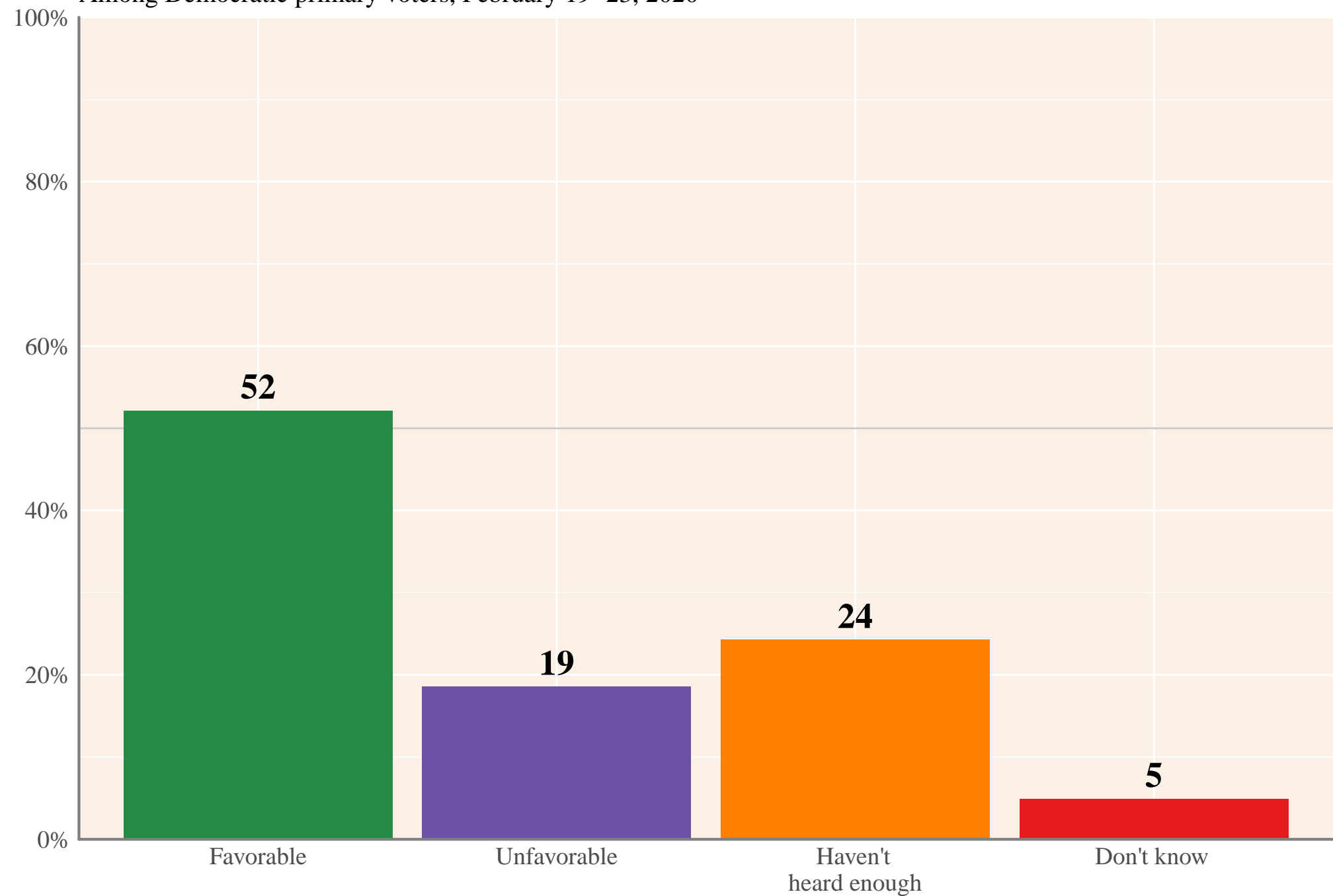

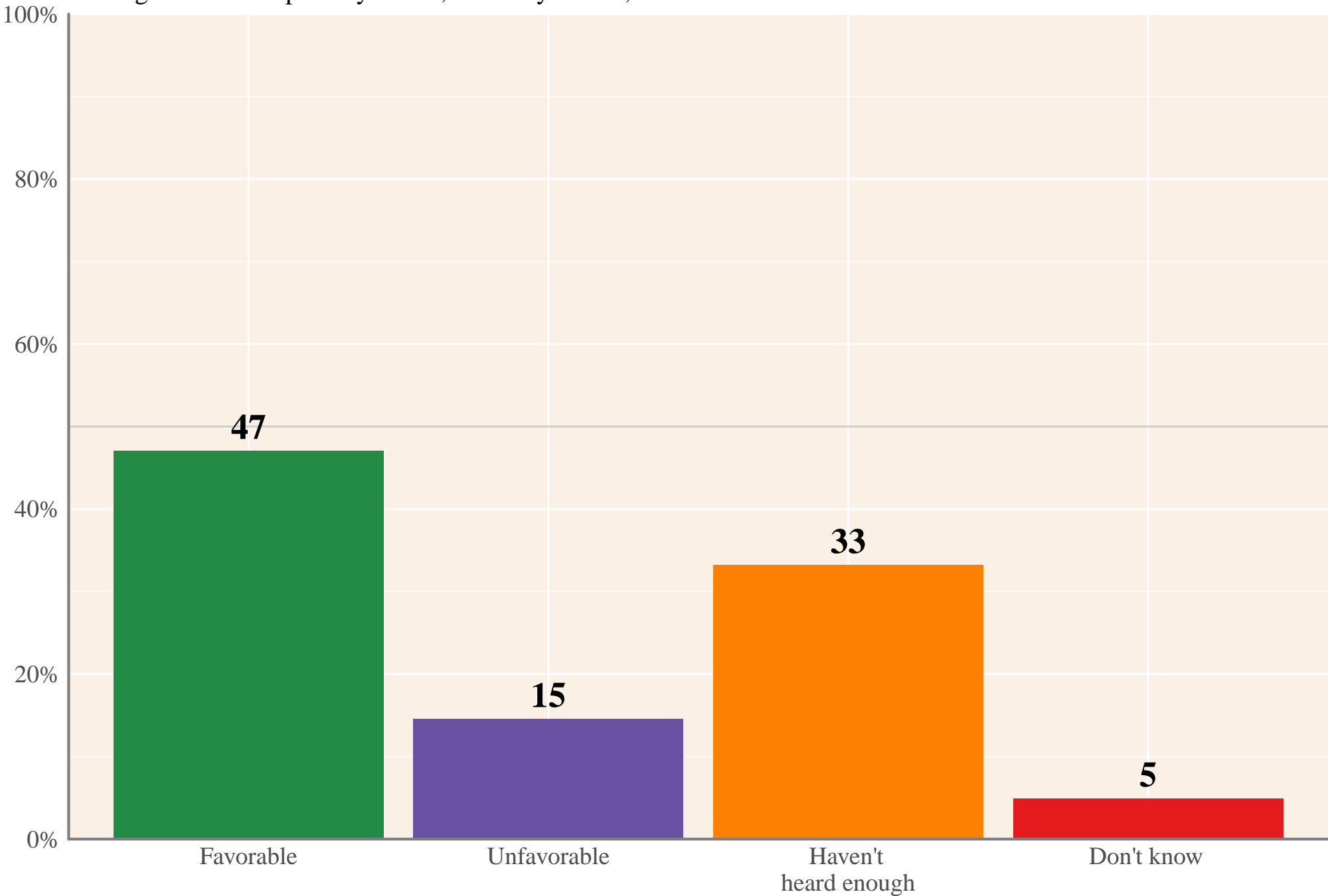

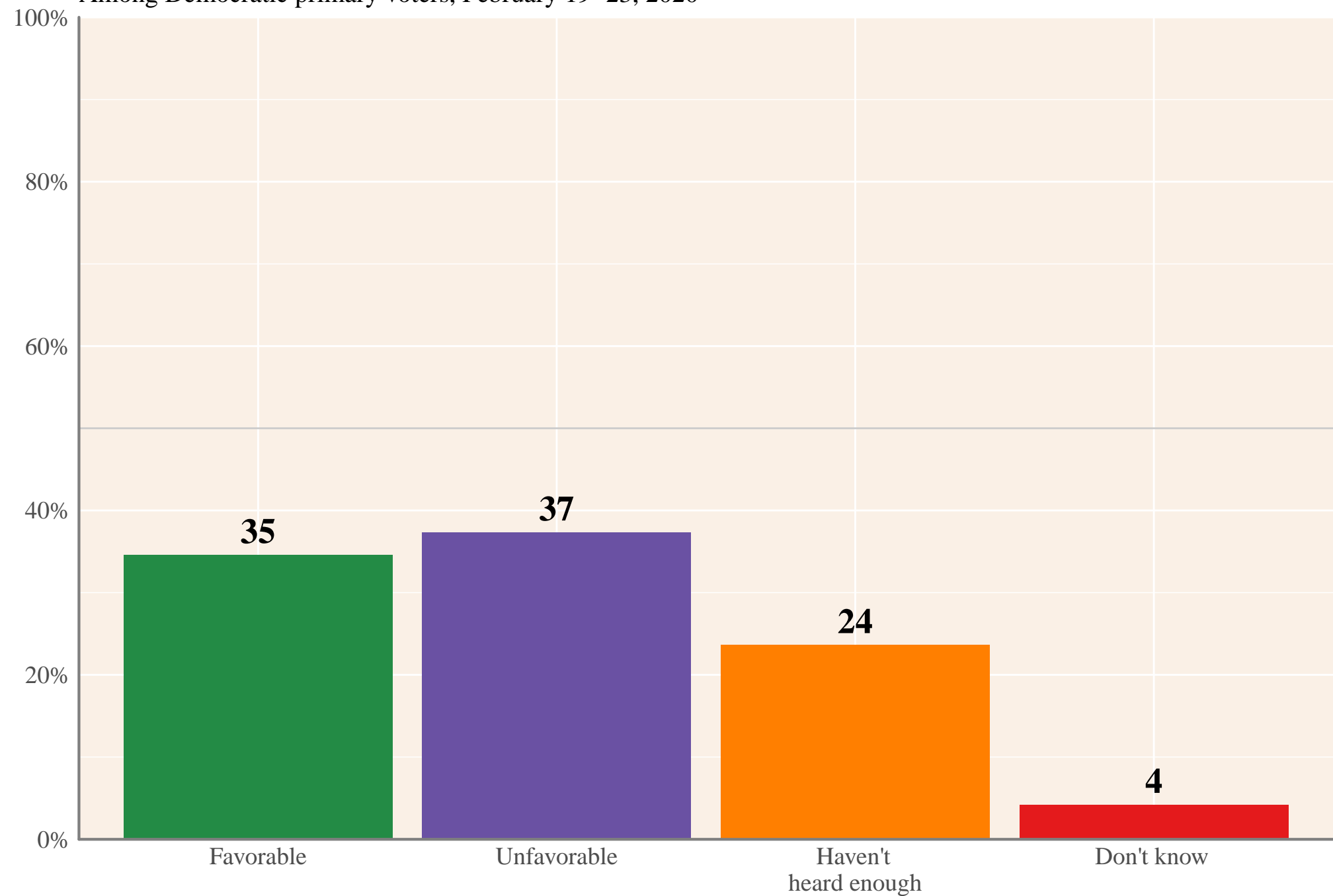

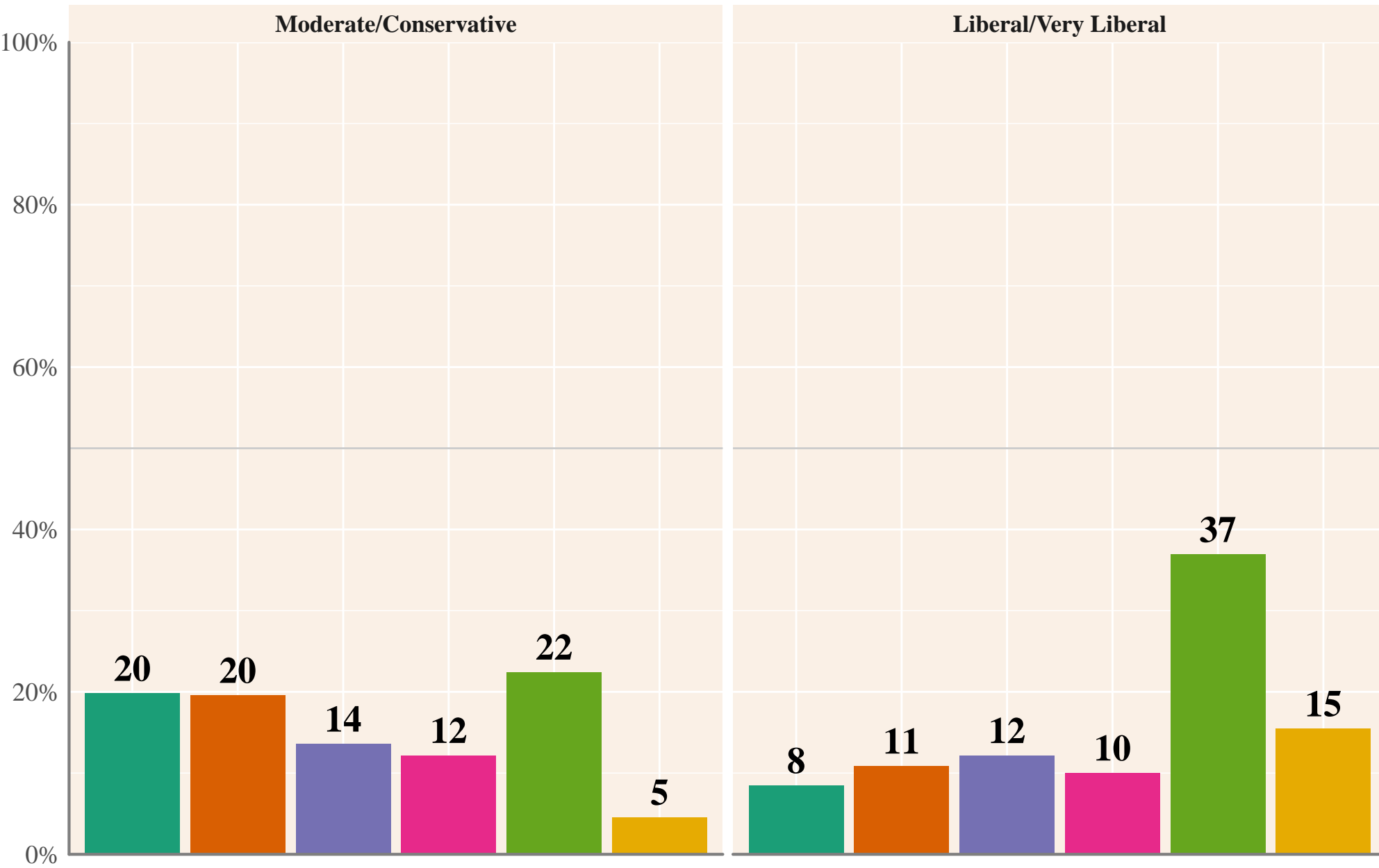

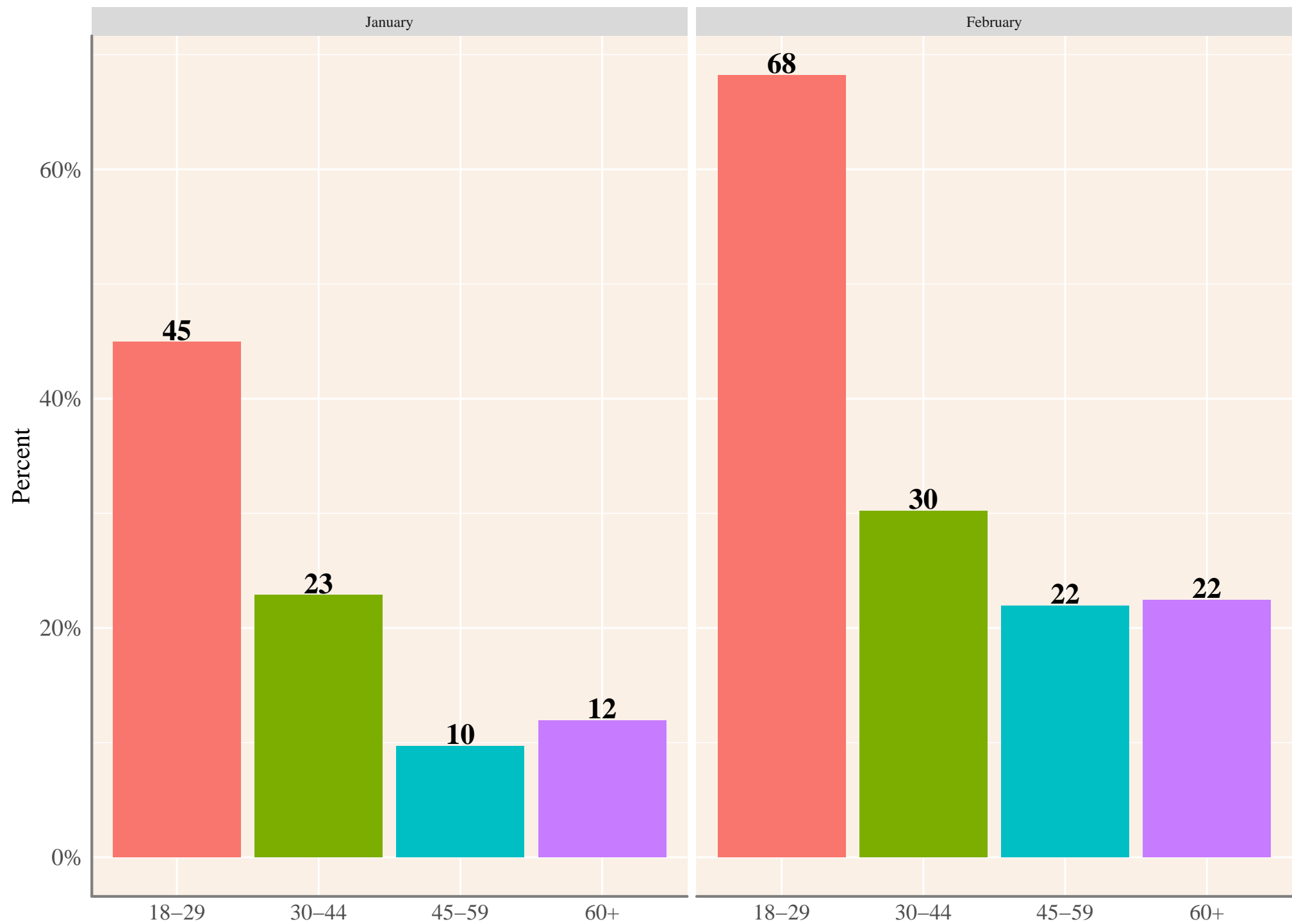


Primary choice by ideology

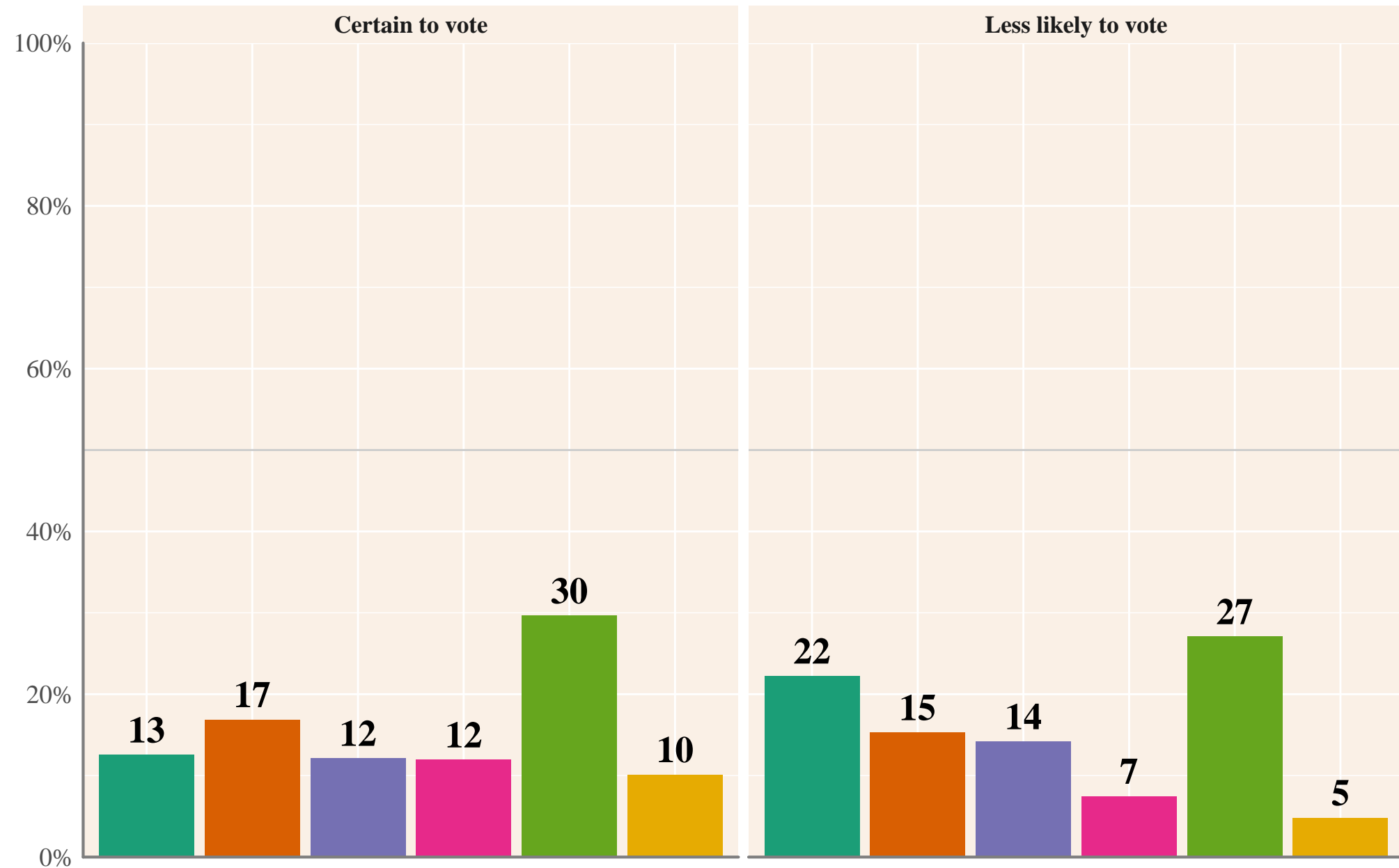
Sanders support by age

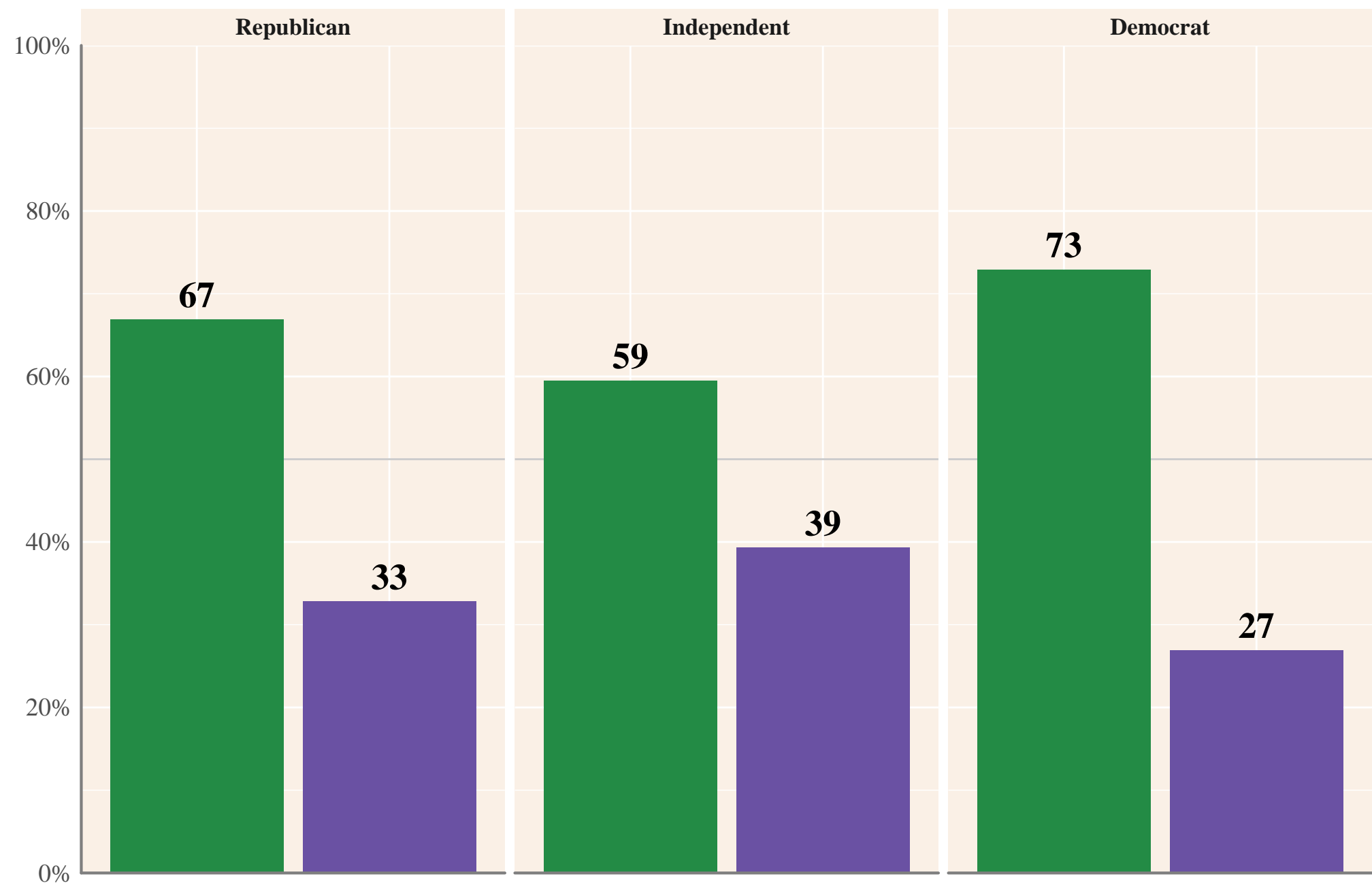

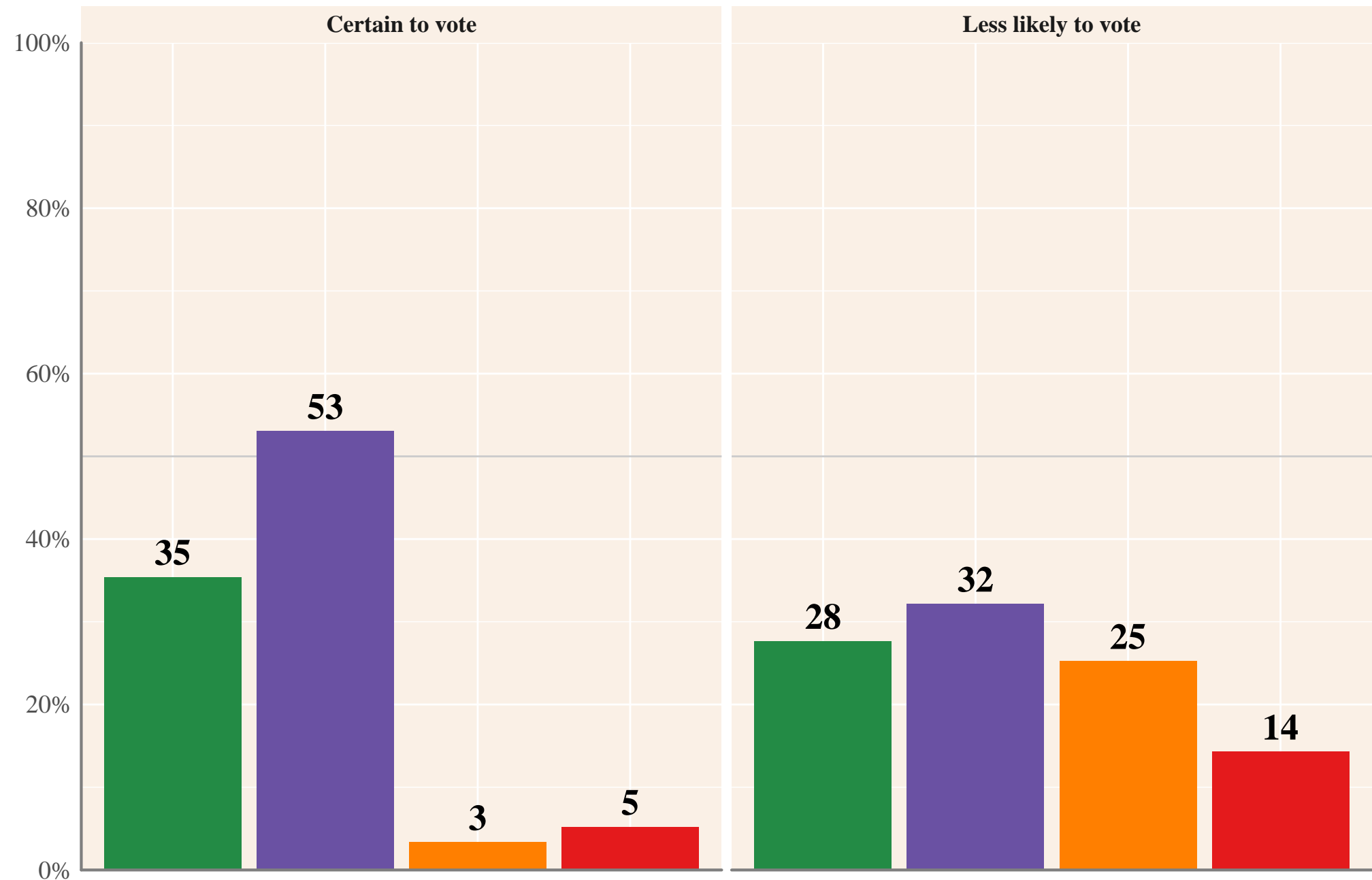

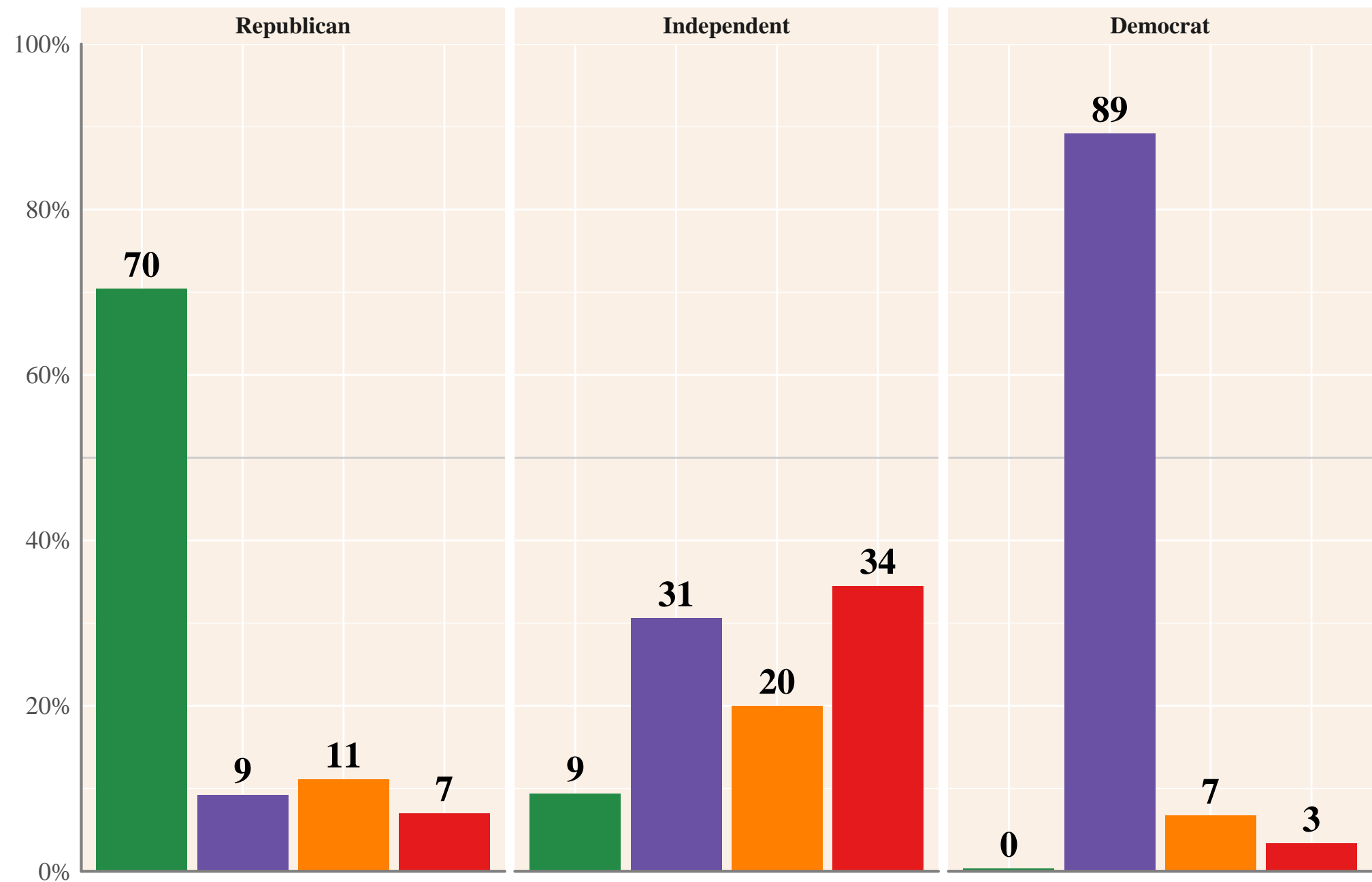

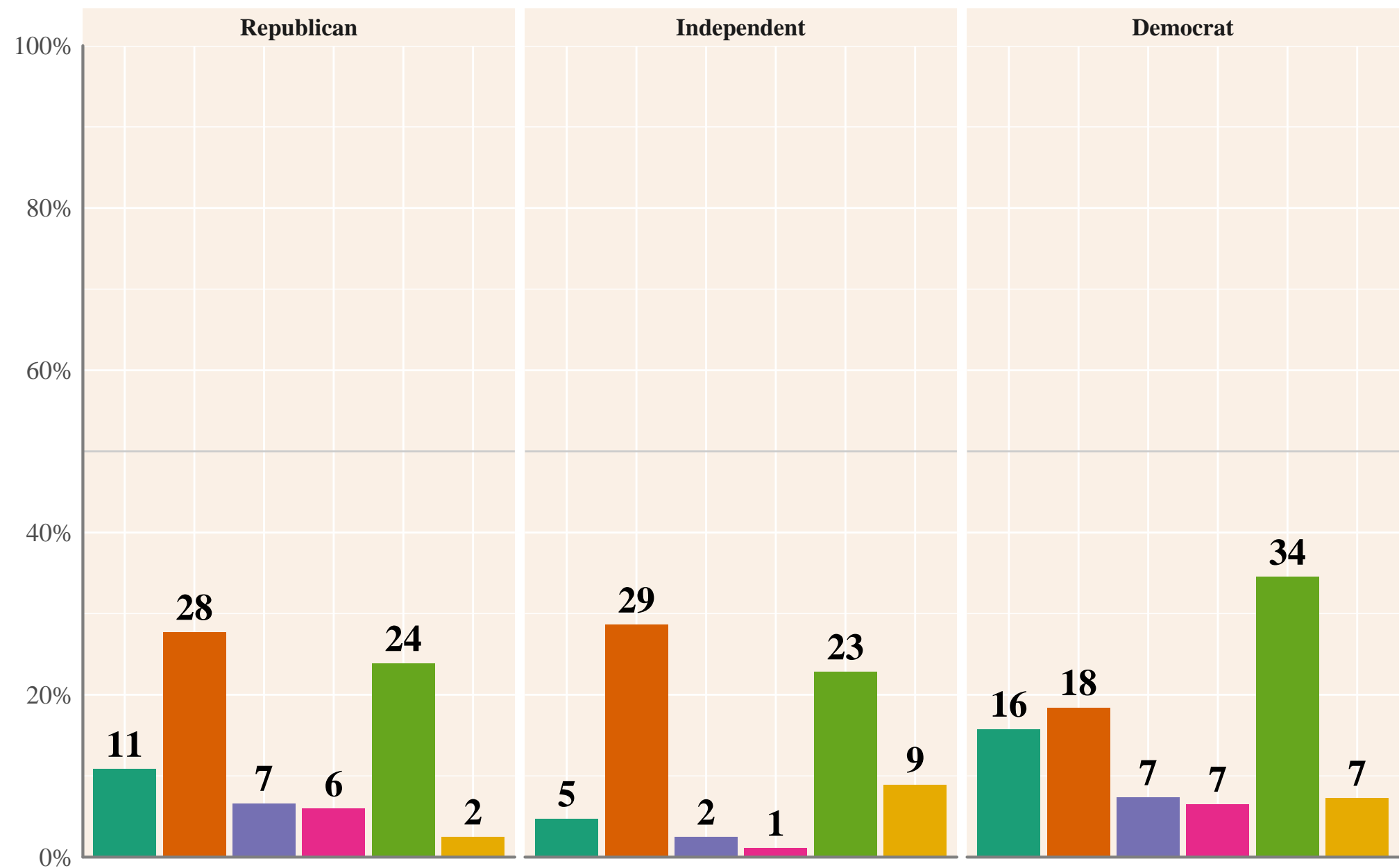

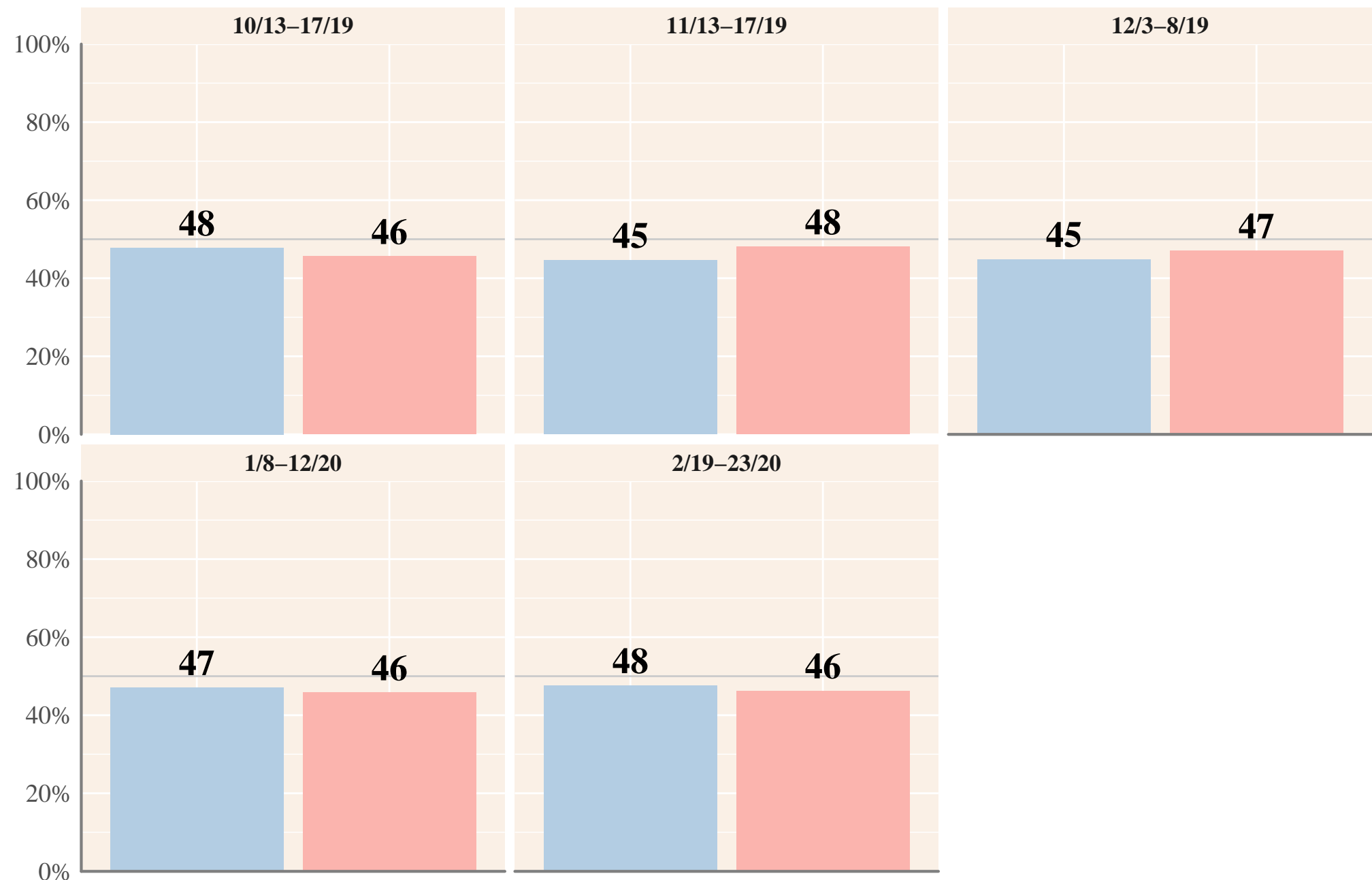

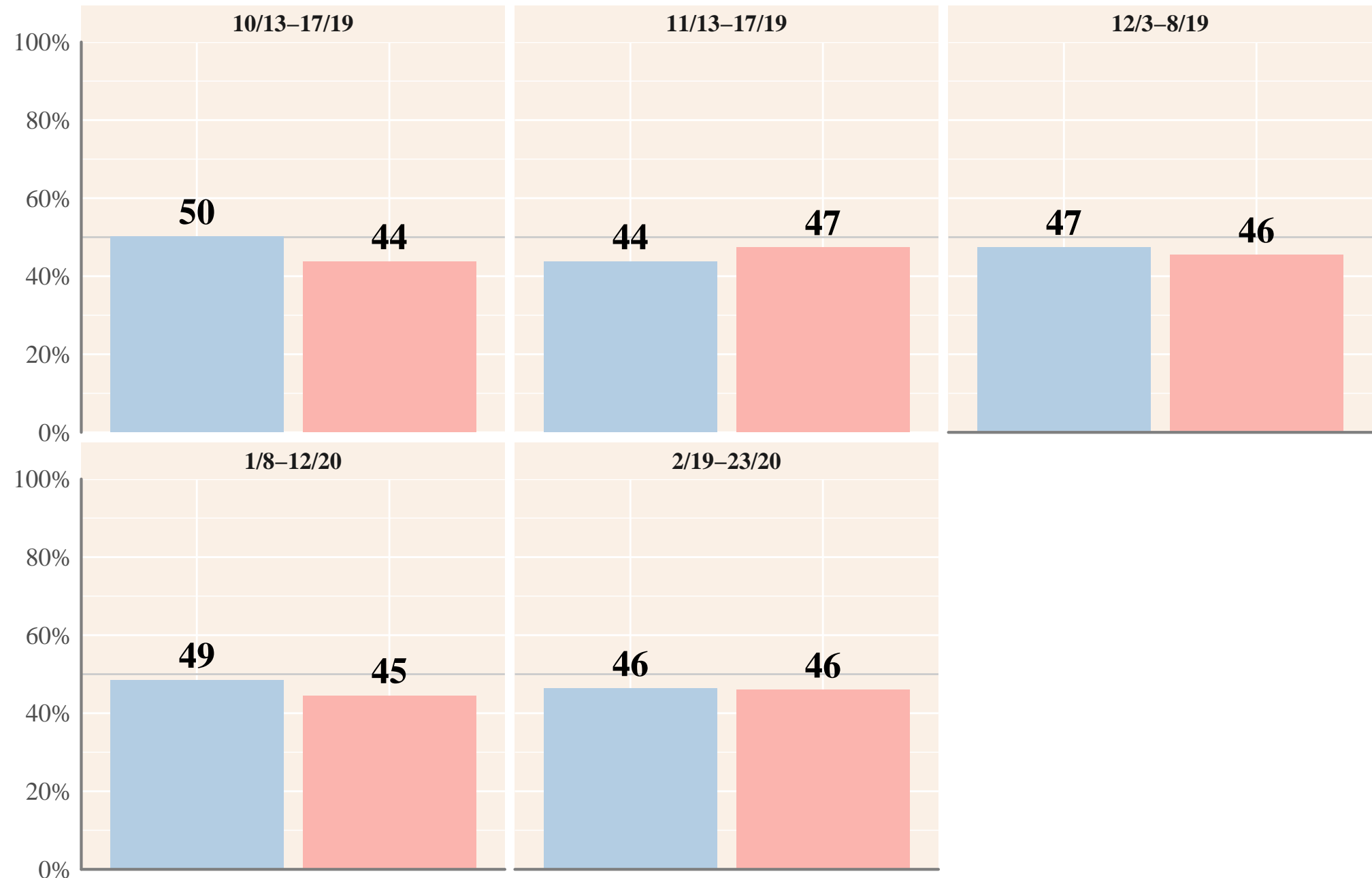

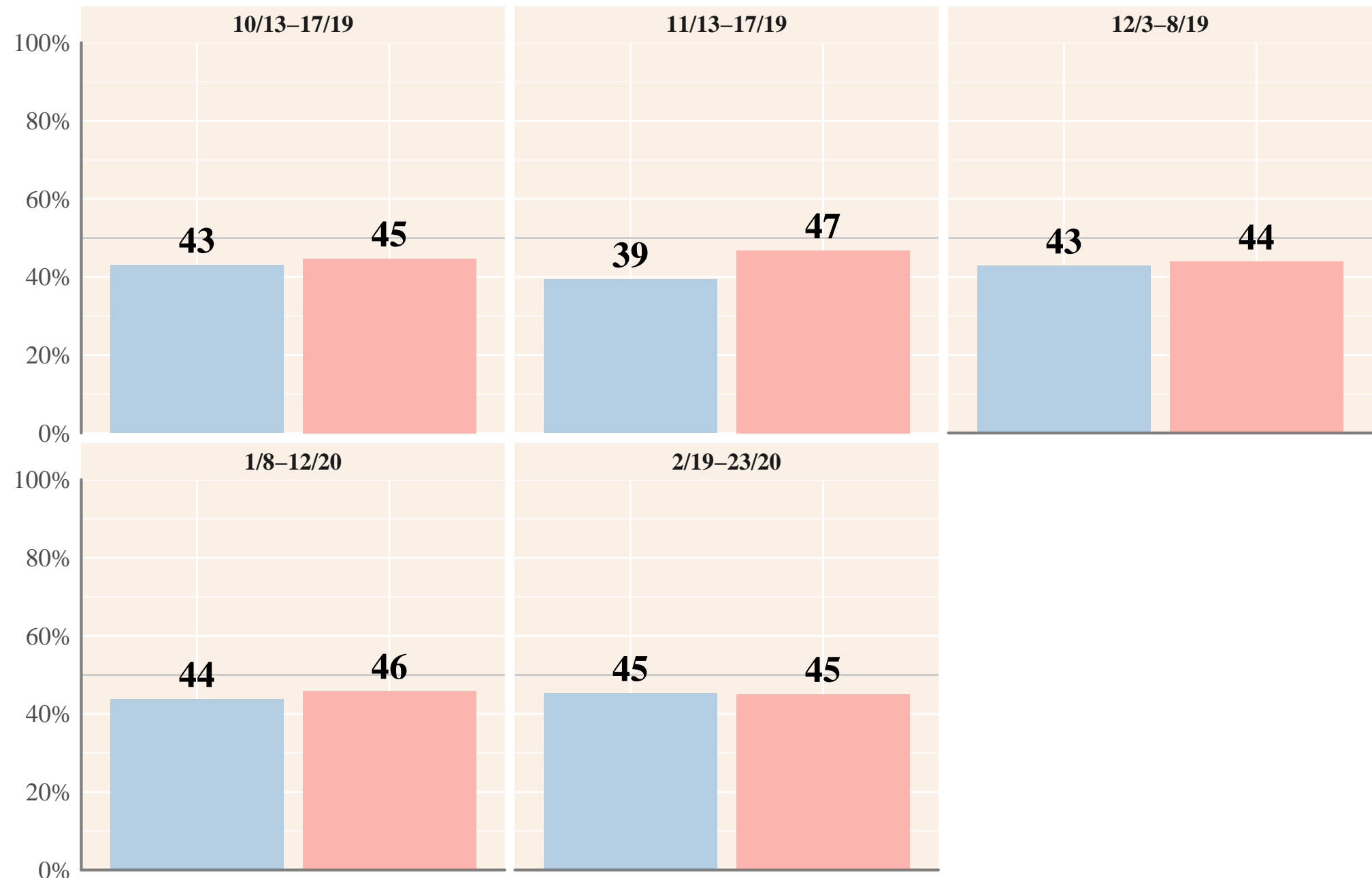

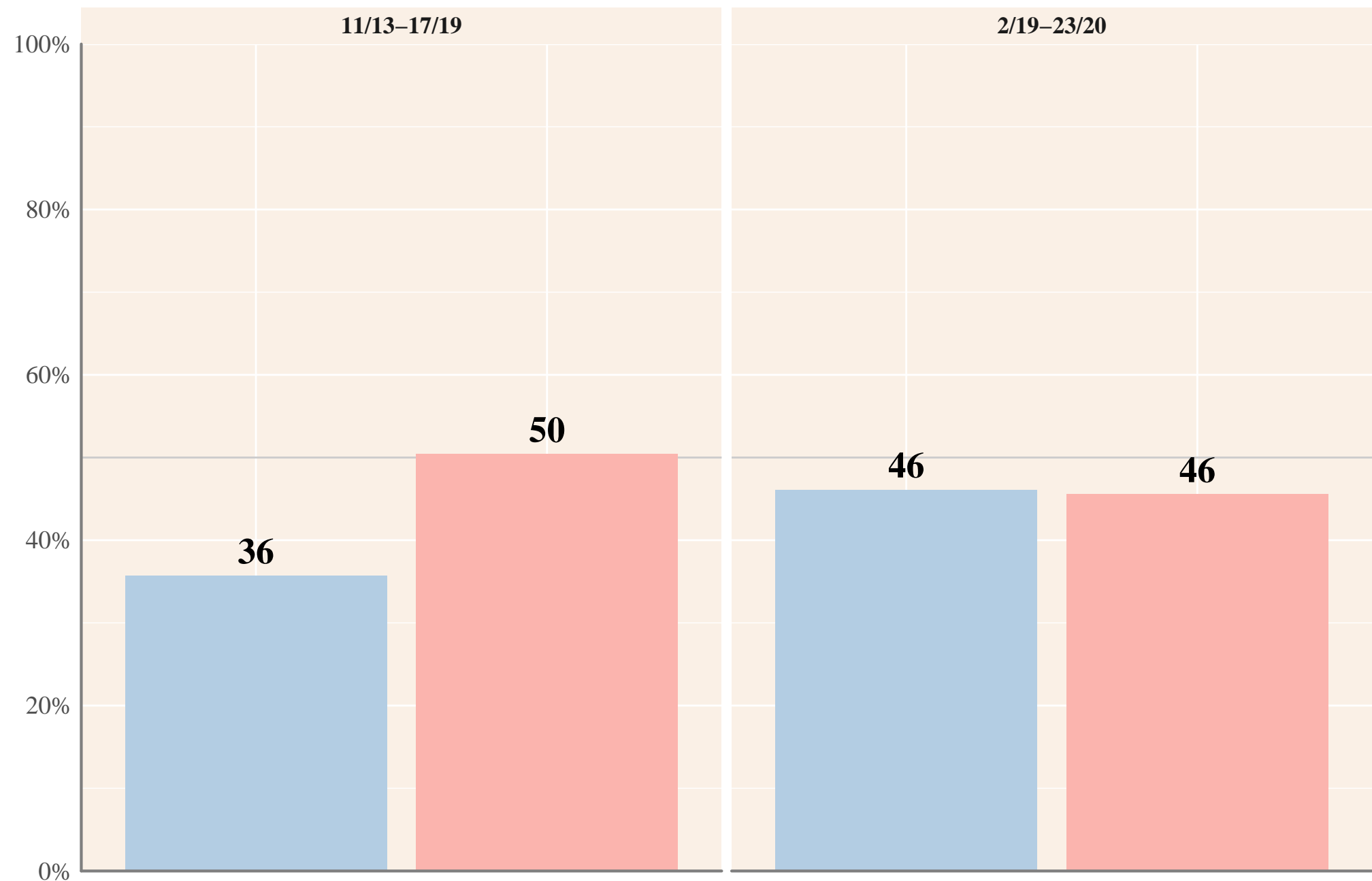

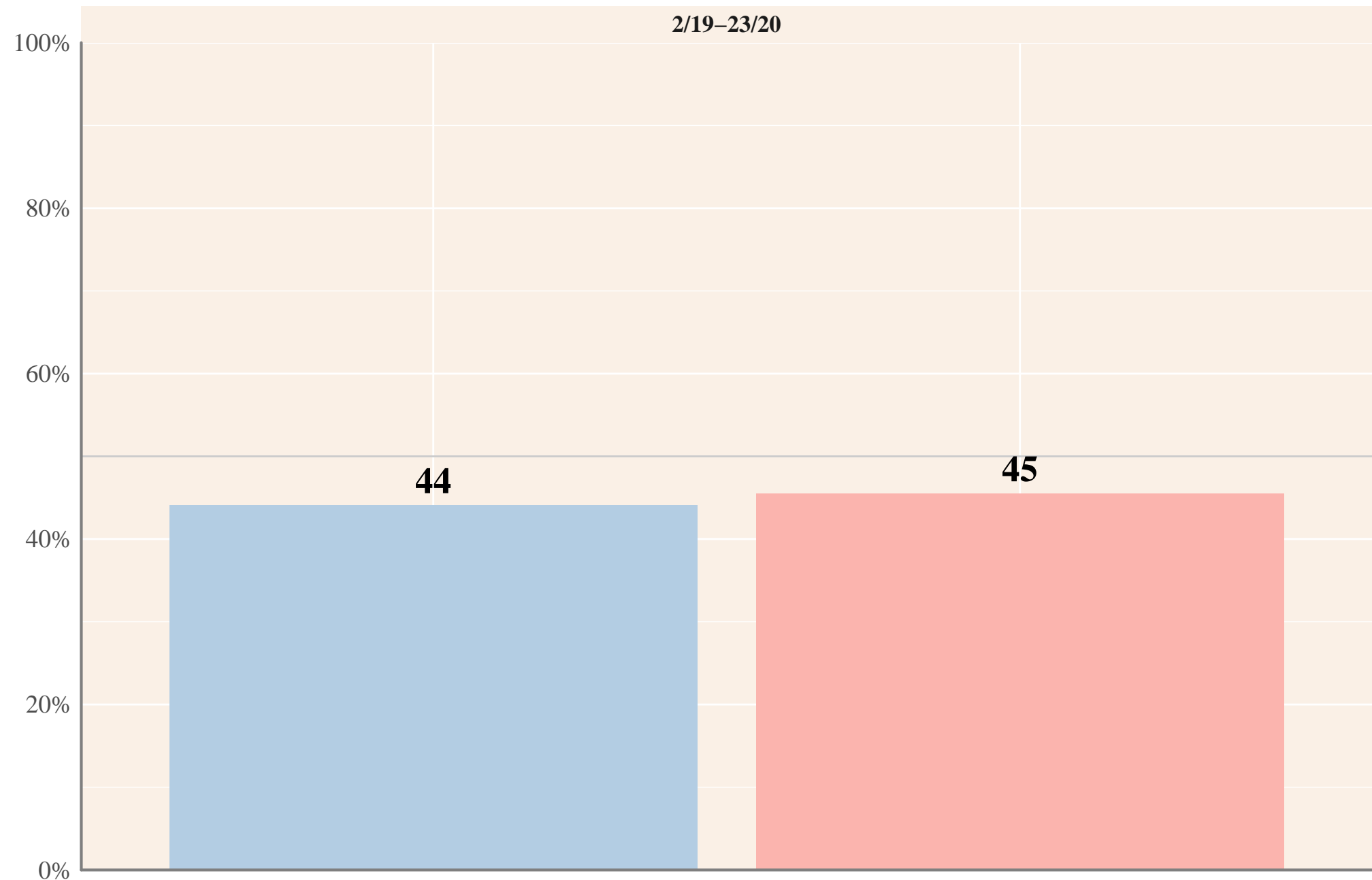

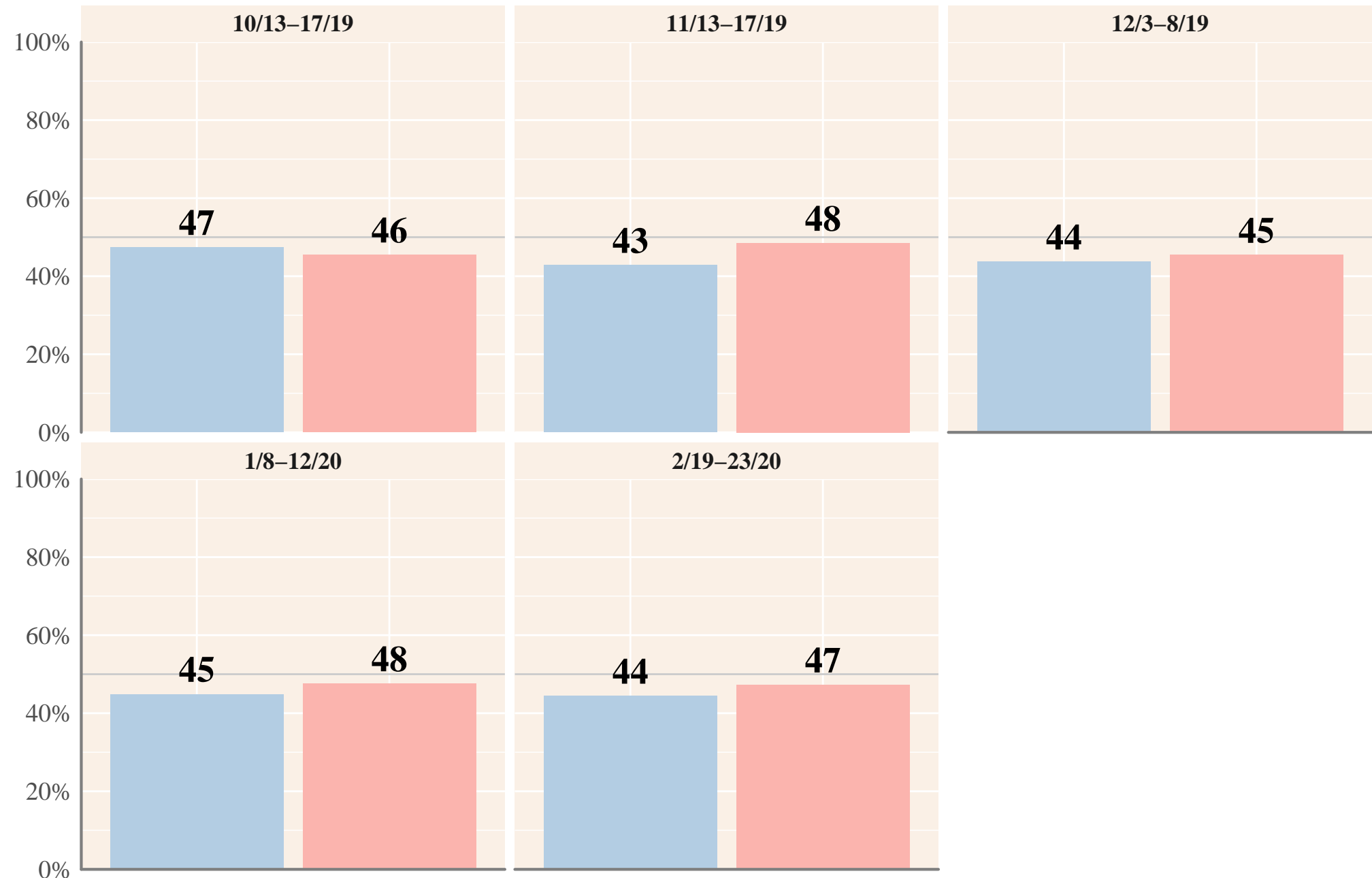

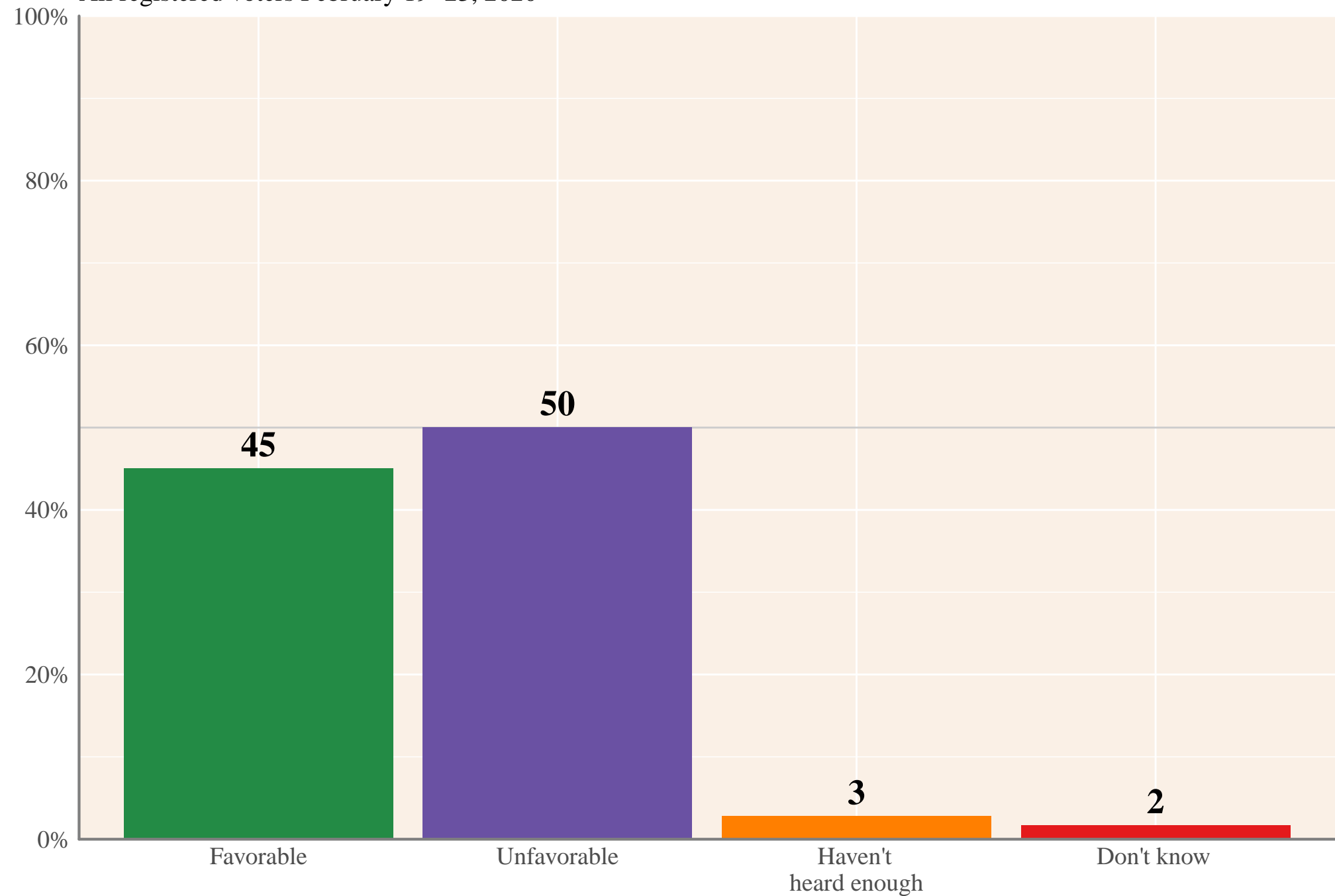

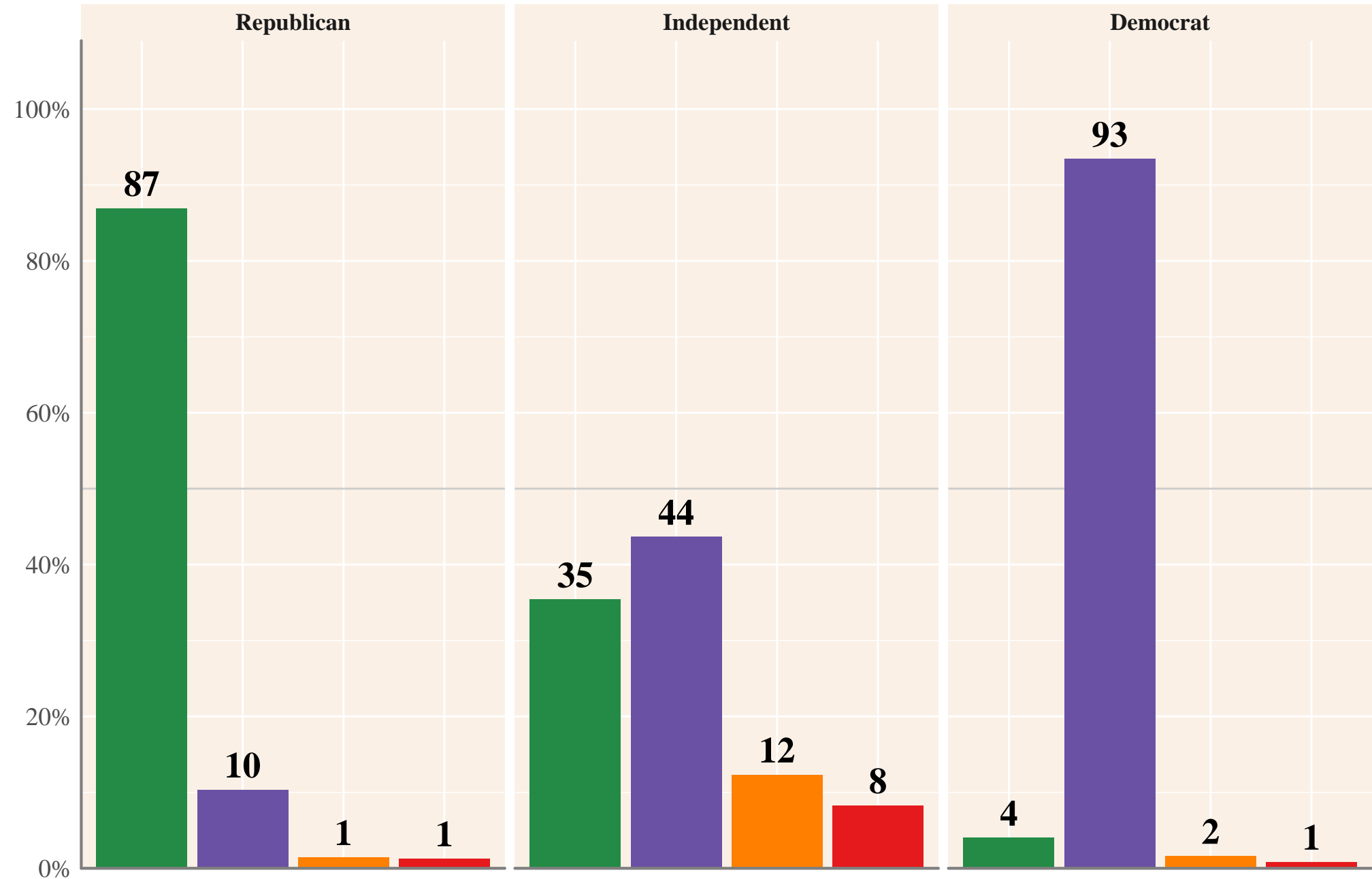

Trump favorability by party ID

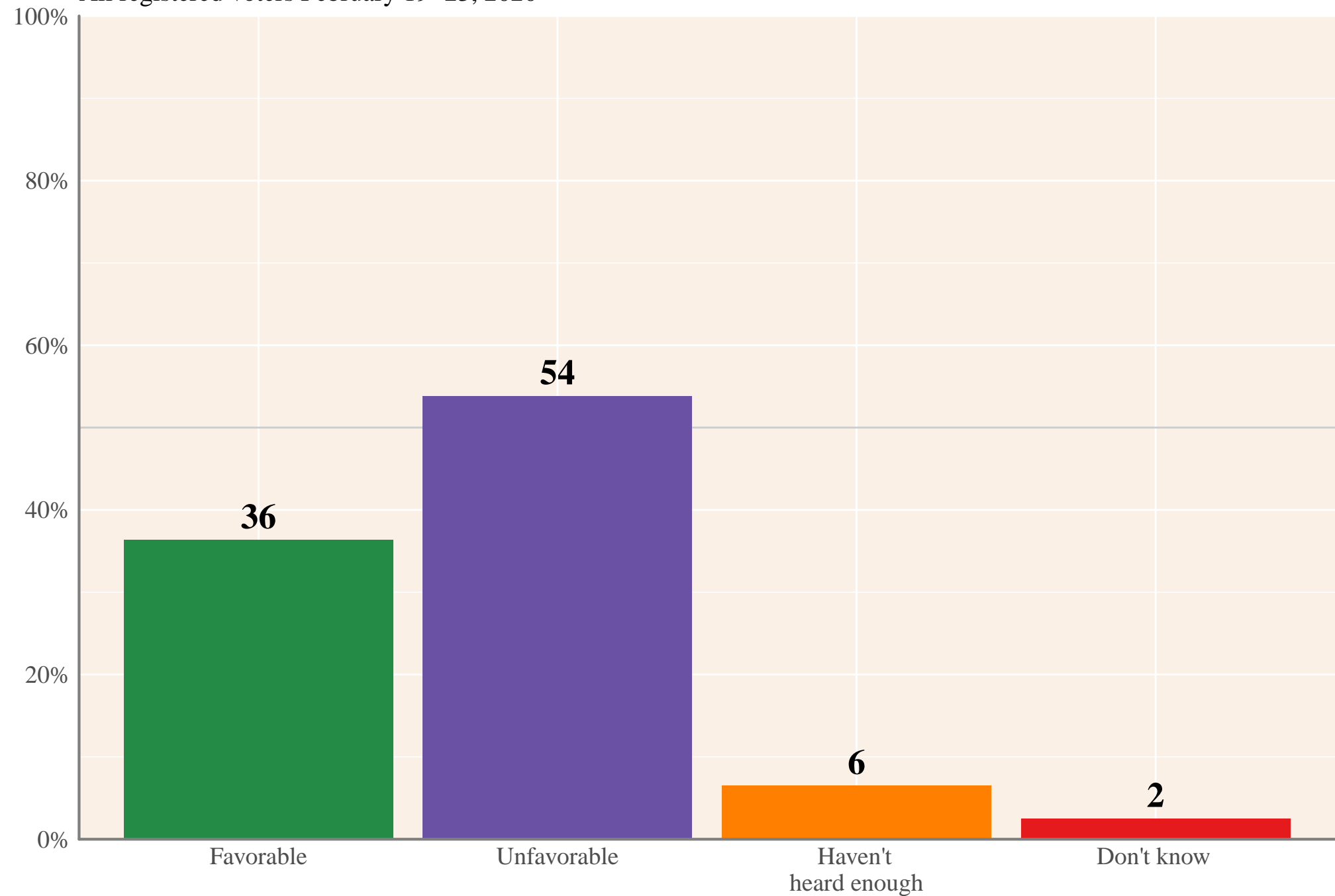

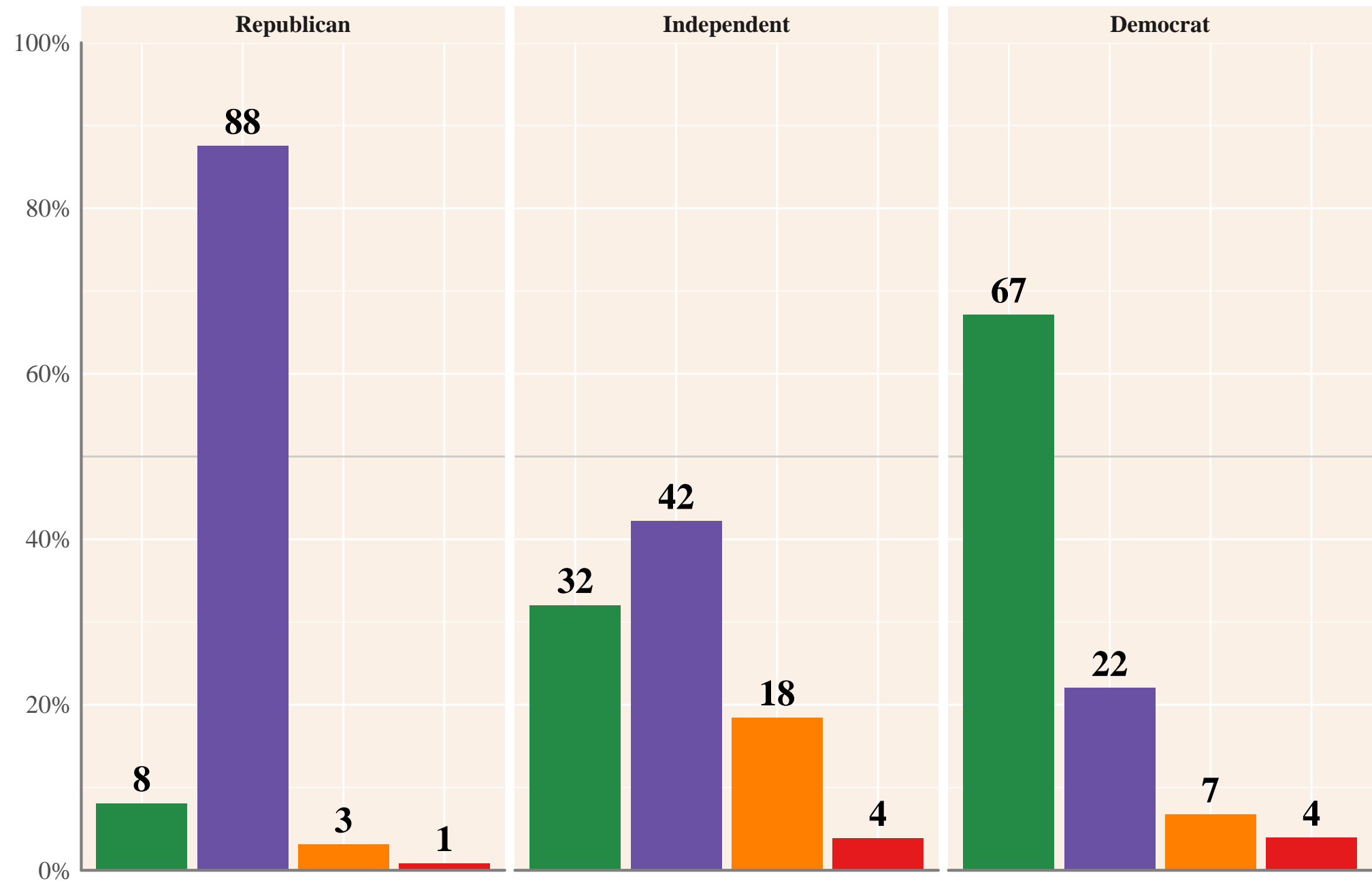

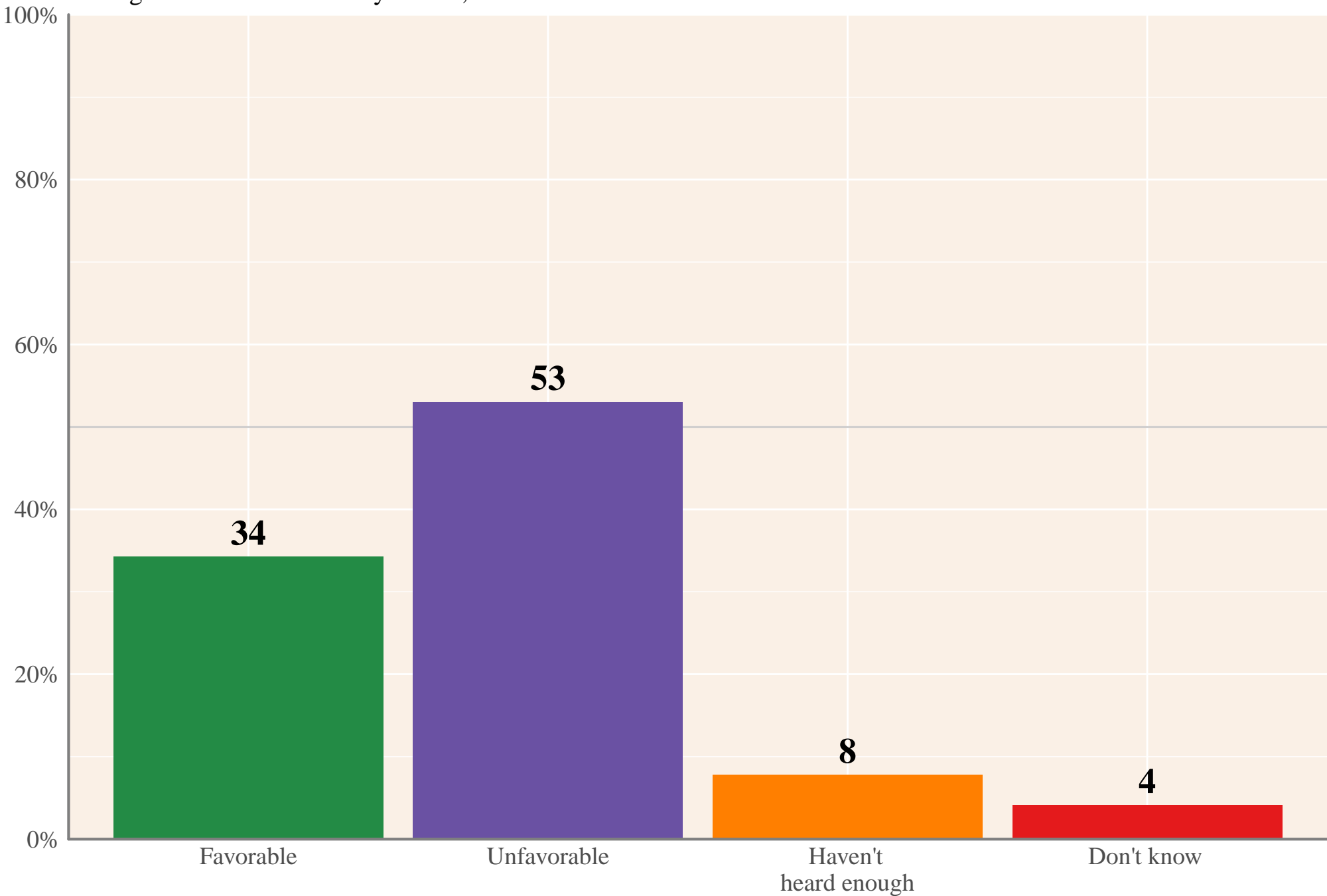

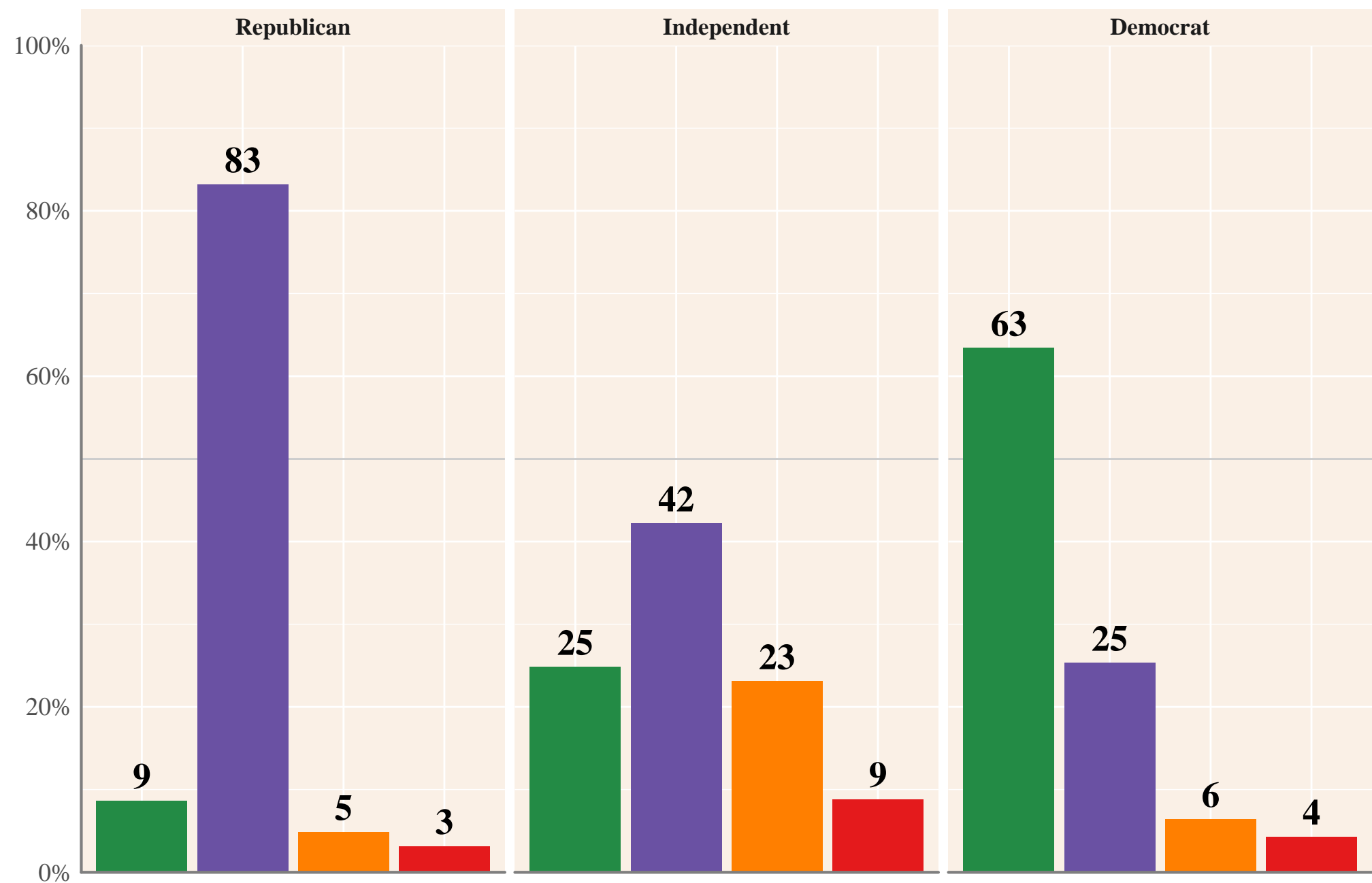

Biden favorability by party ID

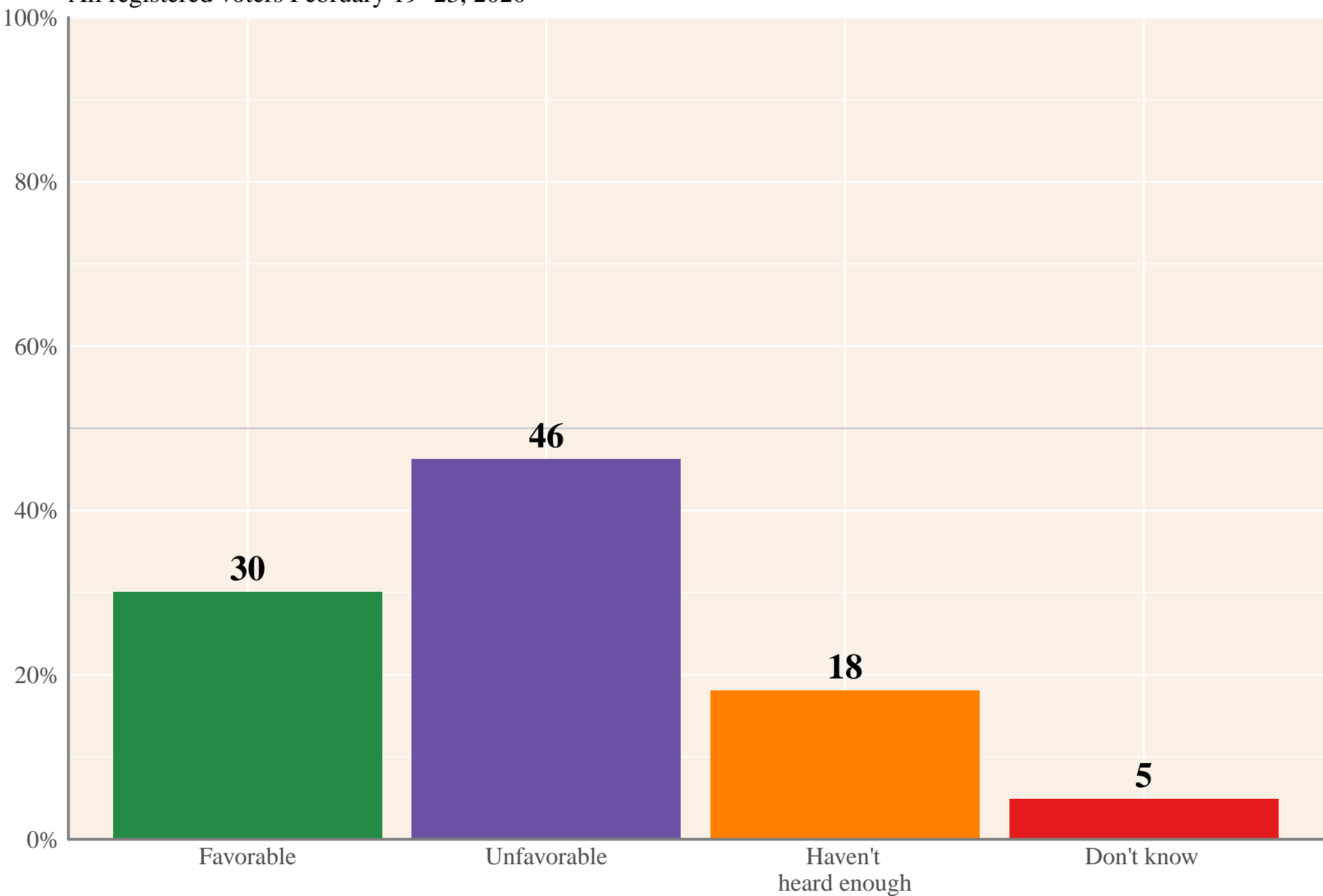

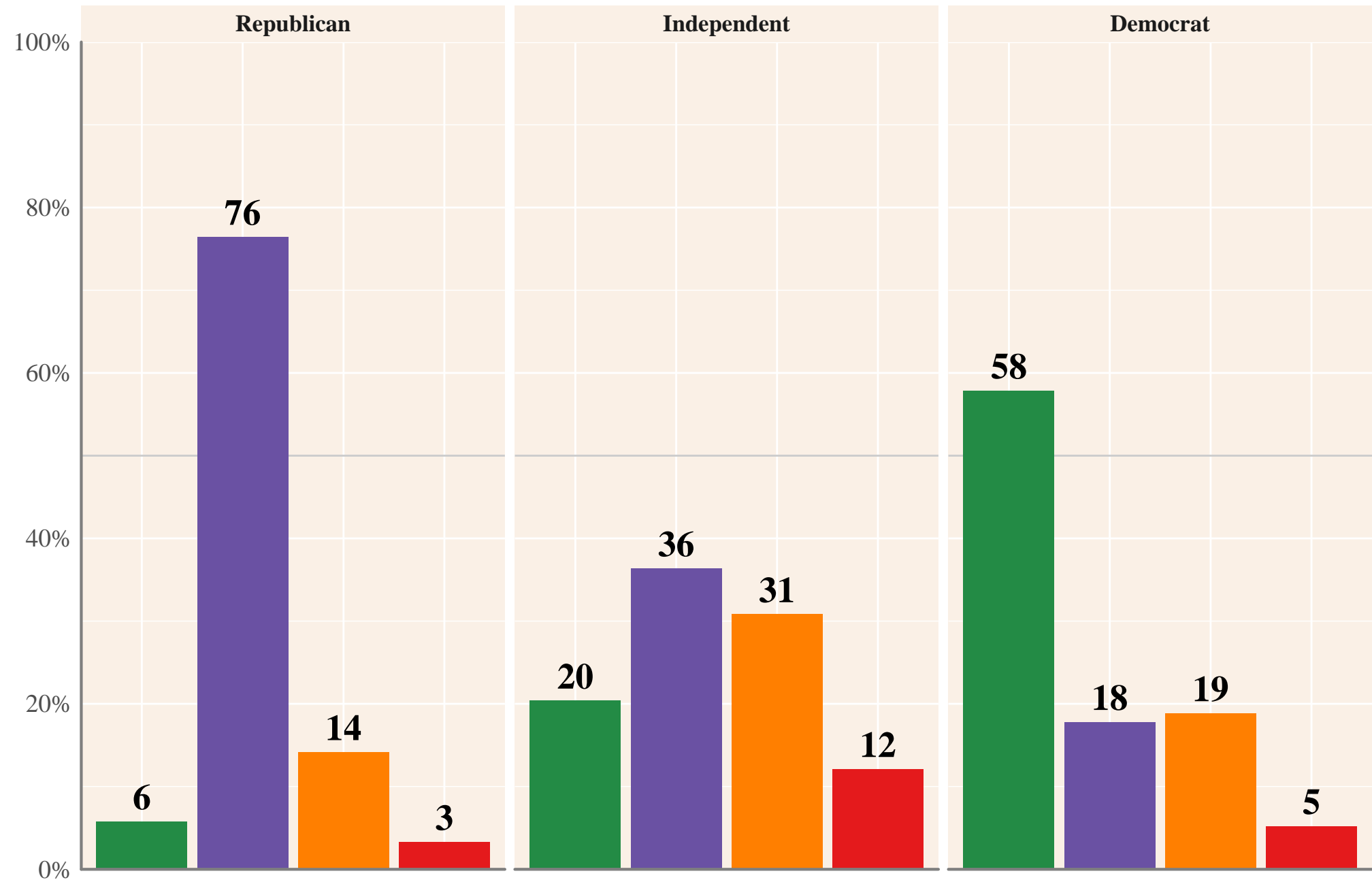

Warren favorability by party ID

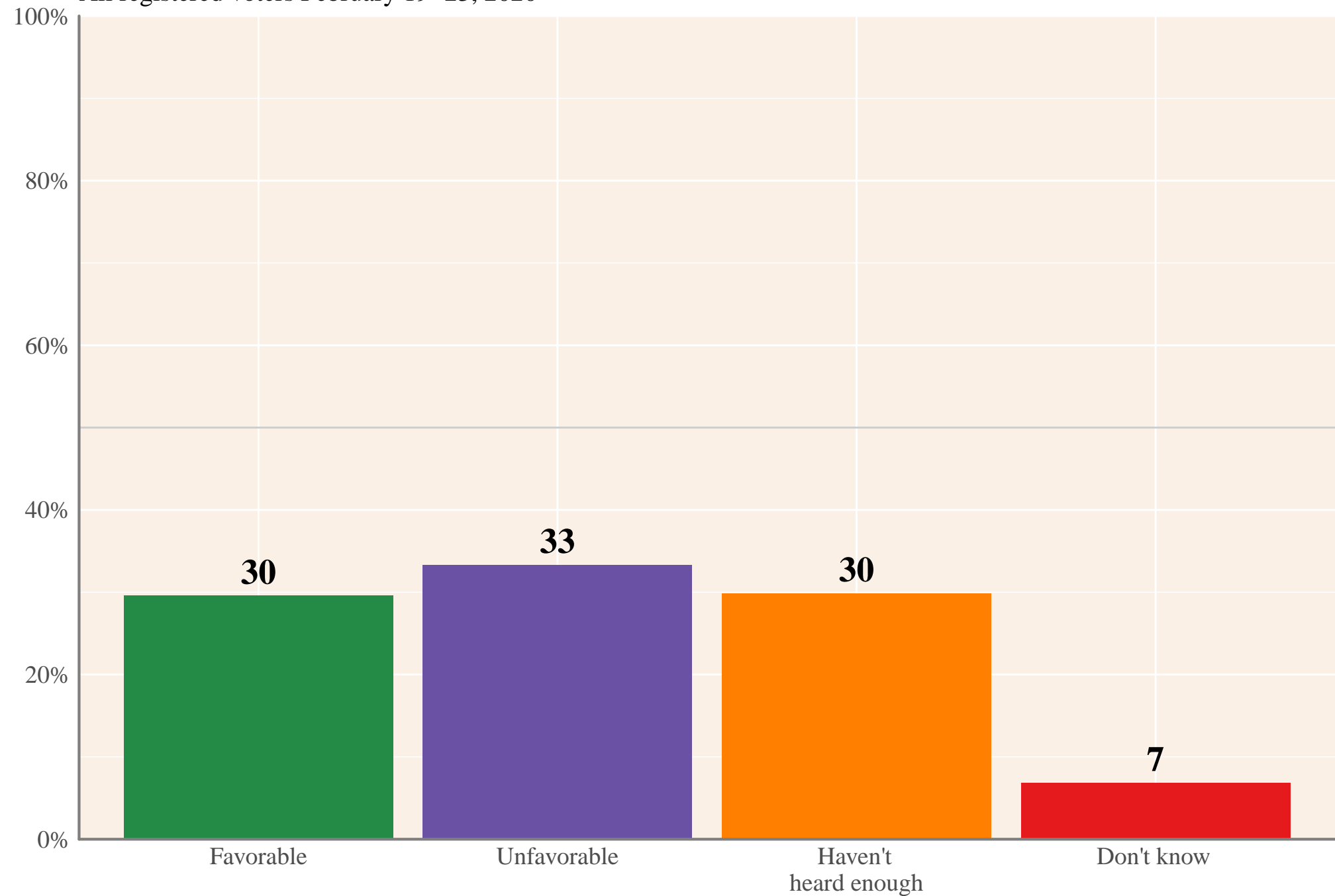

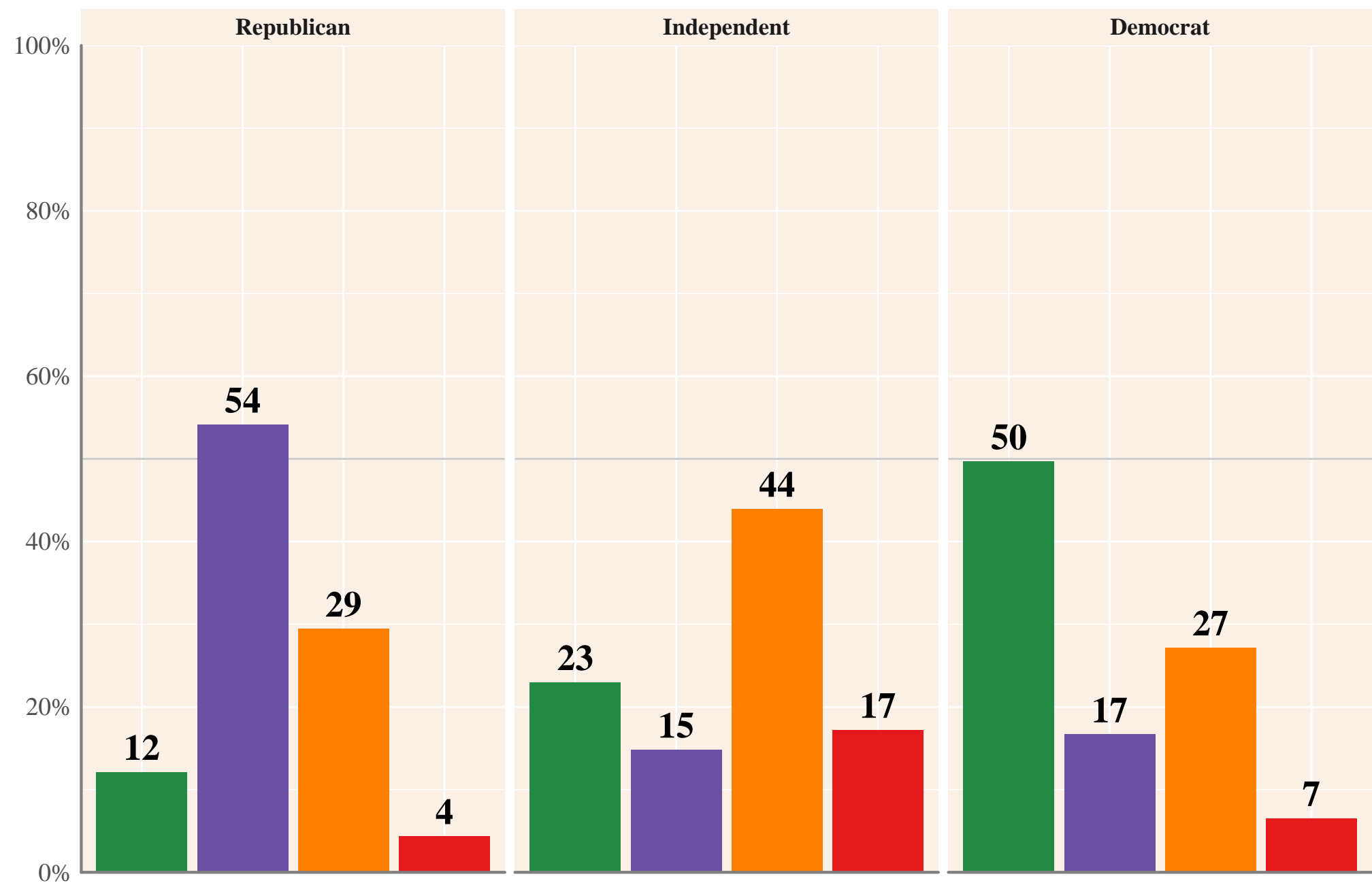

Buttigieg favorability by party ID

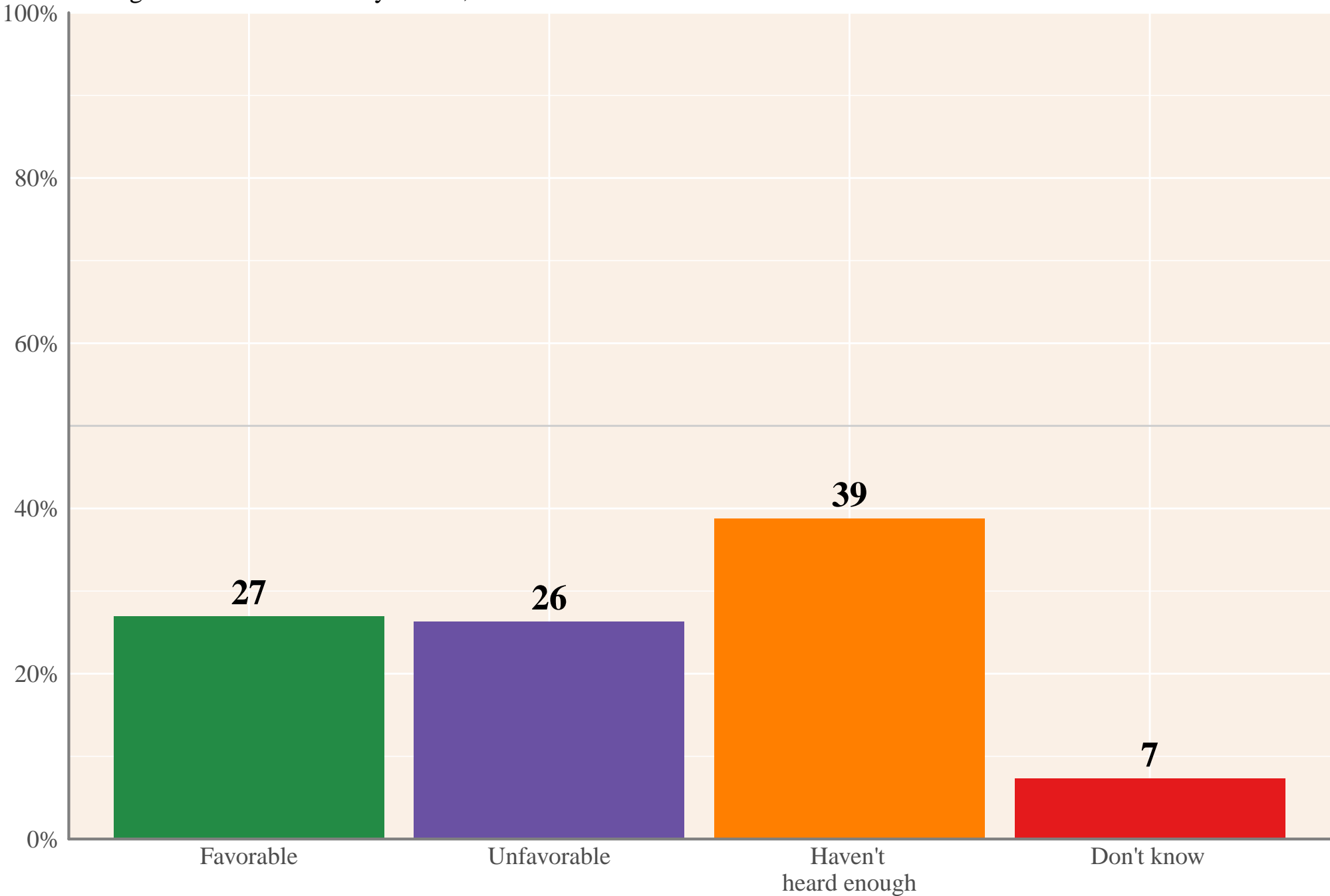

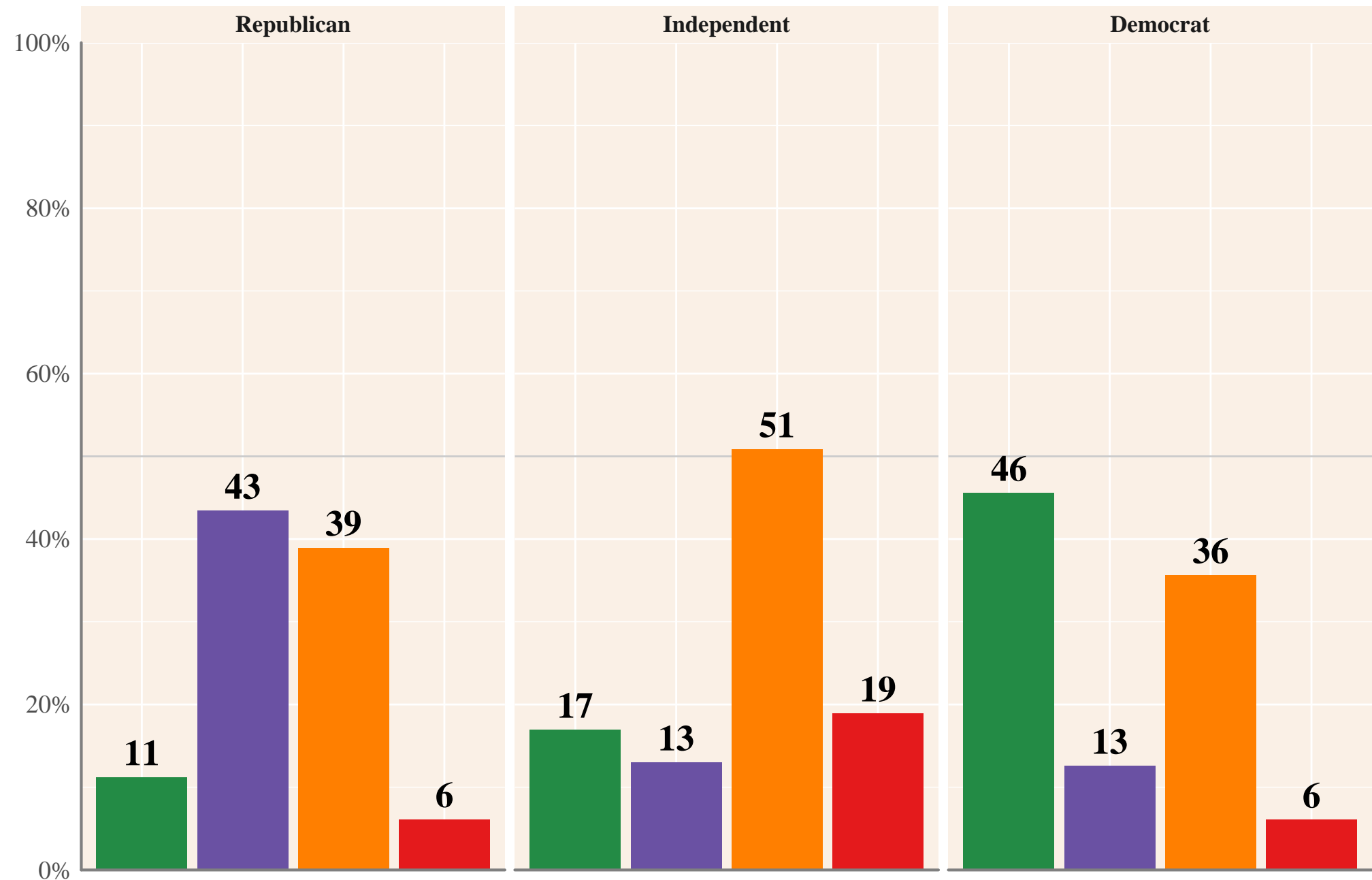

Klobuchar favorability by party ID

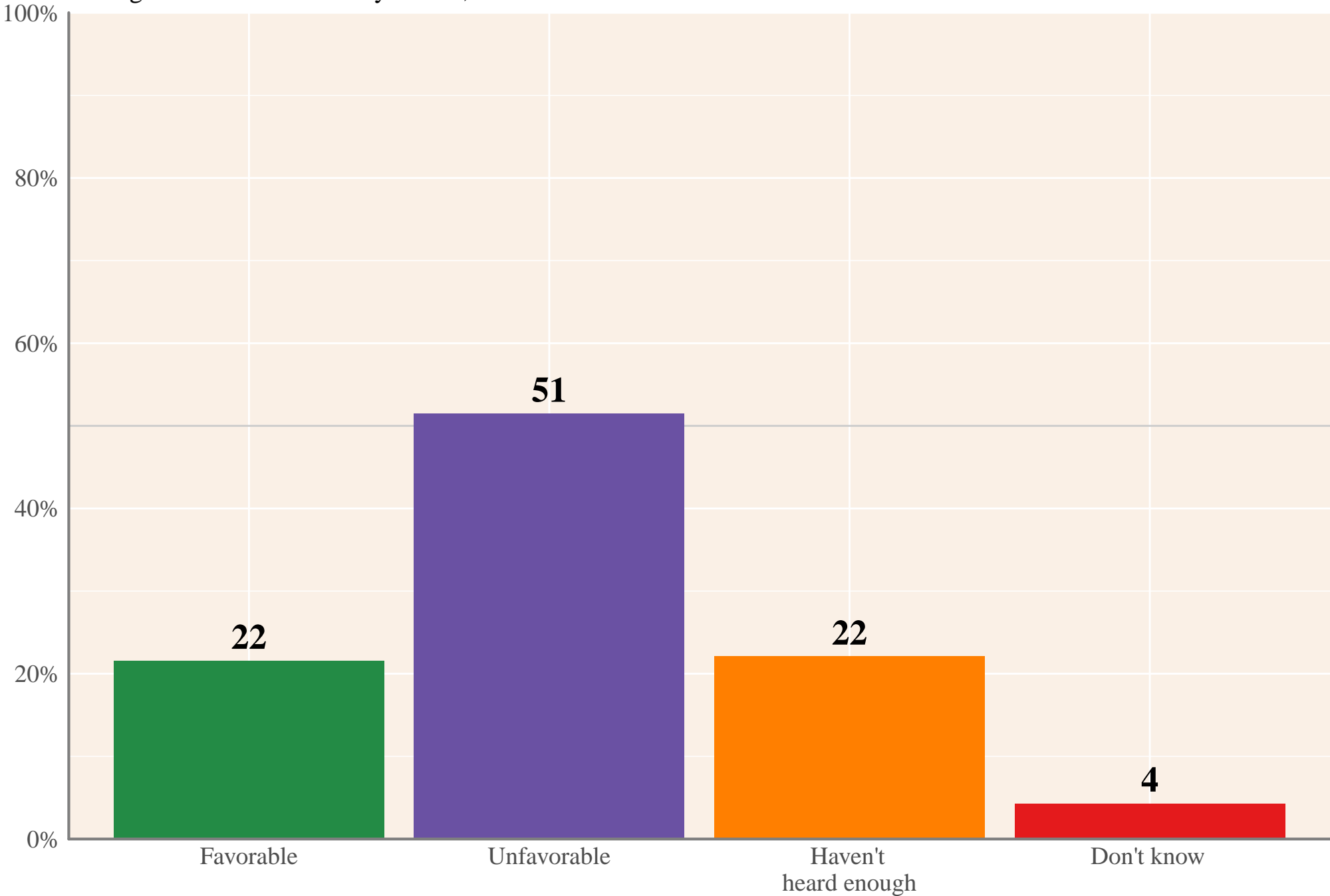

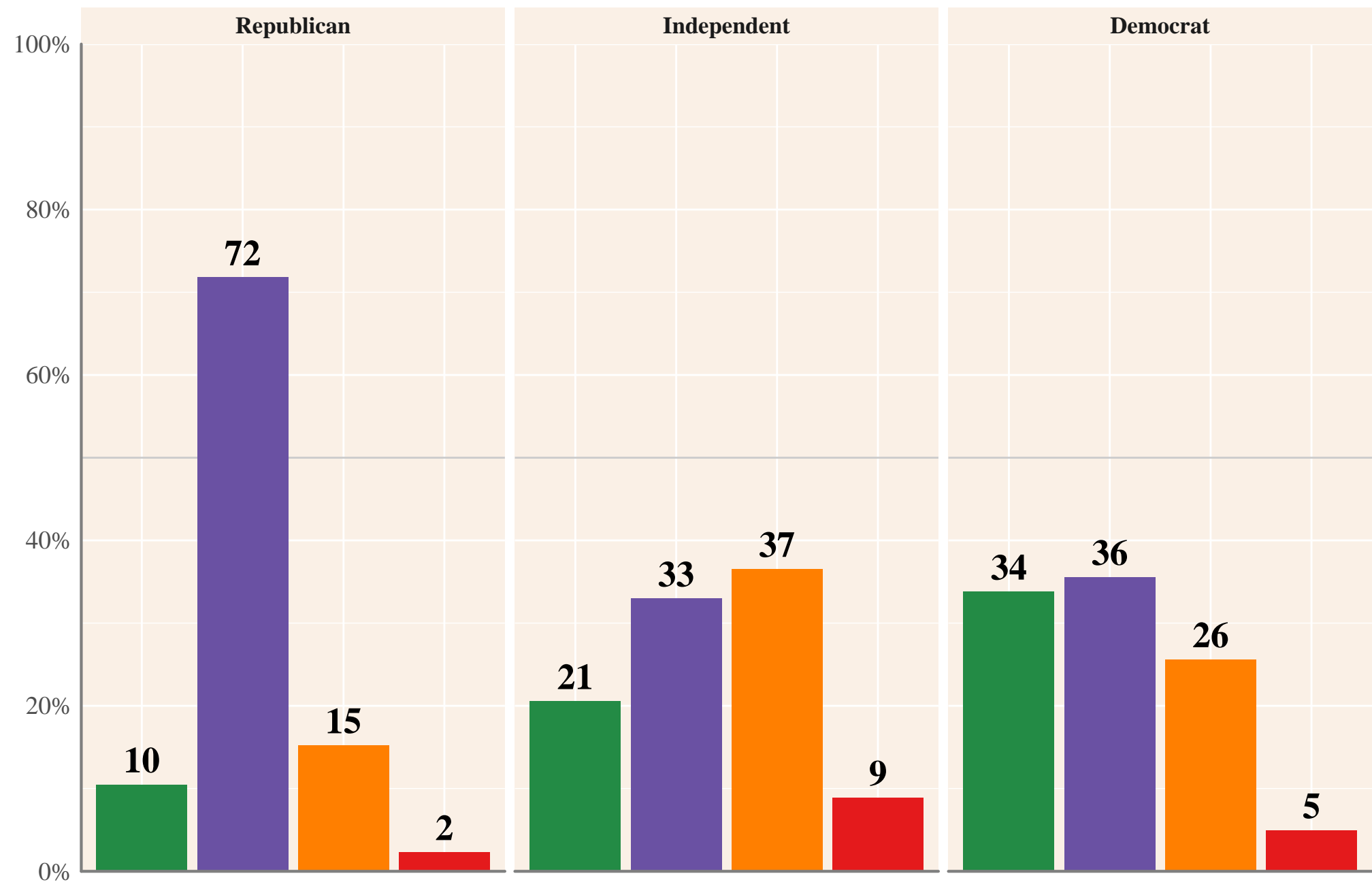

Bloomberg favorability by party ID

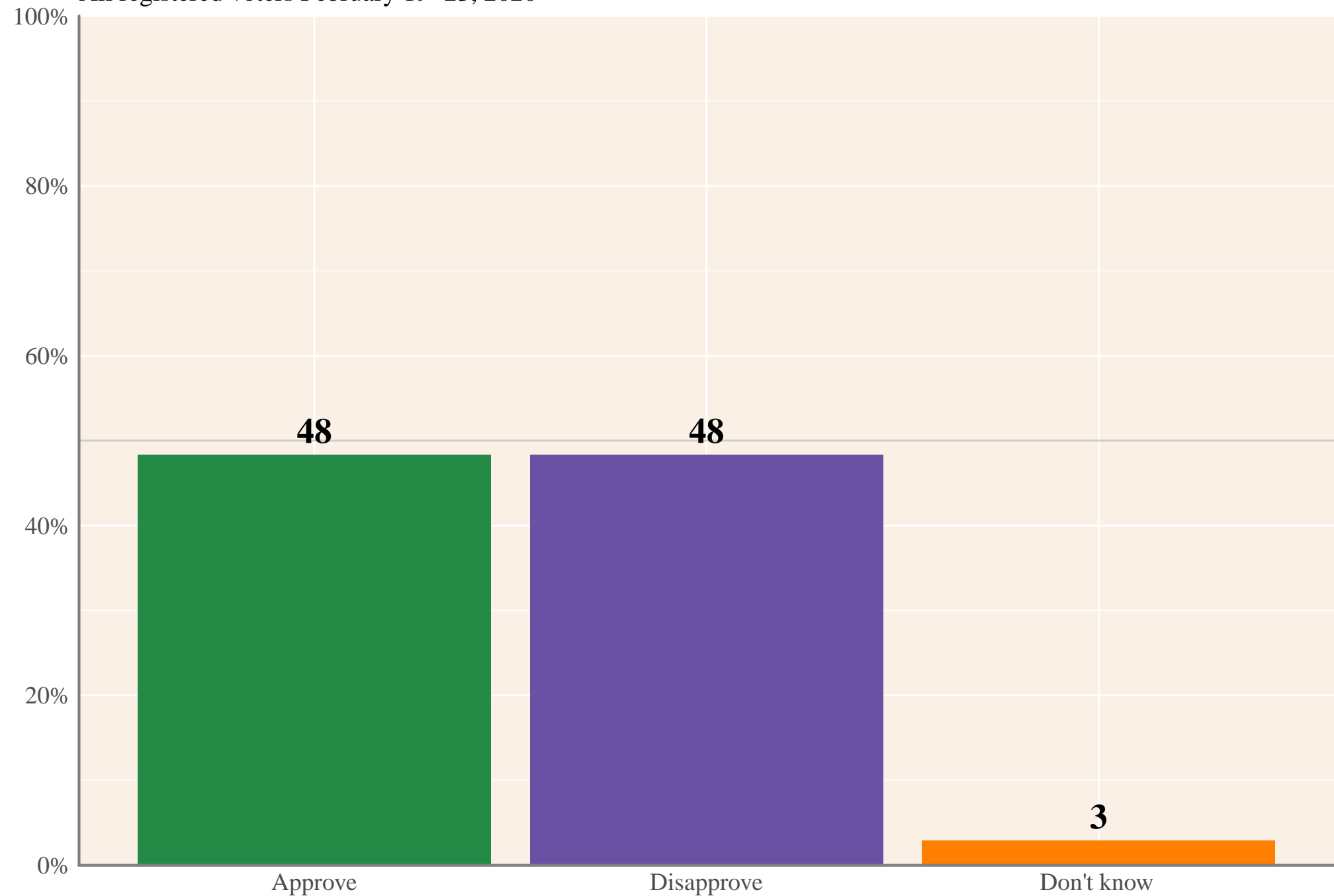

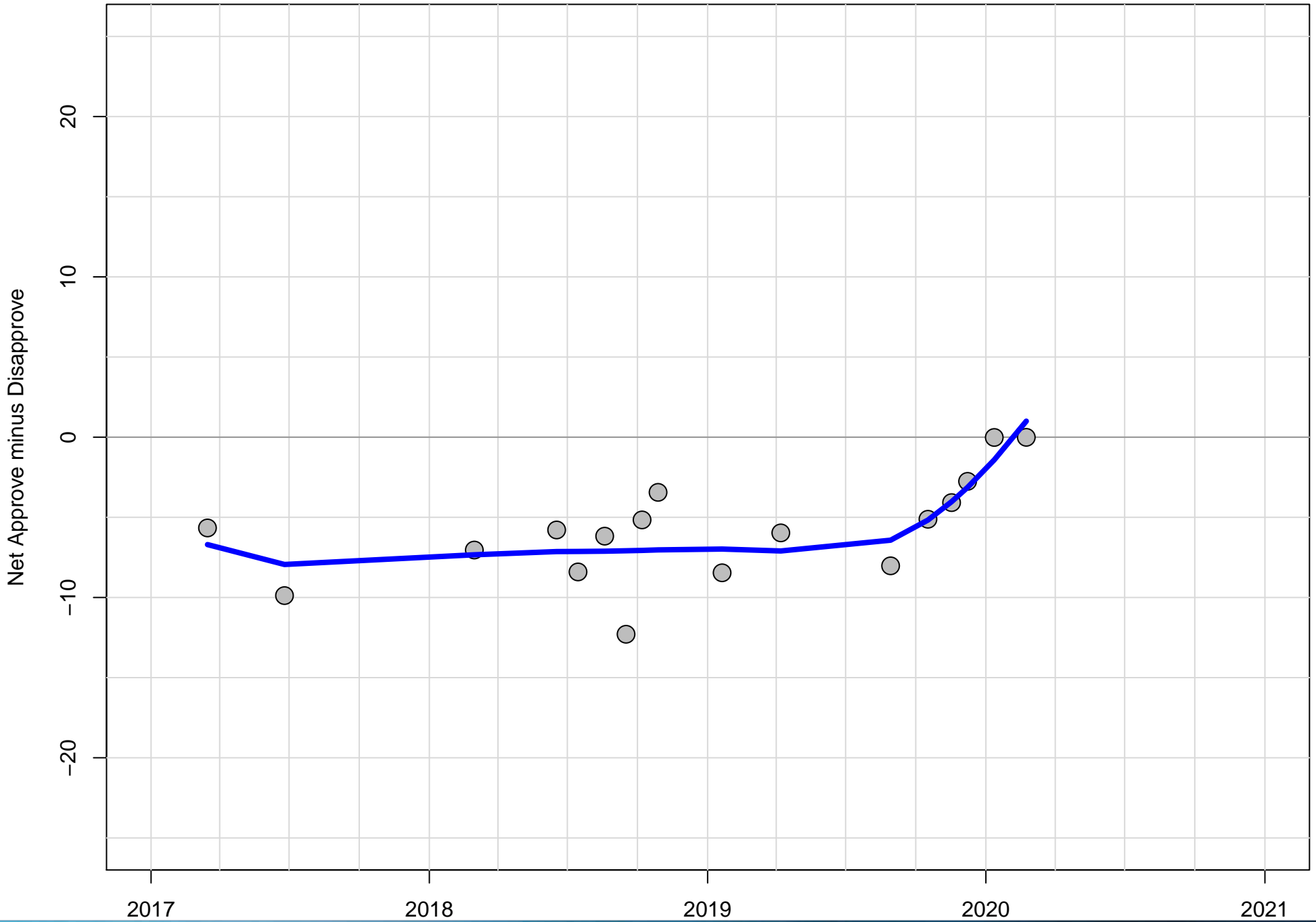


Overall, do you approve or disapprove of the way Donald Trump is handling his job as president?

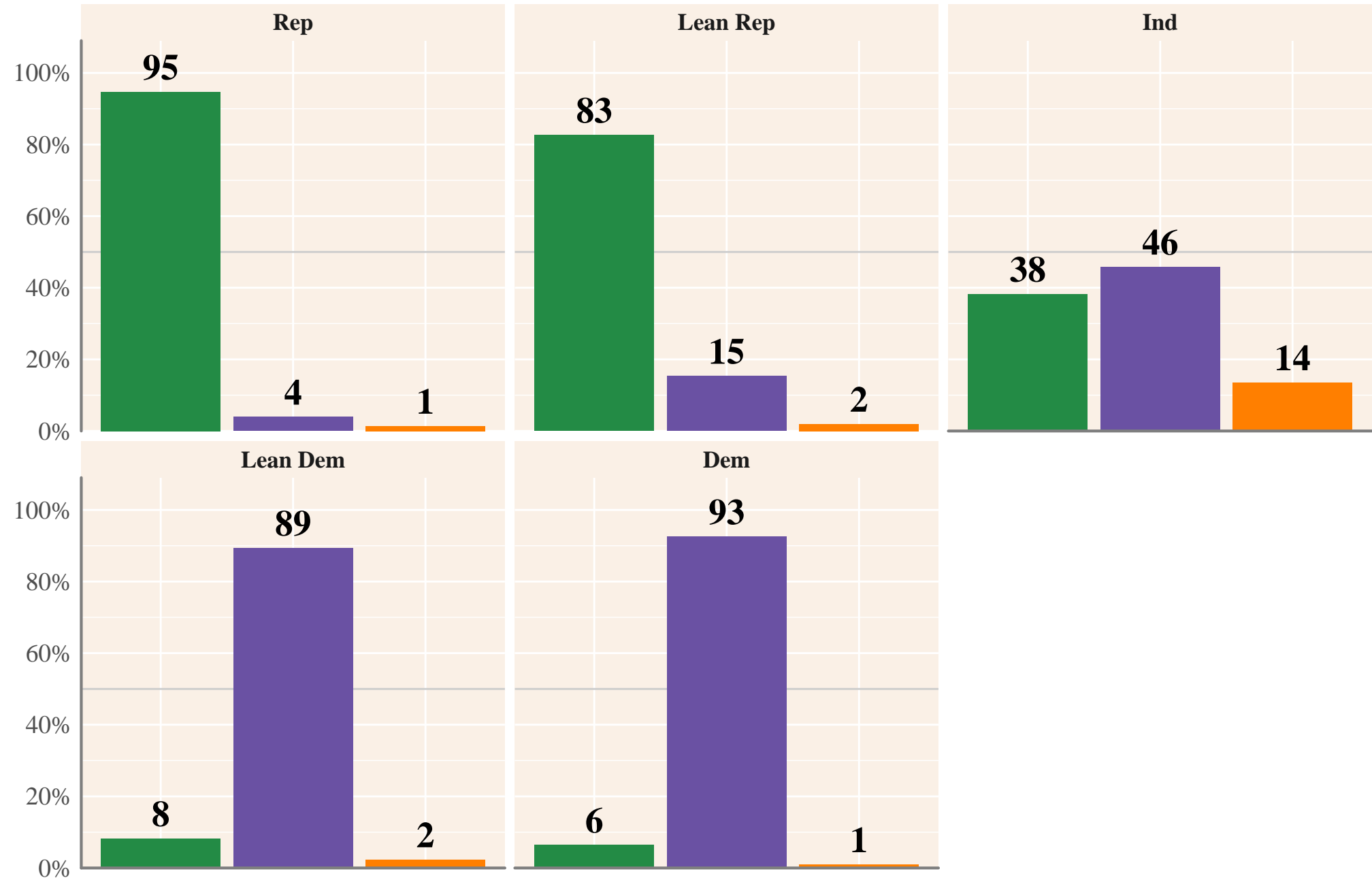
Trump Net Job Approval

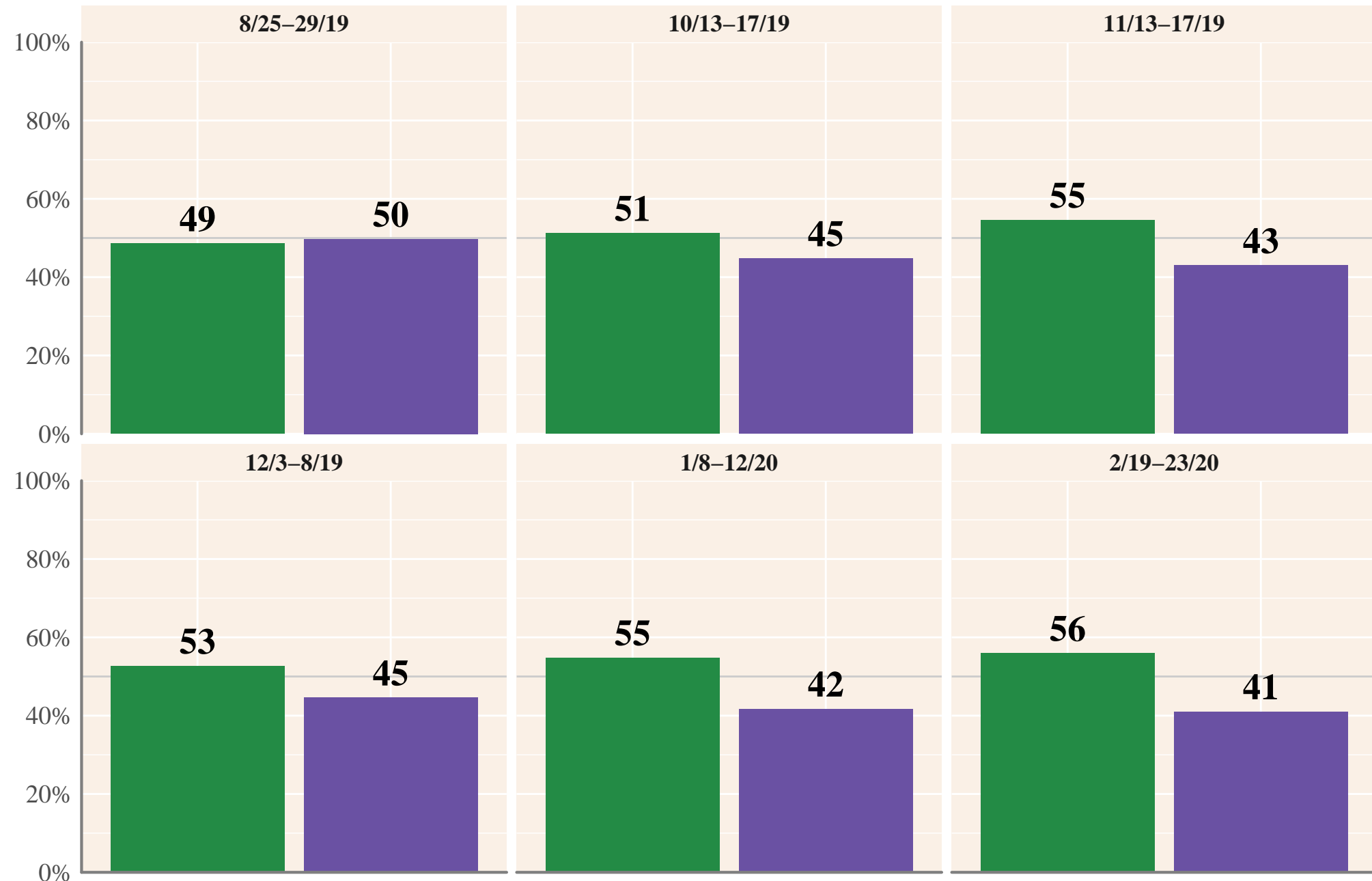

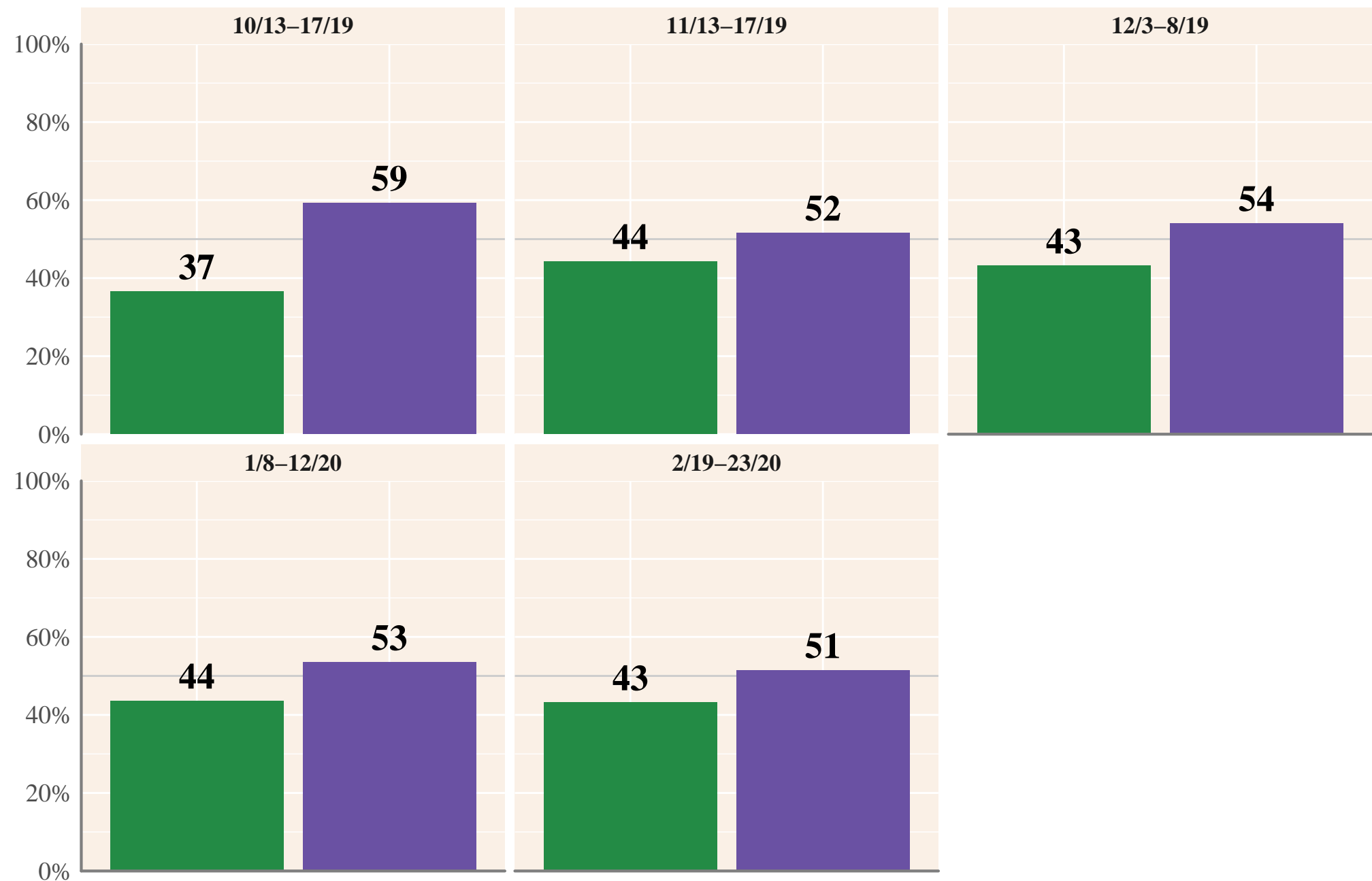

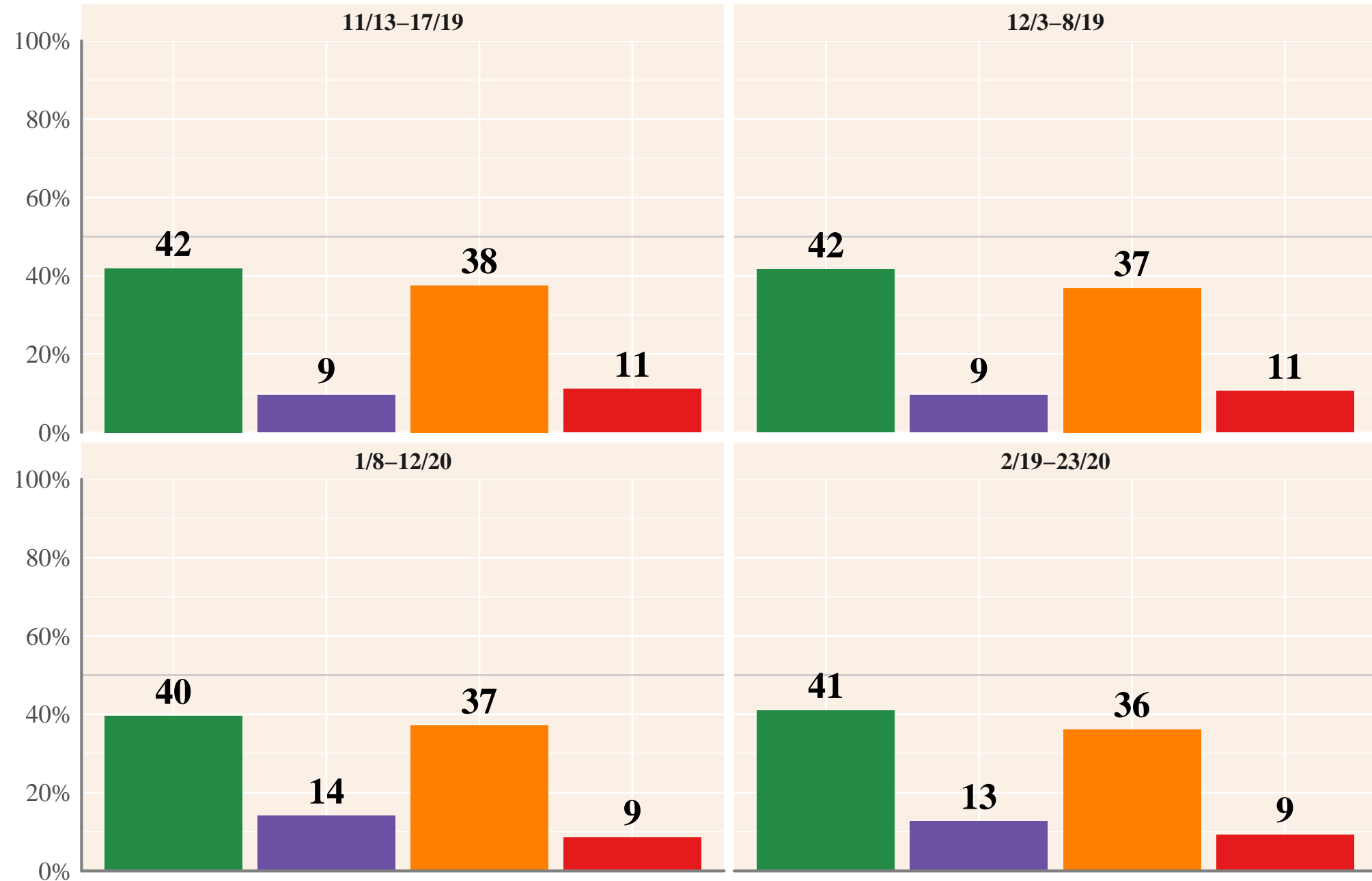

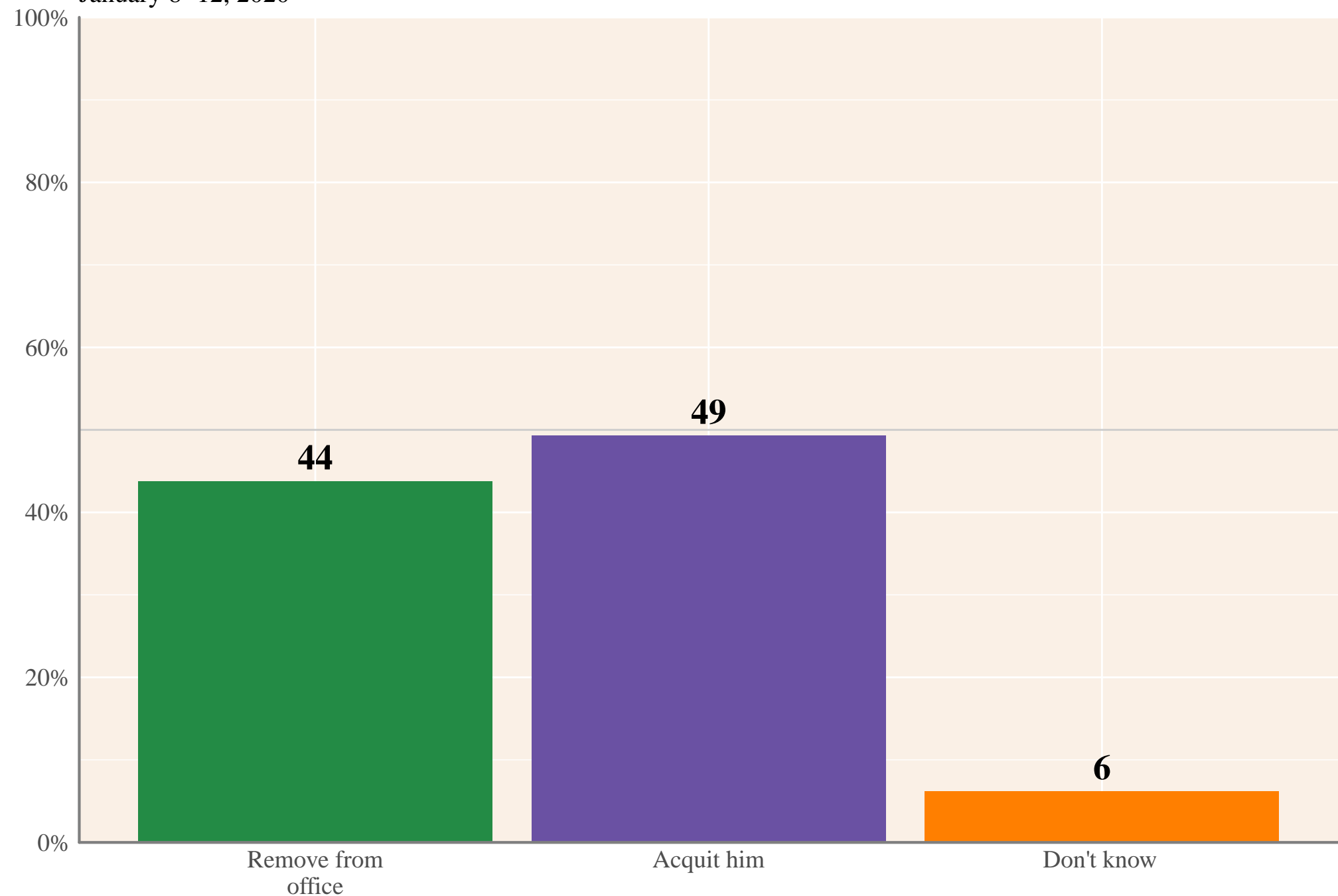

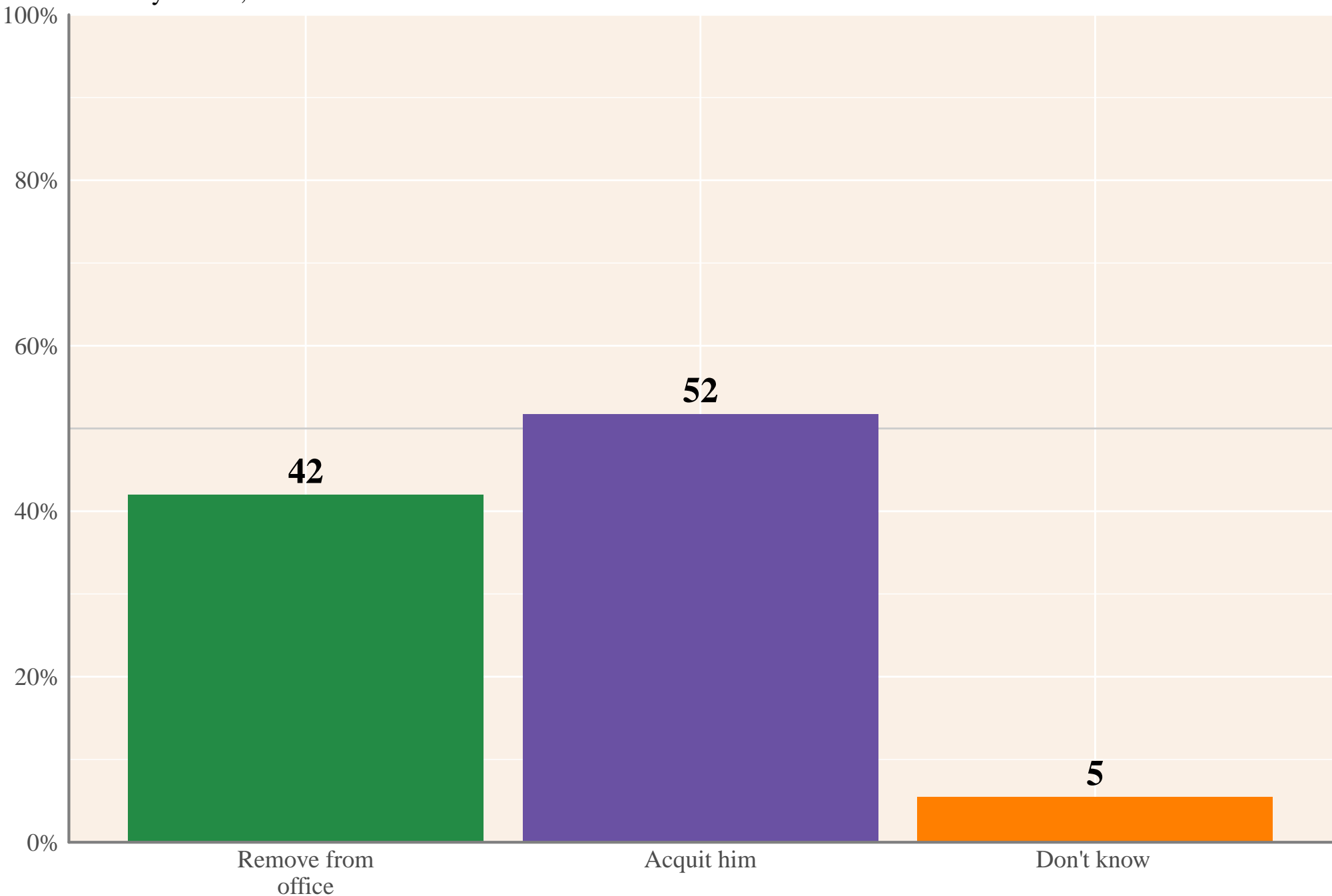
Do you think the U.S. Senate should vote to remove Donald Trump from office or should it vote to acquit him of the impeachment charges?

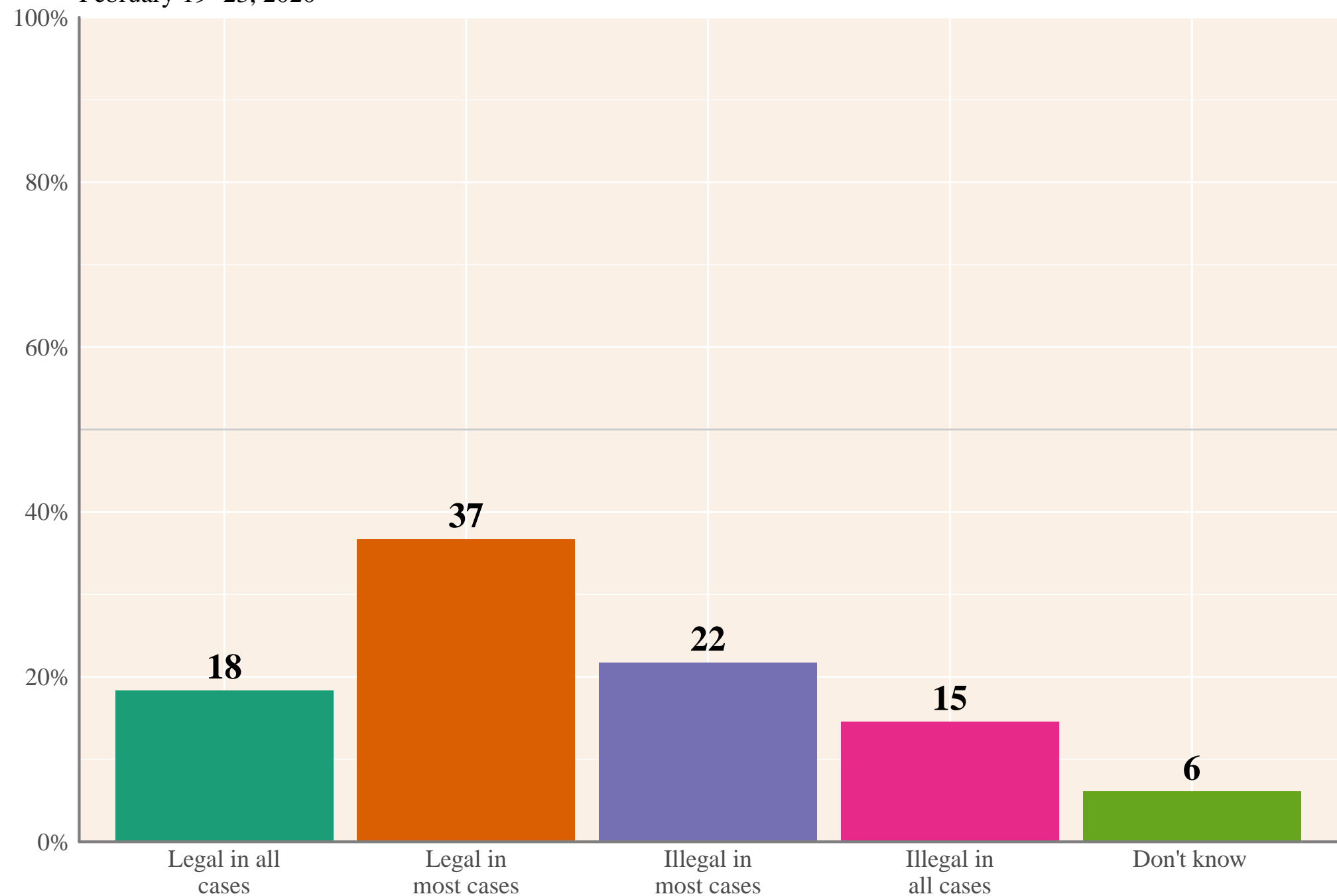
Do you think the U.S. Senate should have voted to remove Donald Trump from office or should it have voted to acquit him of the impeachment charges?

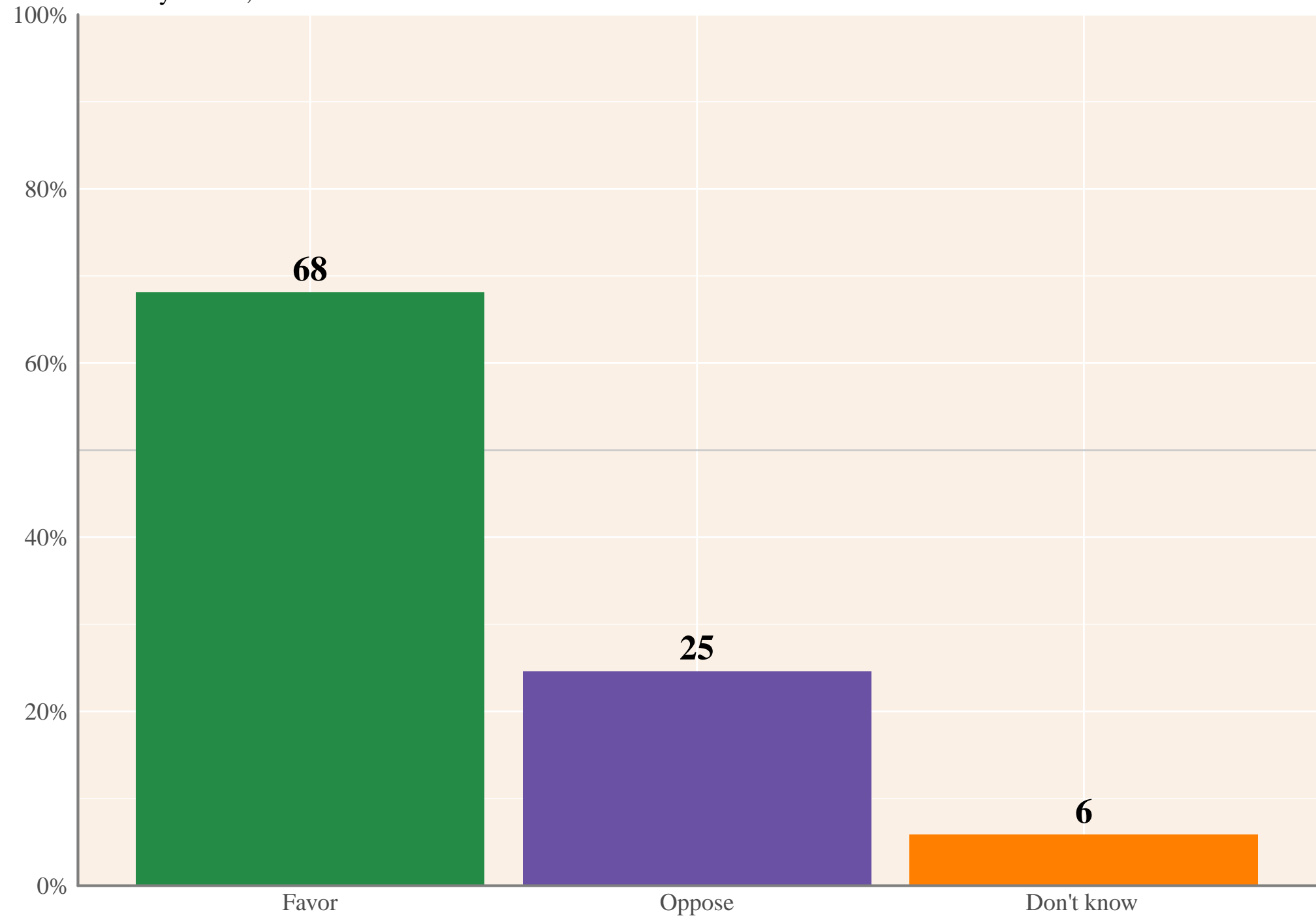
Do you think abortion should be legal in all cases, legal in most cases, illegal in most cases, or illegal in all cases?"

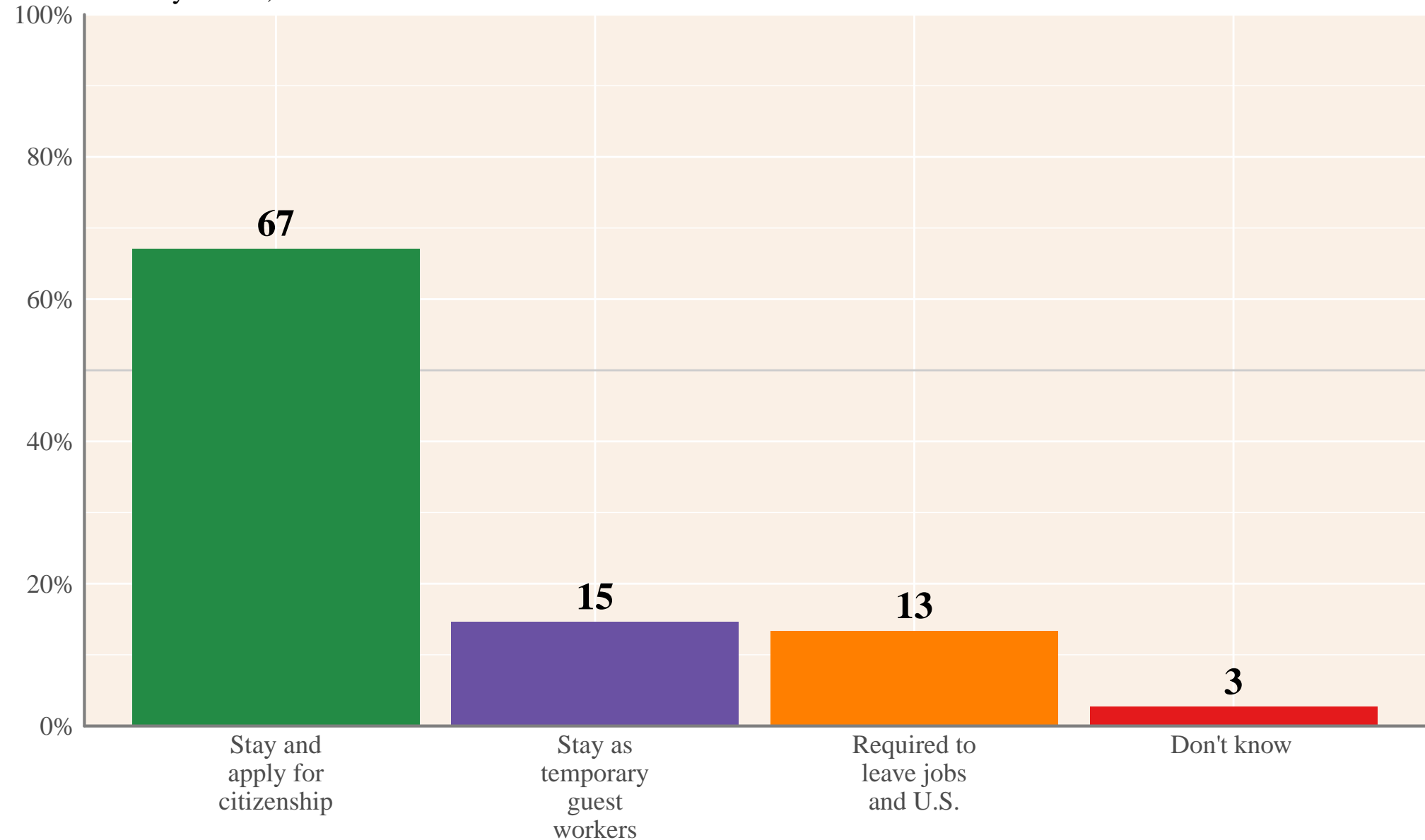
Do you favor or oppose allowing gays and lesbians to marry legally

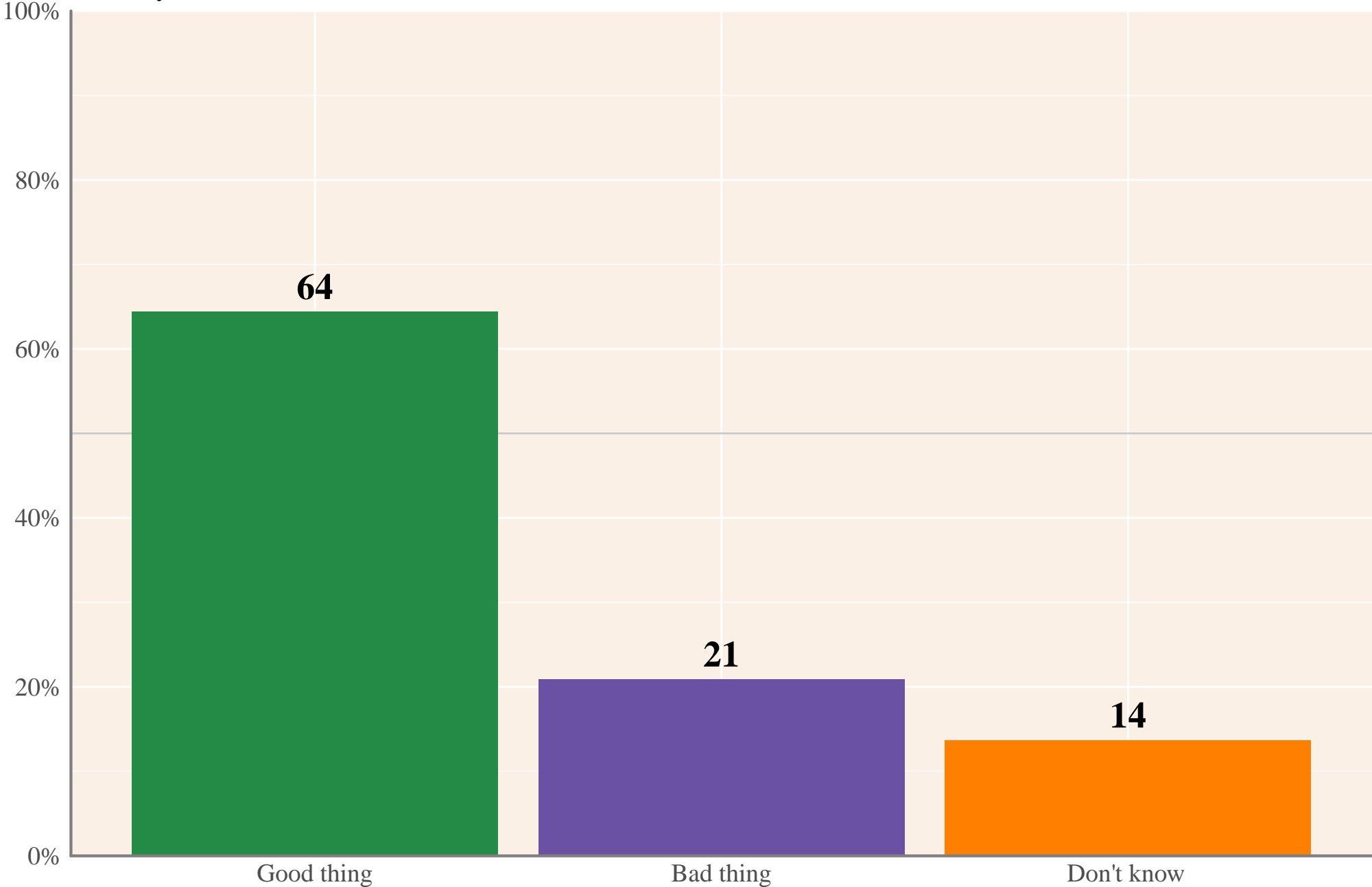

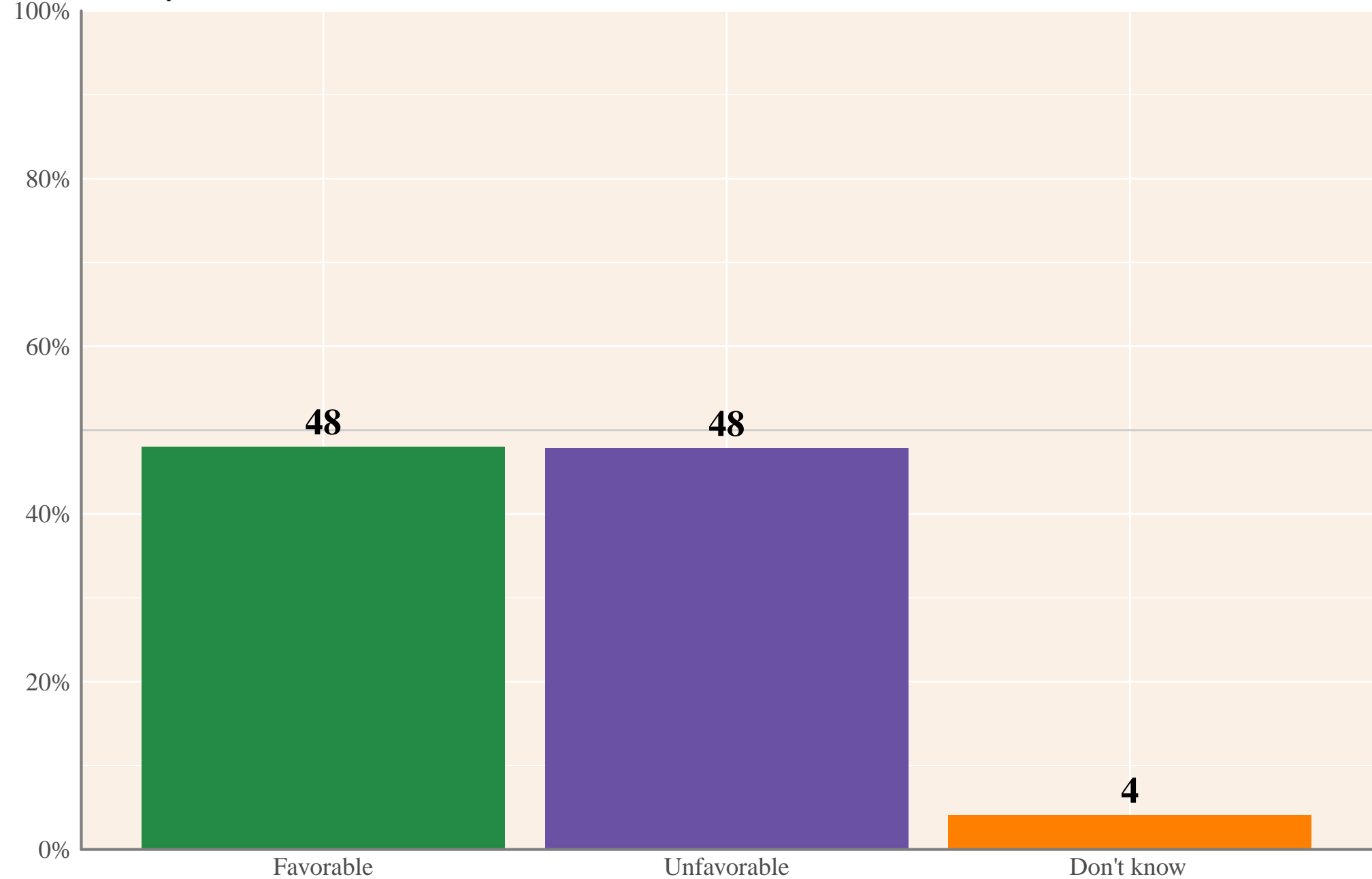
Thinking about free trade agreements...In general, do you think that free trade agreements between the US and other countries have been a good thing or a bad thing for the United States

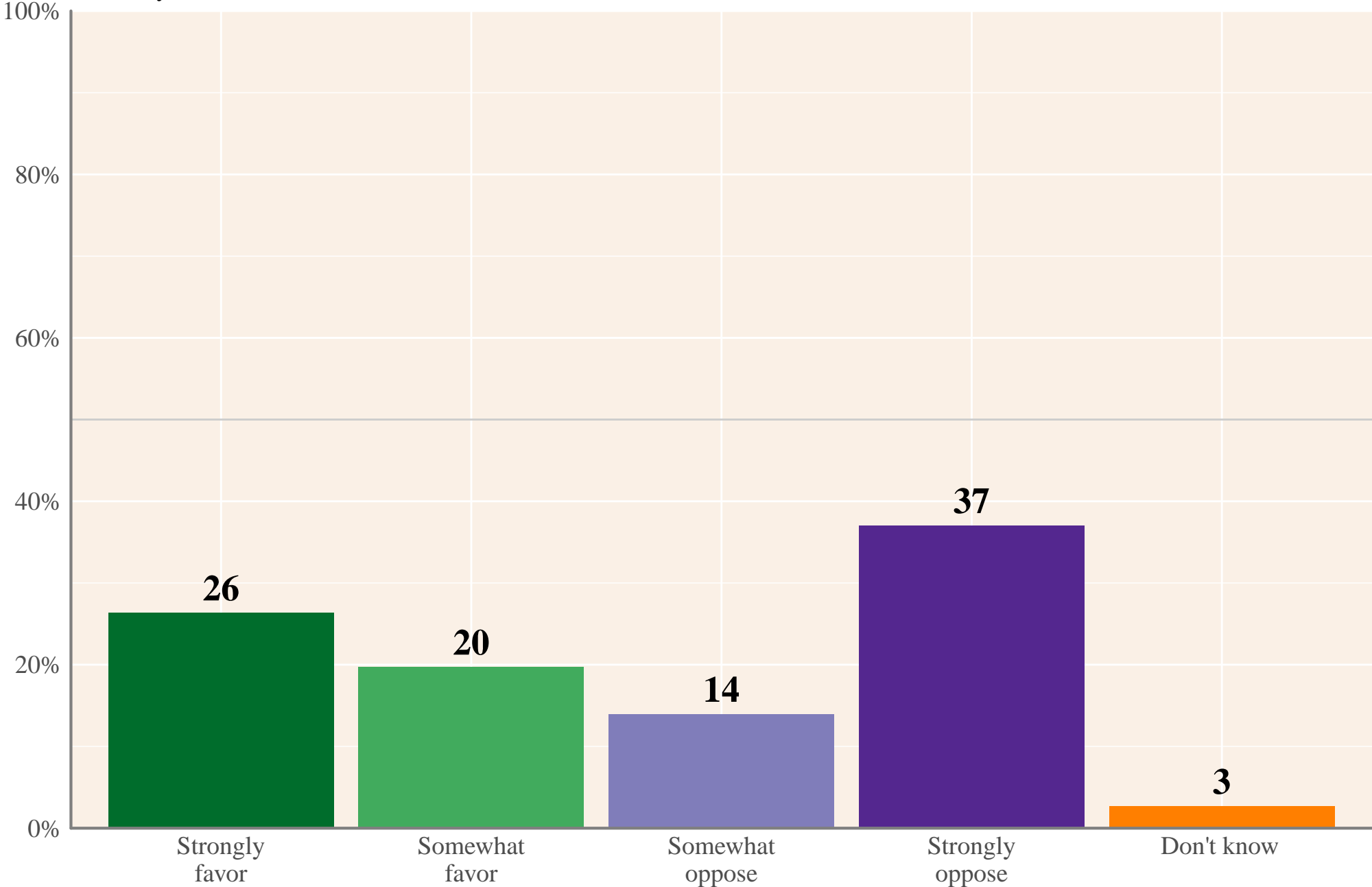

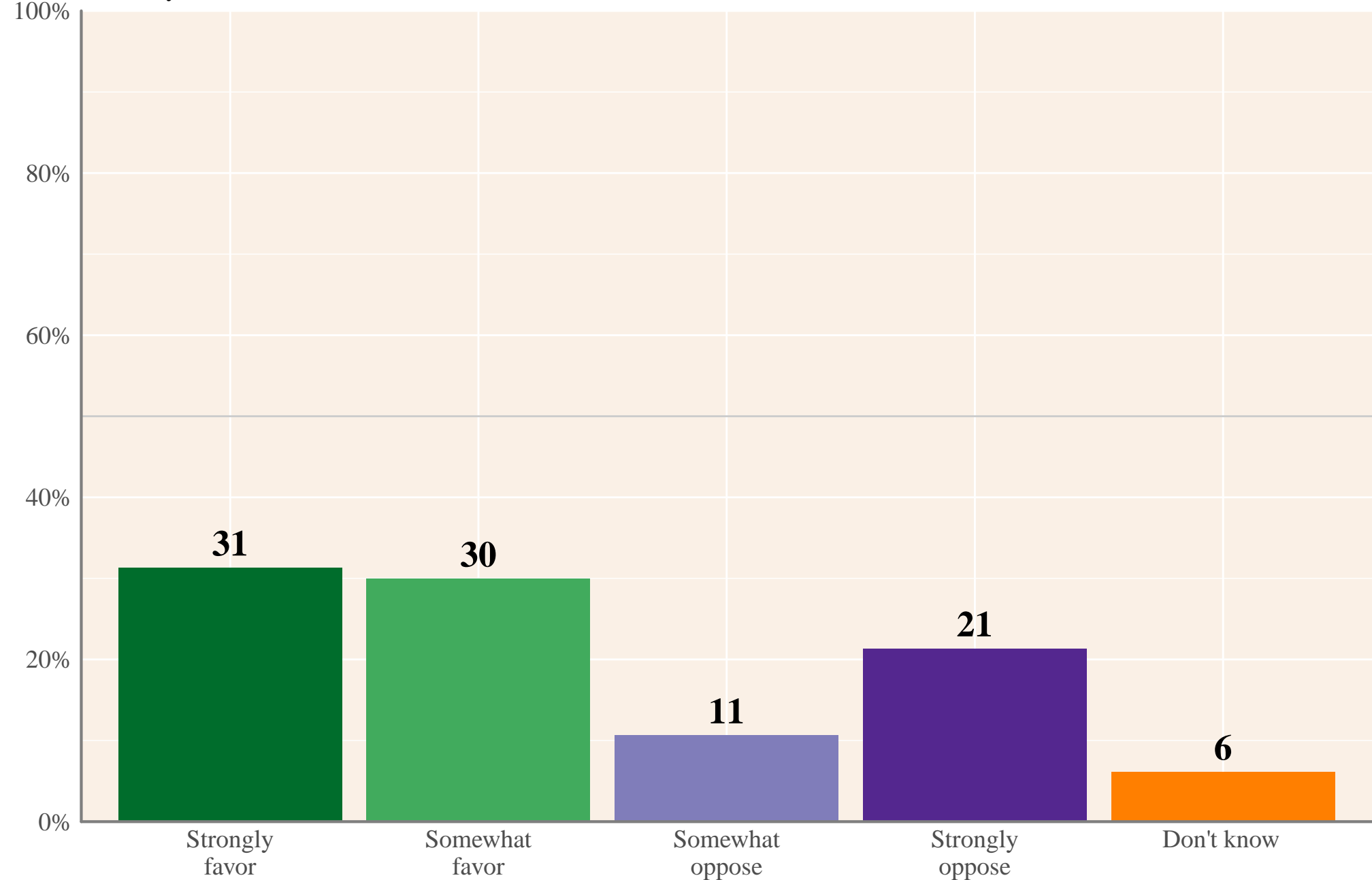

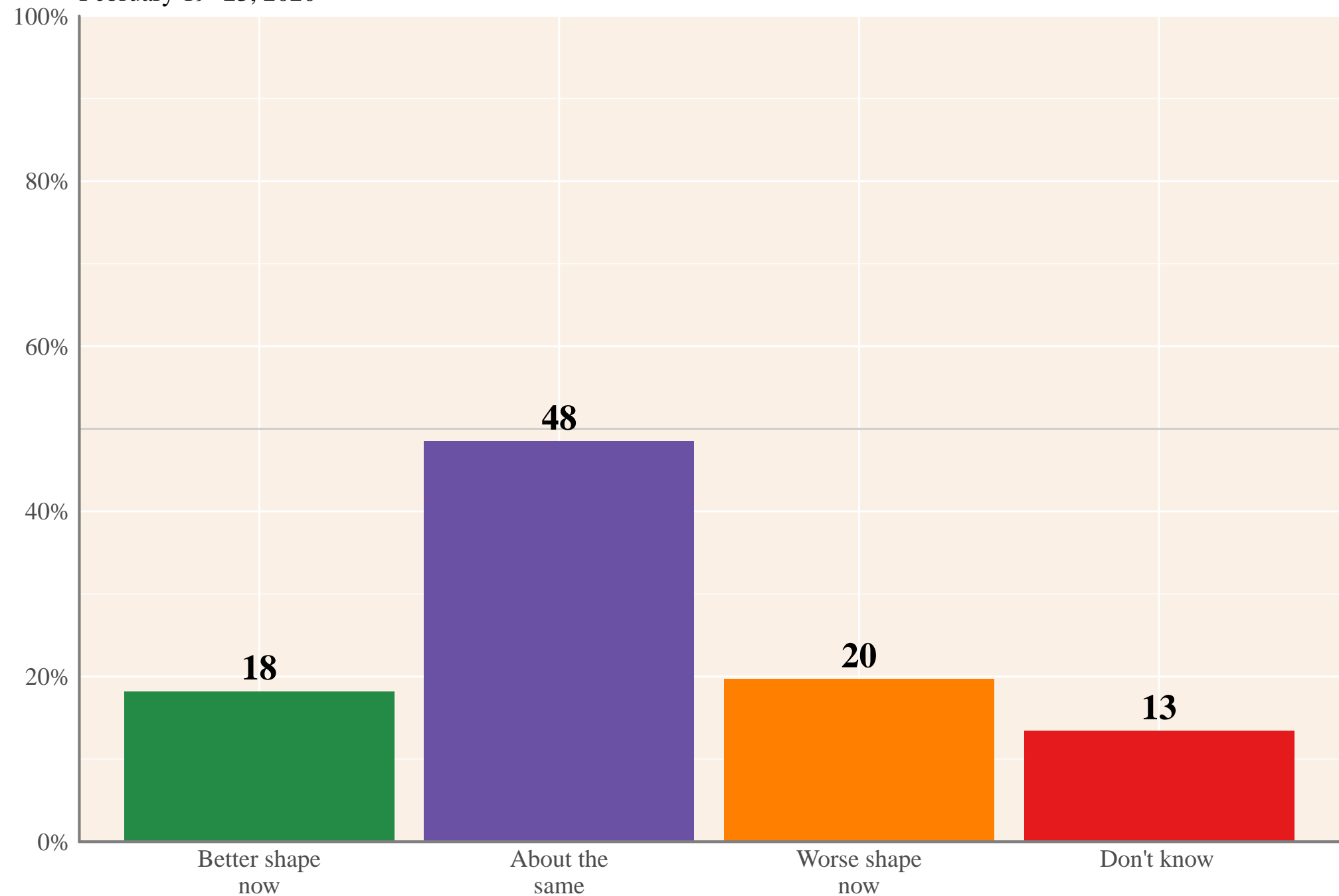

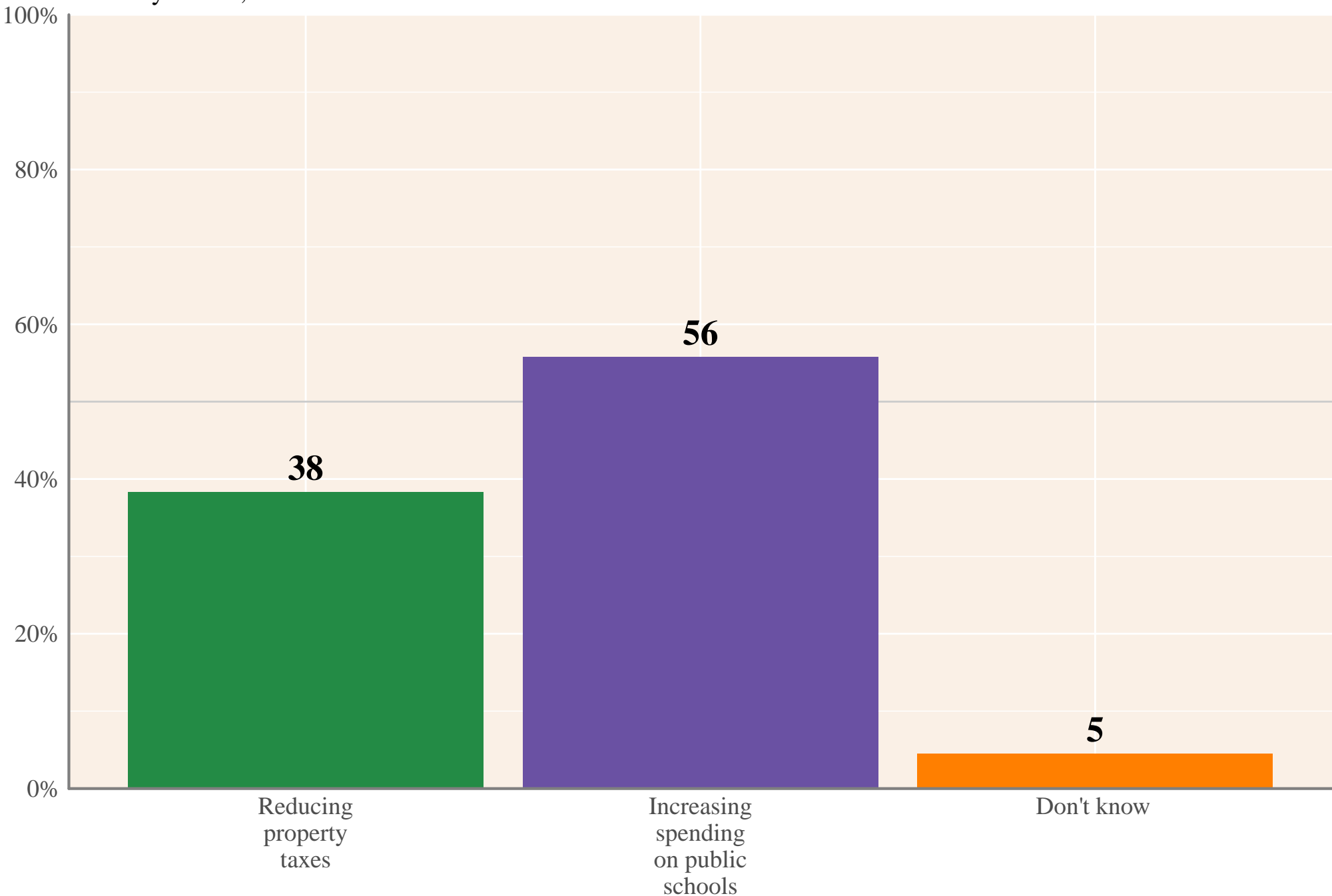
Would you say the state's budget is in better shape now than it was a few years ago, about the same or in worse shape now?

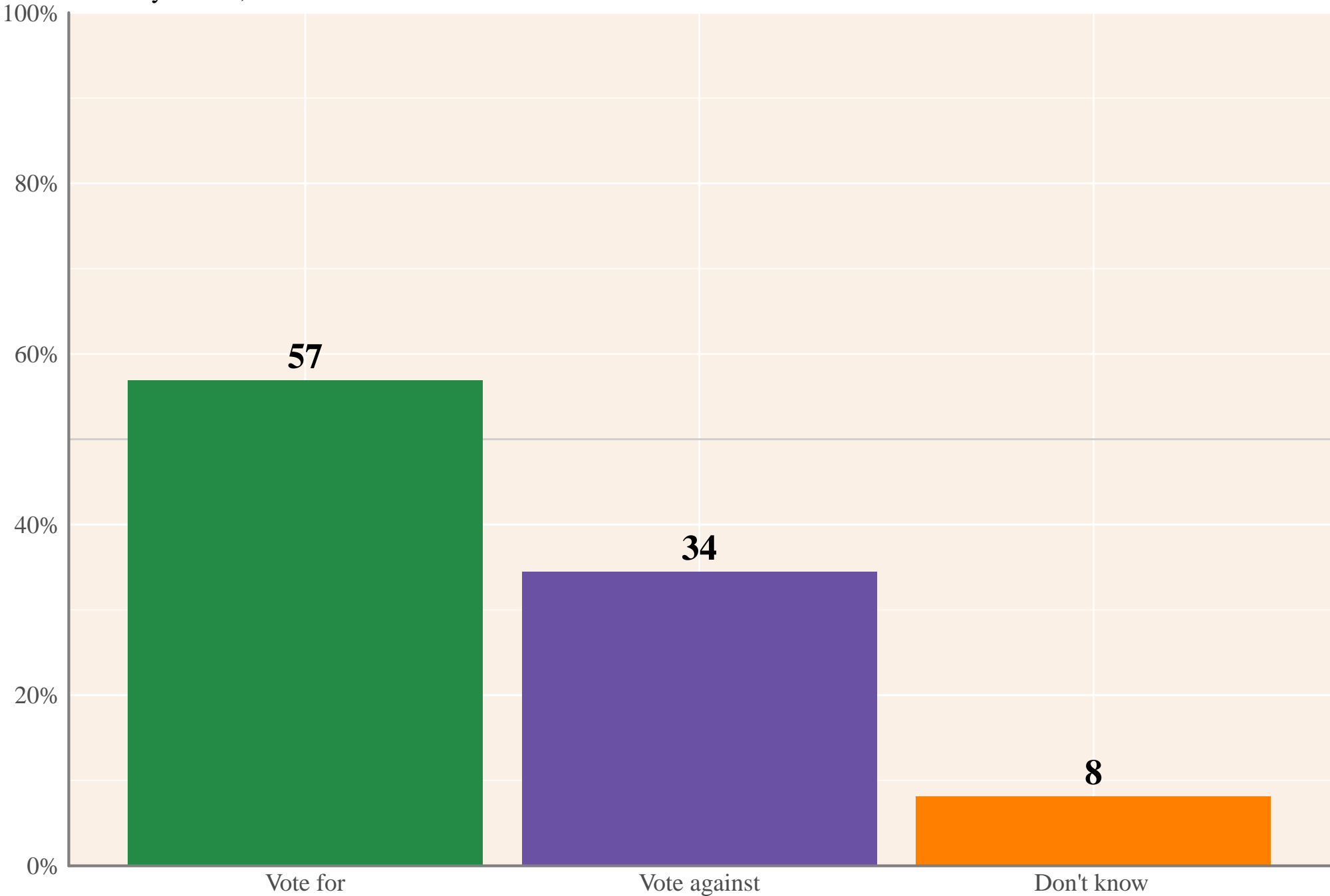

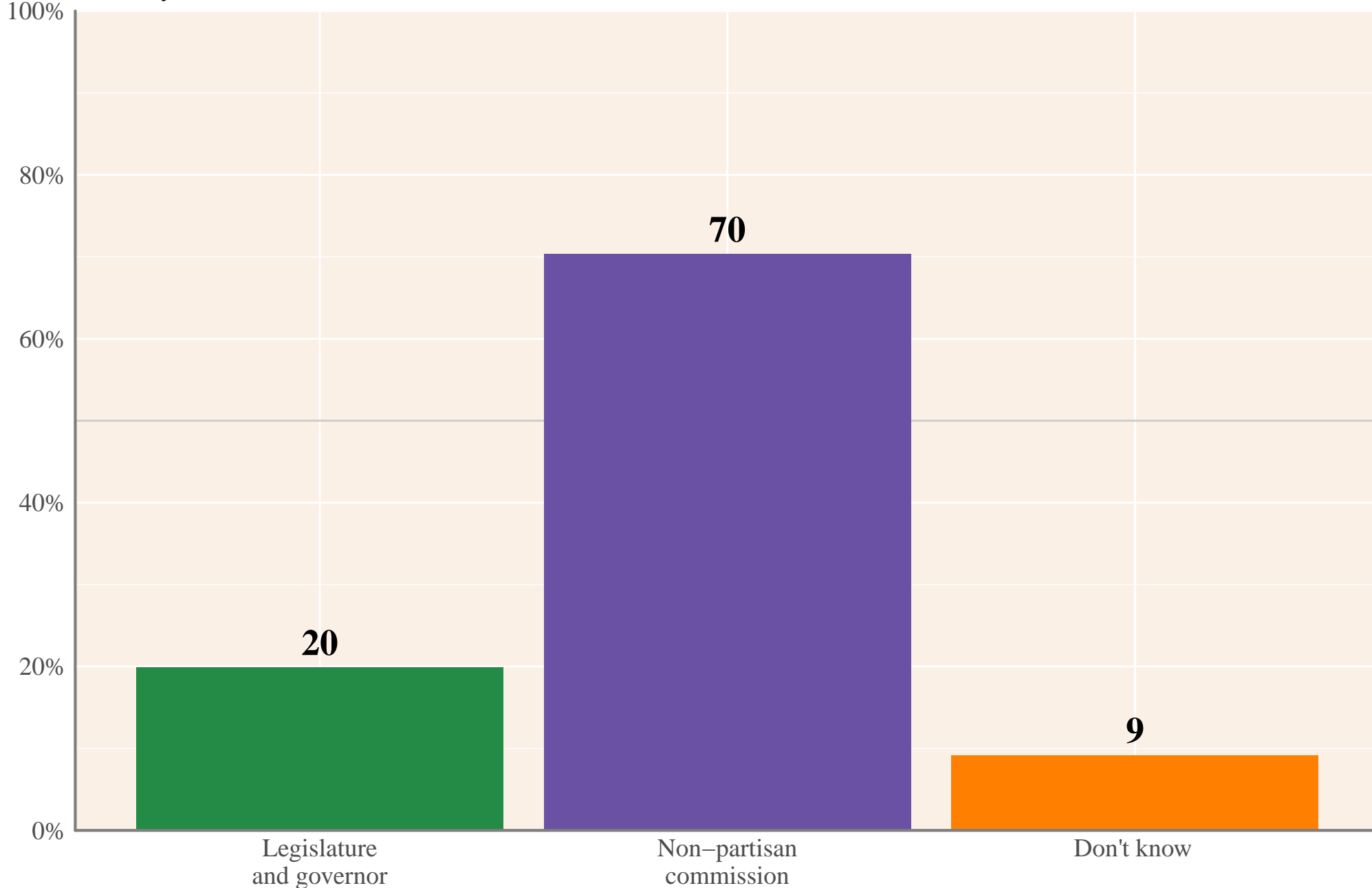

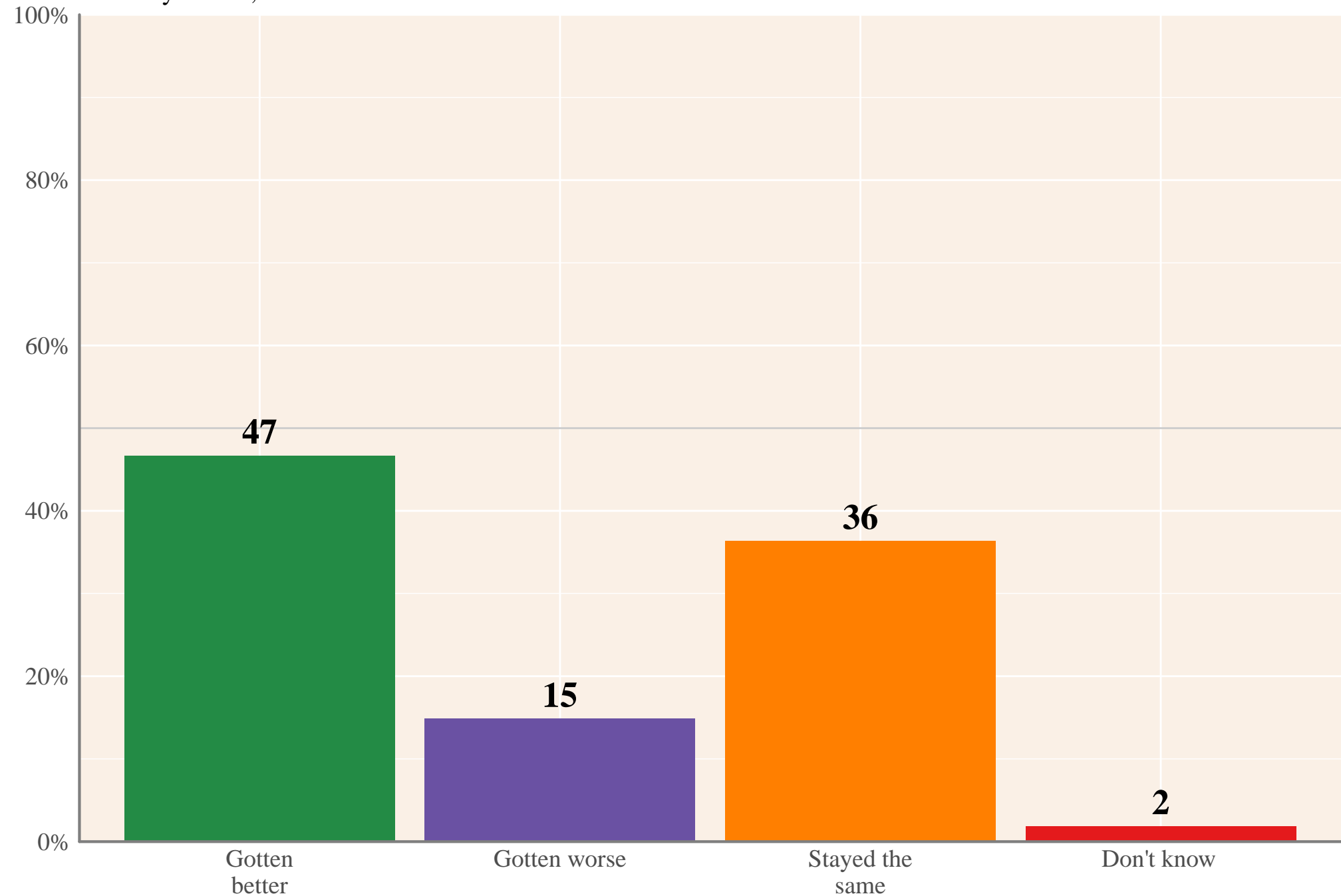

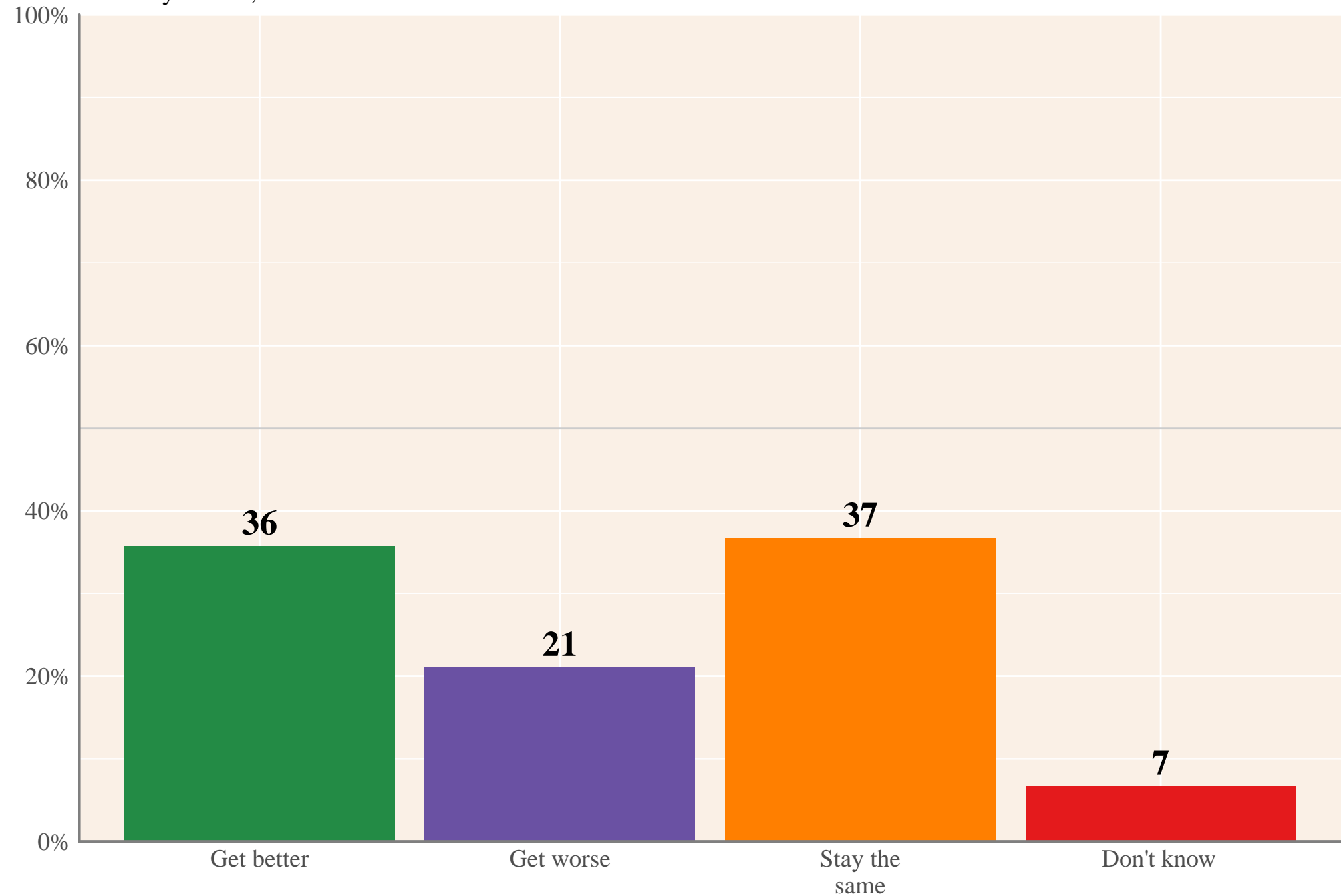
Over the past year, do you feel the economy has gotten better, gotten worse, or stayed about the same?

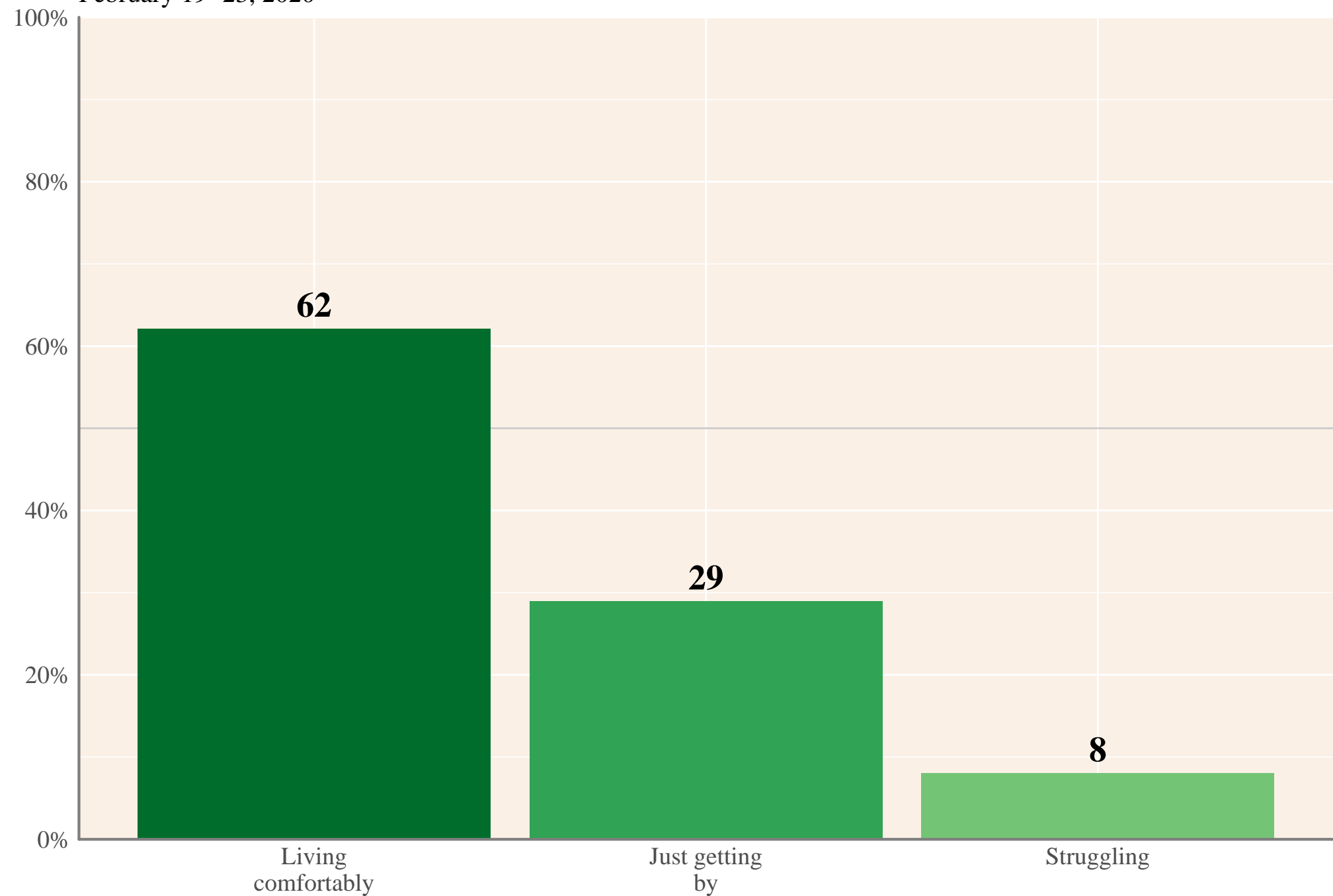

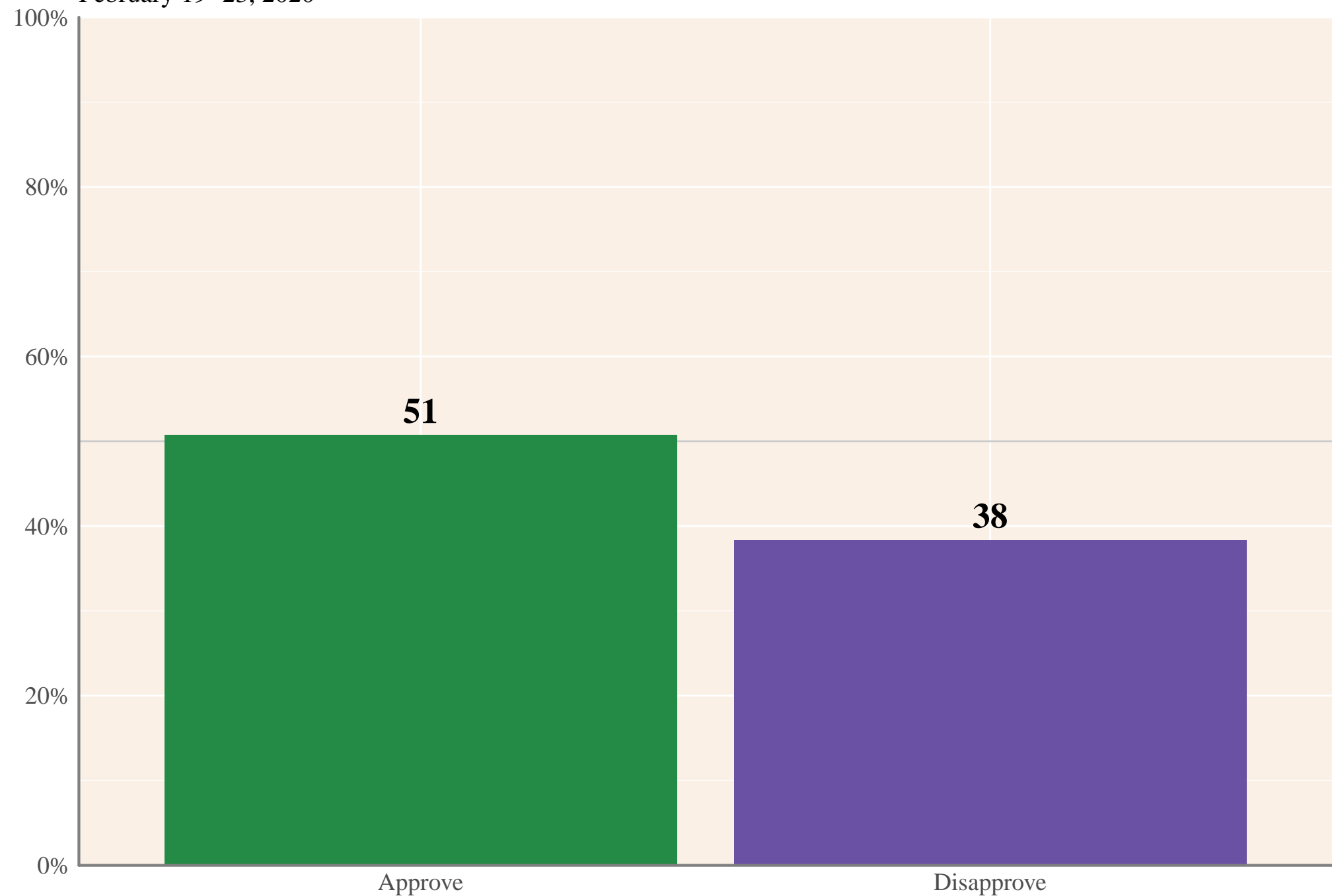

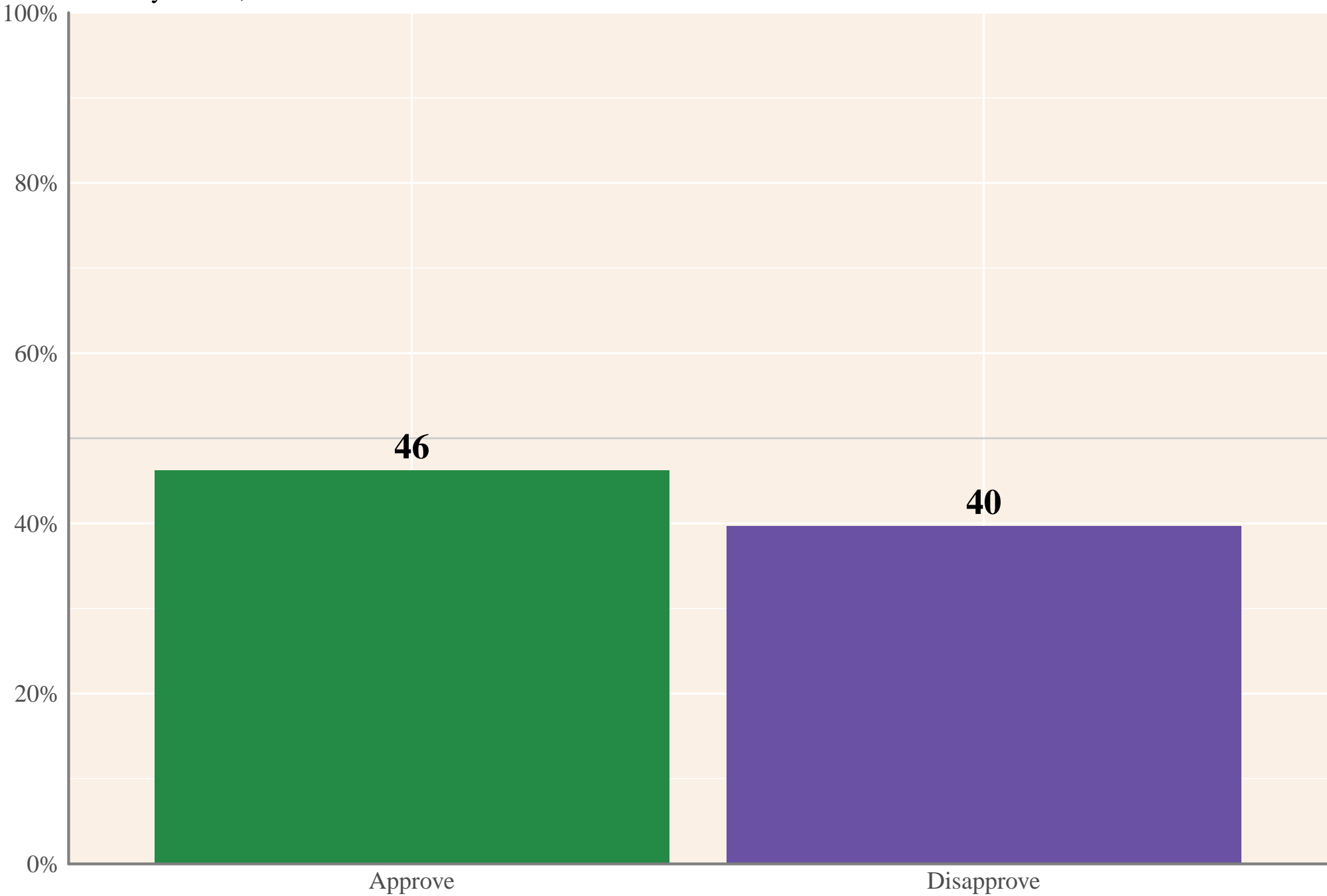

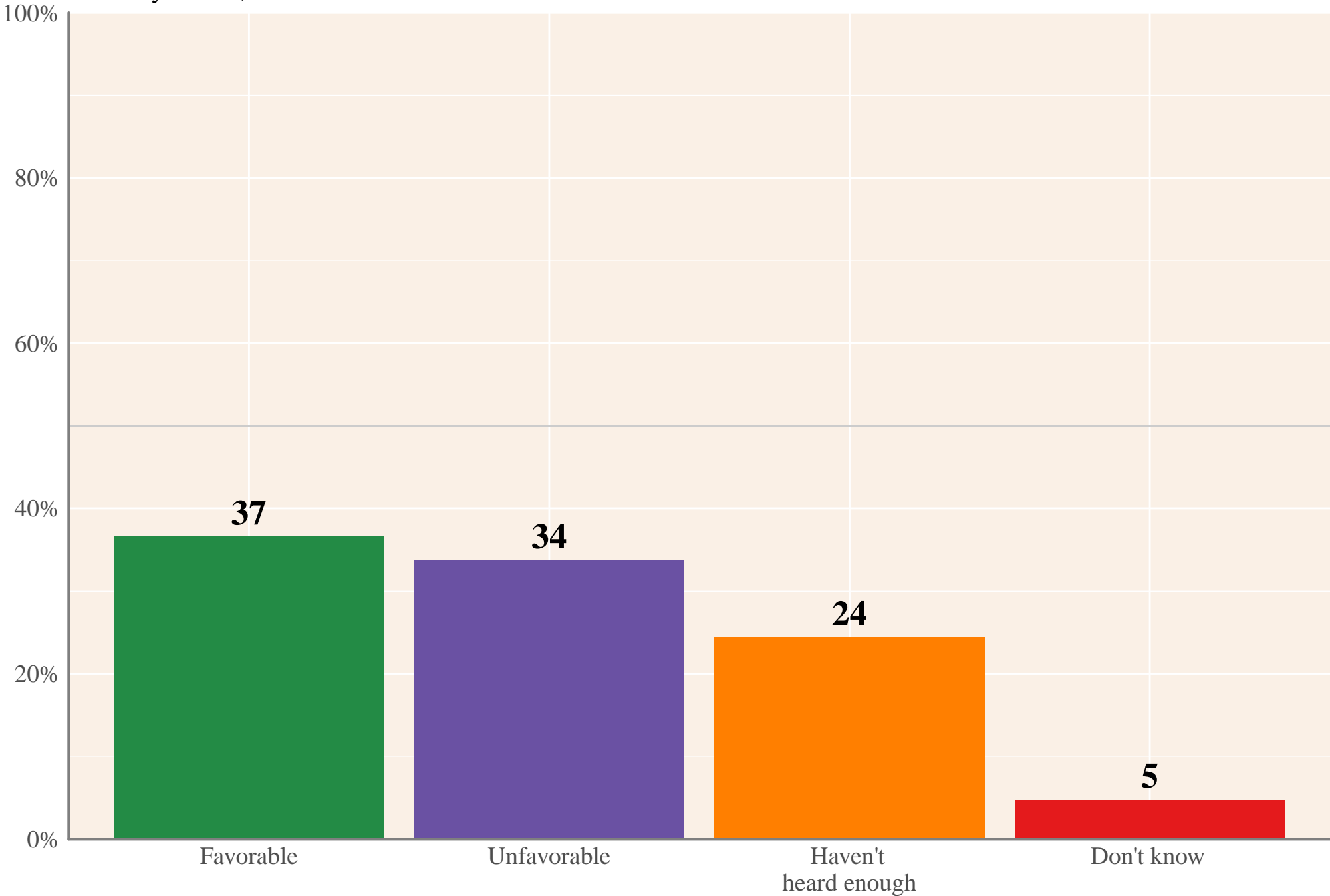
Overall, do you approve or disapprove of the way the Wisconsin legislature is handling its job?

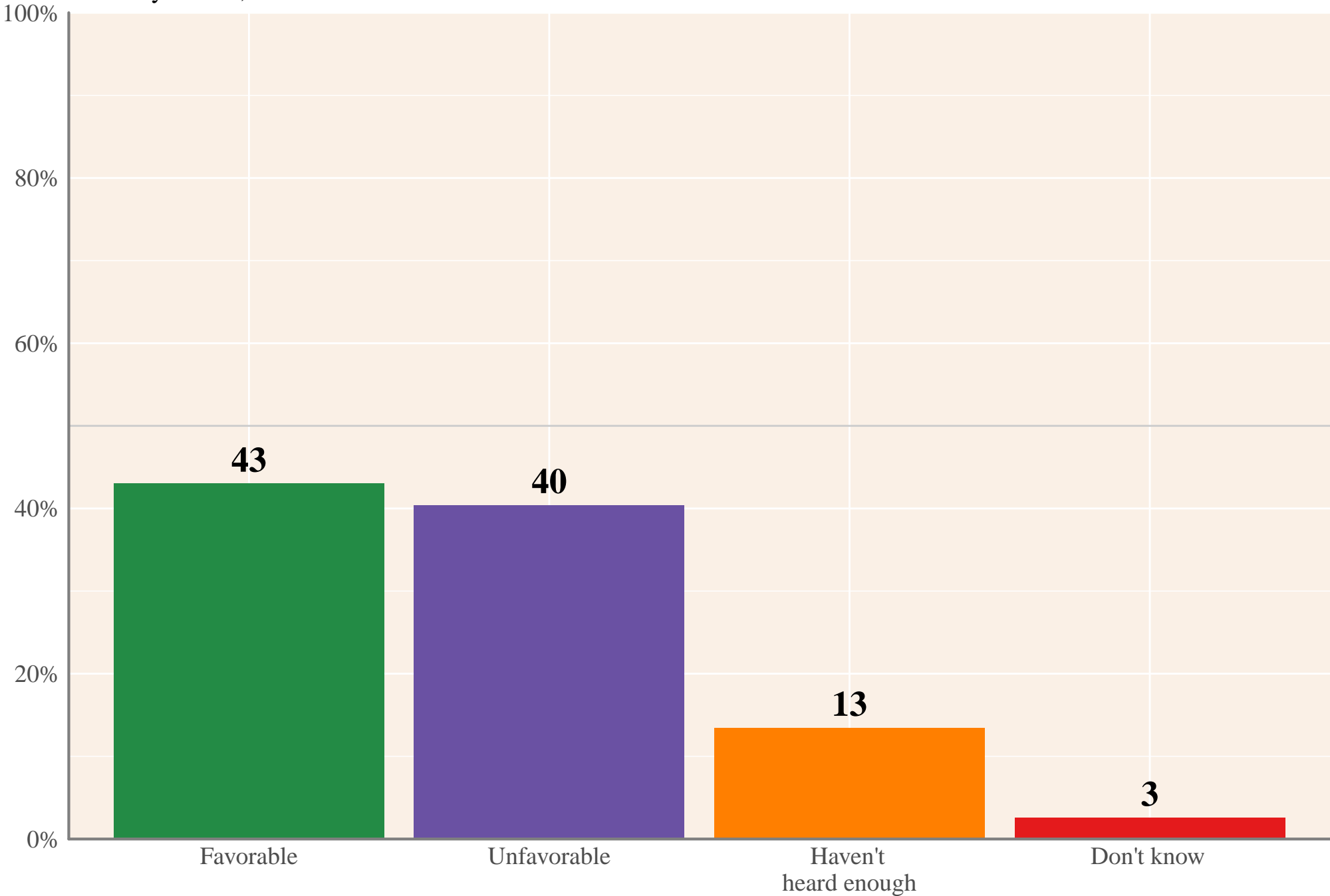
