### The methodology

- The survey was conducted Aug. 28-Sept. 5, 2024, interviewing 822
  Wisconsin registered voters, with a margin of error of +/-4.6
  percentage points.
- There are 738 likely voters with a margin of error of +/-4.7 percentage points.
- New likely voter model is based on voter list record of voting since 2016, rather than our previous use of those who say they are absolutely certain to vote. The results are quite similar but I believe the modeled probability of voting is more stable.


### Partisan makeup

- The partisan makeup of the sample is 35% Republican, 32% Democratic and 32% independent.
- Since January 2020, the long-term partisan balance has been 30% Republican and 29% Democratic, with 40% independent.
- This sample is unusually light on independents, and the party balance is 2 points more Republican than usual. More people are describing themselves as partisans than usual.




Among likely voters


















Among likely voters




#### Baldwin vs Hovde, unleaned vote



### Source of political division


- Which comes closer to your view about political divisions in Washington these days?






#### Which candidate would do a better job on issues, Wisconsin




#### Perceived ideology of Harris and Trump, Wisconsin




#### Perceived ideology of Vance and Walz, Wisconsin


#### Most important issue by party ID, Wisconsin











Among registered voters




#### Harris and Trump combined favorability




## Senate candidate favorability

Among registered voters




### Baldwin favorability trend




## Baldwin favorability by party ID trend








#### Perceived ideology of Baldwin and Hovde, Wisconsin

Among Wisconsin registered voters






