The methodology

- The survey was conducted Sept. 18-26, 2024, interviewing 882 Wisconsin registered voters, with a margin of error of +/-4.4 percentage points.
- There are 798 likely voters with a margin of error of +/-4.4 percentage points.
- New likely voter model is based on voter list record of voting since 2016, assigning each respondent a probability of voting.


Partisan makeup

- The partisan makeup of the sample is 34% Republican, 32% Democratic and 34% independent.
- Since January 2020, the long-term partisan balance has been 30% Republican and 29% Democratic, with 40% independent.
- This sample is light on independents, and the party balance is 1 points more Republican than usual. More people are describing themselves as partisans than usual and fewer as independents who lean to a party. The share of "pure independents" is about the average.



Among both registered and likely voters










Two-candidate vote trend, Wisconsin




Biden/Harris vote by party identification








Baldwin vs Hovde, with undecided




Senate vote trend with undecided, Wisconsin


















Enthusiasm by party ID, Wisconsin





Among Wisconsin registered voters





Harris favorability trend, Wisconsin








Which candidate would do a better job on issues, Wisconsin Among Wisconsin registered voters



Most important issue, Wisconsin




Most important issue by party ID, Wisconsin








Baldwin favorability trend



Hovde favorability trend






Trump retrospective approval trend



Among Wisconsin registered voters




